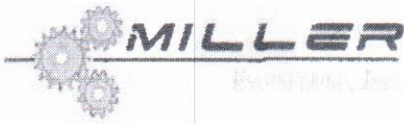

Project Clarifications:

- 1) Detail 2 and 3 on Sheet E501: change depth to top of conduit to 24" EXCEPT for the underground conduit placed for the utility to install conductors.
- 2) The project may be performed by either a general or electrical prime contractor. There is no direct requirement for a general contractor for the project due to the limited scope and size.

Contractor Questions:

- 1) QUESTION: Is there any way to move the bid date by 7 days.
ANSWER: See the formal Addendum cover for the revised Bid Date and Time.
- 2) QUESTION: Is there any provision for rock Excavation?
ANSWER: No provision for rock is included. The determination of rock which is un-rippable or un-removable by a reasonably sized machine will be at the discretion of the Engineer and dealt with on a case-by-case basis. Variation in the path due to boulders is a possible solution to such concerns.
- 3) QUESTION: Can the feeders to the mobile homes use direct burial mobile home cable installed in conduit?
ANSWER: Yes, but with two provisions. First, the mobile home cable must be Stabiloy or approved equal as all aluminum, if used, must be Stabiloy or approved equal. Contractor must verify the voltage drop in the sizing of the mobile home cable.
- 4) QUESTION: Should we use Schedule 80 PVC at road crossings or concrete at the road surface?
ANSWER: NO, as long as the conduit is 24" deep, there is no requirement for P80 conduit.
