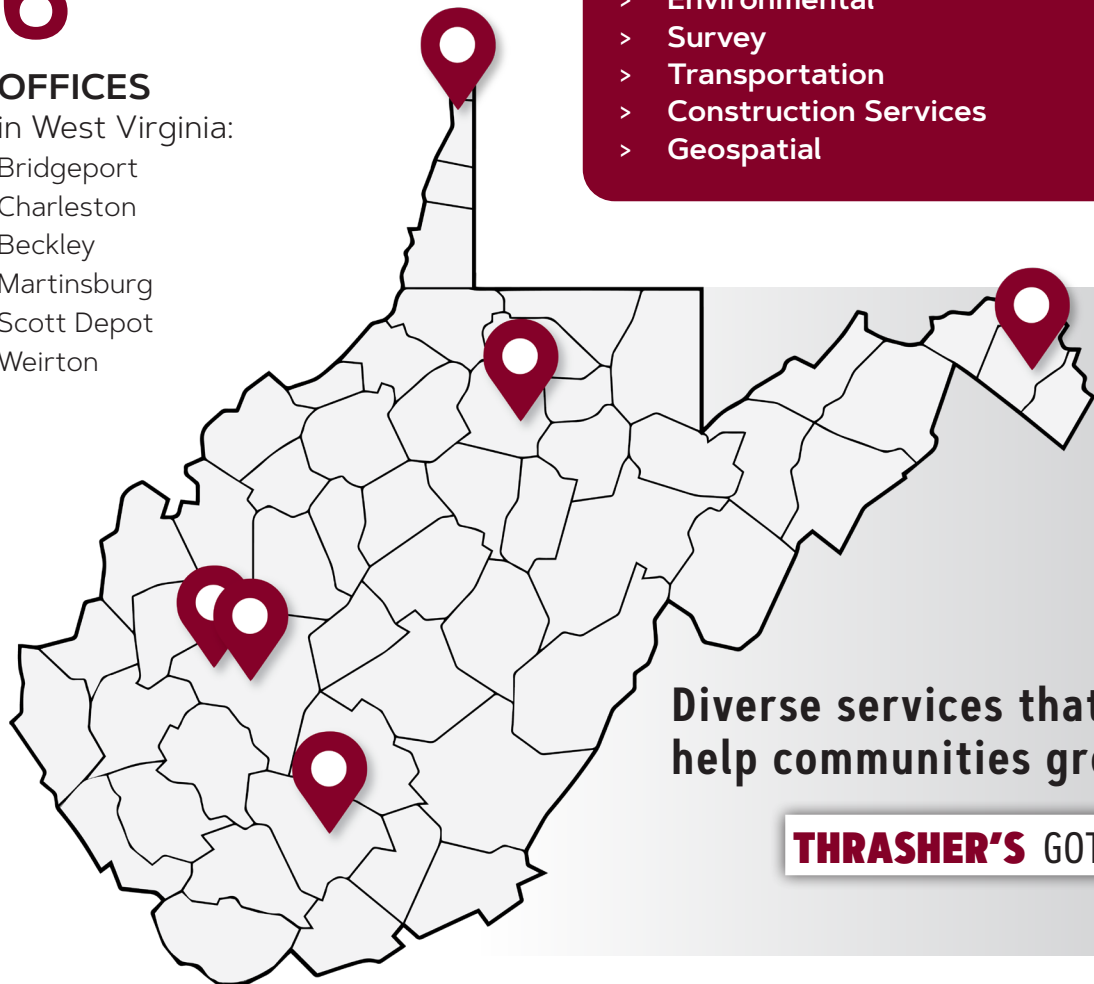

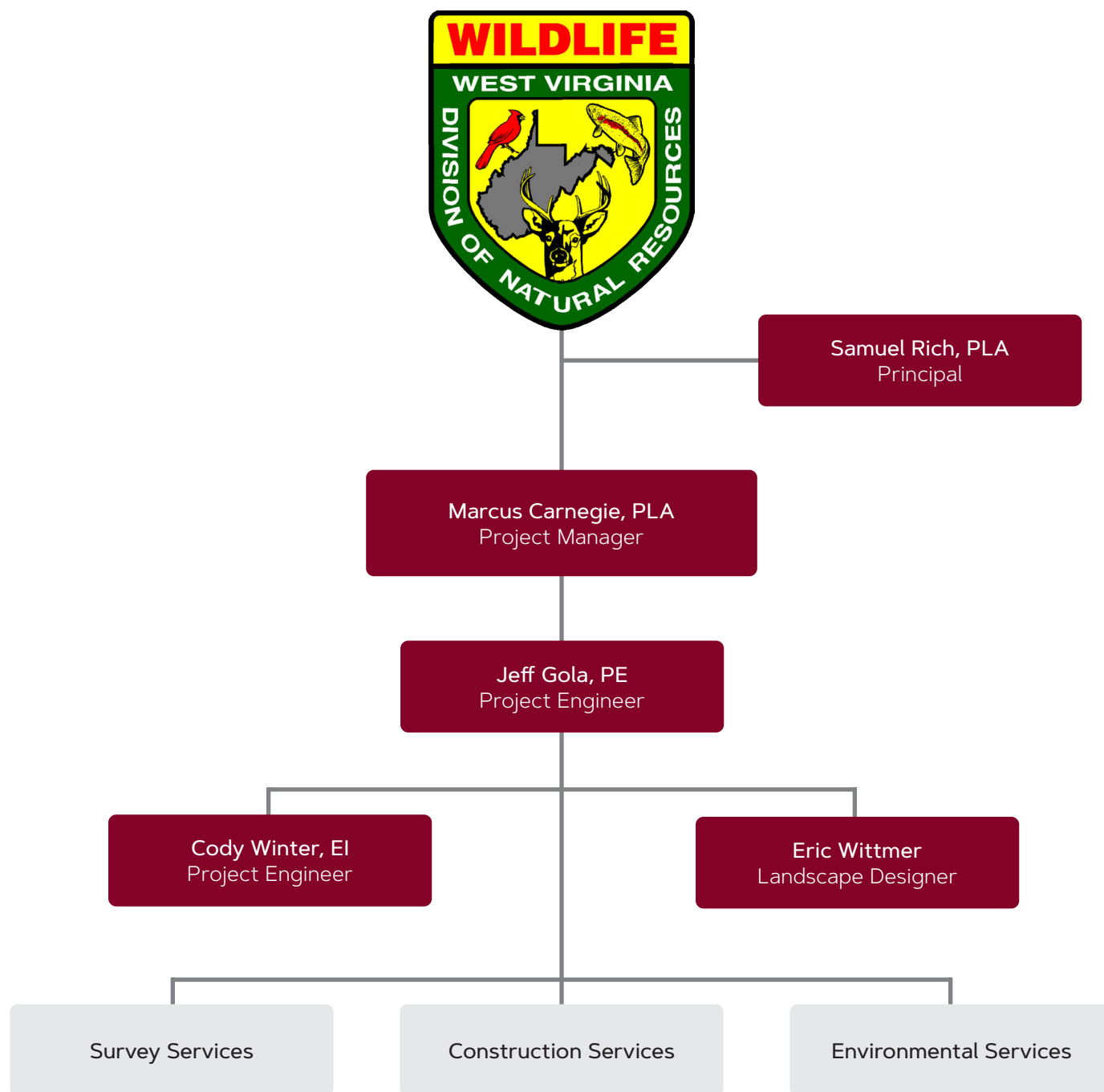

The Hazel Ruby McQuain Park and Amphitheater is one of Morgantown's premier outdoor recreation facilities. The park is home to annual local festivals, community movie and concert events, and several organized run and walk events during all seasons.

The improvements project consists of: a new amphitheater canopy, new restroom building, adaptive reuse of the historic depot, renovation of the existing restroom building to a new green room and police department storage facility, renovations to the amphitheater seating area, redesign and renovation of the park pedestrian areas and landscape, bike/

walking path improvements, new ADA kayak launch, and renovations to the Walnut Street Landing parking and pedestrian area.

Thrasher has had the pleasure of working on the re-development of Palentine Park in Fairmont for several years. Initially, Thrasher designed amphitheater seating to help revitalize the area and draw in performance artists. From there, Thrasher created the overall master plan and vision for this riverside park. To date, construction has consisted of a new splash park, site lighting, restroom facilities, vehicular and bike parking, boat launch facility with trailer parking, sidewalk and trail extensions, river access stairs, and an overlook constructed on top of a historic bridge abutment.


