SCOPE OF WORK

SYSTEM OPERATION

Johnson Controls Security Solution (JCSS) will Install, Program, Focus & Test a new Security System for West Virginia State Treasurers Office located at 322 70th St SE, Charleston, WV 25304. The System that we are proposing will be Exacq Video Surveillance System with Axis IP Cameras and Axis Horn Speakers. The systems were designed as per the reference from customer provided Security Drawings and Documents.

Video Management System

Johnson Controls Security Solution (JCSS) to provide and install a new Axis Video Surveillance Solution with Axis IP Cameras and Axis IP Horn Speakers. This proposal has been designed to protect the following areas: General Areas, Entry/Exit Areas, Parking Lots, and High-Risk Areas. These areas have been identified by the Customer.

Additional Details

- JCSS to provide Camera Software Licenses.
- Customer to provide all Network Switches and Network Infrastructure
- JCSS to provide a Boom Lift 34-39' articulating DC for 1 week. The round trip is included in the proposal
- JCSS to provide labor hours to remove the existing cameras that will be replaced

Head-End Equipment

JCSS will install the head end equipment as identified on the Security Electronic Proposal. The Head End Equipment will consist of the following:

- Network Video Recorder (NVR)
 - JCSS will connect the NVR to the network port and 120VAC power

Field Equipment

JCSS will provide, install & test new Field Devices necessary for the proper & customer expected operation of these security systems. Field Devices will consist of Axis IP Cameras, Axis IP Horn Speakers, Mounts and Accessories as described in the BOM. Reference Security Electronic documents for device counts and placement

Cabling Details

JCSS will install, terminate & test all new cabling from the head end equipment to all new cameras.

Customers Responsibilities

The Customer is responsible for the following:

- Customer to provide all necessary 120v A/C power for Security Equipment
- The Customer is to provide ensure adequate rack space is available for the installation of all necessary security headend equipment
- Customer to provide dedicated IP network resources required for Video System. This includes
 associated ports, IP address ranges, network drops, and access to location specified in this
 SOW or Security Electronic Drawings

- Customer to provide Core Network Switch to place cameras on Customer Network
- The 120VAC power and active network port must be located within 6 feet of the NVR, monitor and POE switch

- All work to be performed during normal working hours, Monday-Friday between 8:00 am to 5:00 pm excluding local and national holidays. If it is required that work be done at any other time except normal working hours, a change order will be presented to the owner's representatives with a schedule of costs. Upon acceptance of the change order, the work will be done and the additional charges will be added to the total charge to the customer
- The installation will occur between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, 5 days a week (Monday-Friday), unless otherwise requested at an additional charge
- All work performed estimated utilizing standard JCSS Integrated Security Labor Rates. Should Prevailing Wage, or A-Rate Labor apply, the customer required to pay variance
- The owner agrees to maintain clear access, free of obstructions or barriers, during the installation period
- The location of all proposed equipment is assumed to be installed outside of any Hazardous Areas. It will be the responsibility of the Customer to advise prior to installing if any area hazards exist
- The owner or his representative is responsible for the structural integrity of all surfaces that will bear the load of equipment covered by this proposal including installation equipment, and installation personnel
- Pricing is subject to change based upon timing of receiving of purchase order
- Any re-engineering of the original scope of work that can compromise the functionality of the system (ex. device relocation that may be further than original design)

 upon prior to the change. Any changes may result in additional charges
- Johnson Control Security will review the installation schedule during meeting with customer to ensure that there are no obstructions to cause delays
- This proposal is based upon the information provided to JCSS by the Customer during our discussions.
- It is understood and agreed by JCSS and the Customer that the location and description of the
 protection equipment selected for the project have been taken from a survey conducted by
 Johnson Controls Security. Should the system, when completed consist of more or less

- protection equipment than specified, the materials costs, installation charges, and/or annual service fees shall be increased or decreased in accordance with the prevailing charges for the protection added or deleted.
- JCSS is responsible for mounting the cameras and focusing per the West Virginia State Treasurers Office request. Any changes after the West Virginia State Treasurers Office signed off on the view will be a change order to the original job.


