US 50 and I-77 Bridge Beam Addition

To correct an error in the specifications:

Specifications Section 5.1 reads, "Length: 100' or a combination of field spliced sections equaling 100'. If beam sections are to be spliced, splices shall occur within 20' of the end of each beam." This should read "length: 100'" as there are to be no splices in the beam.

Specifications Section 7.4 reads, "Vendor shall commence the installation within 90 working days after contract award." This should be corrected to "Vendor shall complete the delivery within 90 working days after contract award."

To answer vendor posed questions.

Question #1: Is there any camber required for the beam?

Response #1: The beam shall be cambered for its own dead weight (i.e. only the dead weight of the steel). See attached dead load deflection drawing.

Question #2: Any coating requirements?

Response #2 The beam does not require a coating.

Question #3: Awardee is required to off load at WV structure location, what are the site conditions? Is there ample space to set up equipment?

Response #3 The site provides ample space to set up equipment.

Question #4: Will WV provide any traffic control?

Response #4 The WVDOH will provide traffic control as needed. Selected vendor will coordinate with District 3 traffic engineer.

Question #5: Is there any time of day restrictions for offloading (day /Night)?

Response #5 The beam may be off loaded at any time during the day (between 7 am and 5 pm).

Question #6: Is there any bolted splices in the existing structure?

Response #6 There are bolted splices in the existing structure. Whether or not there are splices in the existing beam is not relevant to this contract. The new beam must be a continuous piece.

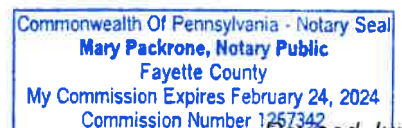

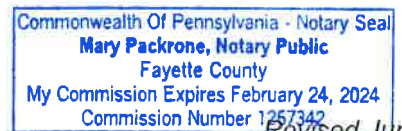
