


EXHIBIT B - PROJECT PLANS

1. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

A. Mandatory Contract Item Requirements: Contract Item must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.

The specifications of this RFQ and/or any WVDOH Standards referenced in and/or attached to this RFQ may include references to specific recognized "industry standard" specifications which are issued by third parties, such as the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) and the American Association of State and Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO). Such specifications are protected by strict copyright restrictions and cannot be published as part of this RFQ. The ability to access such specifications shall be considered a mandatory requirement for participation in the RSQ process as a Vendor or as a supplier to the Vendor, as applicable.

I. Product Requirements: All products and procedures shall be in accordance with the specifications herein. The contractor shall be responsible for verifying accurate dimensions. Definitive measurements can be taken at the site during pre-bid meeting.

A. Renovation Requirements and Execution:

- 1. Metal Panels: Remove and dispose of all old roofing and siding panels, then install new 26-gauge or better R-panel type panels. All metal shall be Coco Brown or similar dark brown in color.
- 2. **Protrusion Booting:** Install temperature specific booting (cold/hot) for all roof protrusions.
- 3. **Trim:** Install new 26-gauge metal drip edge, ridge cap, rake, and eaves. Any rotten fascia boards should be replaced, and facia trim should be installed. The color of the trim shall match the roof and siding panels.
- 4. Gutters: Install new 6-inch seamless gutters behind the drip edge along each eave. Gutters shall be metal and have a minimum thickness of 0.032 inch and be installed on a slope so that water drains toward the downspout. The color of the gutters shall match the roof and siding panels.

- 5. Downspouts: Downspouts should be 4 inch by 4 inch and run from the gutter opening to the pavement, then elbow out to the parking lot. Downspouts shall be placed approximately every 50 feet or less depending on building constraints. The color of the downspouts shall match the roof and siding panels.
- 6. Snow/Ice Guards: Metal snow/ice guards shall be installed across the entire width of the finished metal roof to prevent an "avalanche". Snow/ice guards should be placed and fastened according to the manufacturer's specifications.
- 7. Windows: Remove and dispose of old windows. Install 2 new 34-inch by 34-inch windows and 10 new 36-inch by 48-inch windows.
- 8. Entry Doors: Remove and dispose of old entry doors. Install 3 new 36-inch steel external entry doors.
- Garage Doors: Remove and dispose of old garage doors, tracks, etc...
 Install 5 new roll up style steel garage doors w/ motor operators as specified.
 - 9.1 Curtain: The garage door curtains shall be non-insulated and consist of interlocking slats manufactured from galvanized 22 gage steel or better. The garage doors must have dimensions of 12-foot wide by 14-foot tall. The curtain should be finished with a light gray enamel coating.
 - 9.2 Tracks: All tracks must be installed according to the manufacturer's specifications and be able to accommodate the finished dimensions of the door curtain. tracks and hardware shall be galvanized to prevent corrosion.
 - 9.3 Attachments: The doors shall be fitted with end-locks and wind-locks suited for a 20 PSF wind load. Weather seals shall be installed on each door.
 - 9.4 Motor Operator: New garage door motor operators shall be installed for each door. The motor operator must be 110-115V single phase and have a minimum of ½ horsepower rating.
 - 9.5 Openers: All doors shall be equipped with three (3) button electric wall control openers where the "close" button operates under constant pressure. The openers shall have NEMA 1 rated interior closures. All electrical wiring and connections shall be done by the vendor.

- 9.6 Electrical Connections: Any products requiring electrical connections must be listed and classified by Underwriters Laboratories, Inc.
- 10. Cleanup: The vendor shall perform a daily cleanup of the area surrounding the construction site, removing all construction debris or otherwise deleterious materials. All construction materials must be stored in a manner that does not impede normal operations at the facility.

WARRANTY: Successful bidder will provide a 2-year warranty on all parts and labor in addition to any manufacturer's warranty.

Building and roof renovations on the West Virginia Division of Highways Bruceton Mills facility located at 14115 N. Preston Hwy Bruceton Mills, West Virginia 26525.

The Vendor shall furnish all materials, labor, and equipment necessary to complete all Construction Services. The Vendor shall furnish any incidental work, materials, labor, and equipment that are necessary to complete the Construction Services, even if such incidental work is not explicitly included in the Project Plans.

- 2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions and in the Project Plans as defined below.
- 2.1 "Construction Services" means removal of existing roof and siding and replacement of new R-PANEL roofing and siding as more fully described in the Project Plans.
- 2.2 "Pricing Page" means the pages contained in wvOASIS, attached hereto as Exhibit A, or included in the Project Plans upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Construction Services.
- 2.3 "Solicitation" means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with Construction Services that is published by the Purchasing Division.
- 2.4 "Project Plans" means documents developed by an architect, an engineer, the Agency, or another design professional, which are attached hereto as Exhibit B, that provide detailed instructions on how the Construction Services are to be performed. In the event that Project Plans contain drawings or other documents too large to attach in Exhibit B, Vendors can obtain copies in accordance with Section 9 of these Specifications.
- 3. ORDER OF PRECEDENCE: This General Construction Specifications document will have priority over, and supersede, anything contained in the Project Plans.
- 4. QUALIFICATIONS: Vendor, or Vendor's staff if requirements are inherently limited to individuals rather than corporate entities, shall have the following minimum qualifications:
- 4.1. Experience: Vendor, or Vendor's supervisory staff assigned to this project, must have successfully completed at least five (5) projects that involved work like that described in these specifications or the Project Plans. Compliance with this experience requirement will Revised 06/08/18

be determined prior to contract award by the State through references provided by the Vendor upon request, through knowledge or documentation of the Vendor's past projects, through confirmation of experience requirements from the architect assisting the State in this project, or some other method that the State determines to be acceptable. Vendor must provide any documentation requested by the State to assist in confirmation of compliance with this provision. References, documentation, or other information to confirm compliance with this experience requirement may be requested after bid opening and prior to contract award.

- 4.2. Licensing: Vendor must have valid Contractor's License
 - 5. CONTRACT AWARD: The Contract is intended to provide Agency with a purchase price for the Construction Services. The Contract will be awarded to the lowest qualified responsible bidder meeting the required specifications. If the Pricing Pages contain alternates/add-ons, the Contract will be awarded based on the grand total of the base bid and any alternates/add-ons selected.
 - 6. SELECTION OF ALTERNATES: Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(f), any solicitation of bids shall include no more than five alternates. Alternates, if accepted, shall be accepted in the order in which they are listed on the bid form. Any unaccepted alternate contained within a bid shall expire 90 days after the date of the opening of bids for review. Determination of the lowest qualified responsible bidder shall be based on the sum of the base bid and any alternates accepted.
 - 7. **PERFORMANCE:** Vendor shall perform the Construction Services in accordance with this document and the Project Plans.
 - 8. SUBSTITUTIONS: Any substitution requests must be submitted in accordance with the official question and answer period described in the INSTRUCTIONS TO VENDORS SUBMITTING BIDS, Paragraph 4. Vendor Question Deadline. Vendors submitting substitution requests should submit product brochures and product specifications during the official question and answer period.
 - 9. PROJECT PLANS: The checked box will apply to Project Plans for this solicitation.
- No Additional Project Plan Documents: There are no additional Project Plans other than those attached hereto as Exhibit B & Exhibit C or any subsequent addenda modifying Exhibit B & Exhibit C.
- Additional Project Plan Documents: There are additional Project Plan documents other than those attached as Exhibit B. Copies of the additional Project Plan documents not attached as Exhibit B can be obtained by contacting the entity identified below.

10. CONDITIONS OF THE WORK

- 10.1. Permits: The Vendor shall procure all necessary permits and licenses to comply with all applicable Federal, State, or Local laws, regulations, and ordinances of any regulating body.
- 10.2. Existing Conditions: If discrepancies are discovered between the existing conditions and those noted in the specifications, Vendor must immediately notify the Agency's representative. Vendor must also immediately notify the Agency if suspected hazardous materials are encountered.
- 10.3. Standard Work Hours: The standard hours of work for this Contract will be Monday Friday 6:30am 5:00pm excluding holidays recognized by the State of West Virginia. Any work outside of the standard hours of work must be approved in advance at the Agency's sole discretion. Authorization of work outside of the standard hours of work will not entitle Vendor to additional compensation.
- 10.4. Project Closeout: Project Closeout shall include the following:
 - 10.4.1. Final Cleanup: Vendor shall perform the final cleanup activities listed below, along with any other final cleanup activities normally associated with the work performed under this Contract, prior to final inspection:

All construction debris, including existing roofing/siding panels shall become the responsibility of the contractor to dispose of in accordance with all state and federal laws. All construction materials shall be kept in an orderly fashion daily.

- 10.4.2. Final Inspection: Vendor shall participate in a final inspection with the Agency's project manager. The purpose of the final inspection will be to identify deficiencies that need to be remedied prior to Agency's final acceptance of the work. Vendor shall at all times be obligated to perform in accordance with the Contract and must take all actions necessary to ensure that work complies with requirements of Contract prior to final acceptance. Final acceptance does not waive or release Vendor from its obligation to ensure that work complies with the Contract requirements. Vendor shall submit any warranty documents to the Agency project manager at final inspection.
- 11. FACILITIES ACCESS: Performance of Contract Services may require access cards and/or keys to gain entrance to Agency's facilities. In the event that access cards and/or keys are required:


- 11.1. Vendor must identify principal service personnel which will be issued access cards and/or keys to perform service.
- 11.2. Vendor will be responsible for controlling cards and keys and will pay replacement fee, if the cards or keys become lost or stolen.
- 11.3. Vendor shall notify Agency immediately of any lost, stolen, or missing card or key.
- 11.4. Anyone performing under this Contract will be subject to Agency's security protocol and procedures.
- 11.5. Vendor shall inform all staff of Agency's security protocol and procedures.

Contract Manager: During its performance of this Contract, Vendor must designate and maintain a primary contract manager responsible for overseeing Vendor's responsibilities under this Contract. The Contract manager must be available during normal business hours to address any customer service or other issues related to this Contract.
