Eskola LLC is a partnership with three corporate officers in the company. Below are these officers, titles, and brief summary of their work.

Jon Eskola – President of Eskola LLC. Jon, alongside Ben, founded Eskola in 2004 after his father retired from his long-standing roofing company. Jon has worked in roofing for his entire life and has dedicated his time to expanding Eskola across the country to make Eskola an industry leader in the roofing business. Jon is the visionary of Eskola and concentrates his time and efforts on all ways to continue to improve.

Ben Eskola – Vice President of Eskola, LLC. Ben, alongside Jon, founded Eskola in 2004. Ben has worked in roofing his entire life and is committed to understanding all aspects of the company's departments. Ben started in estimating and has worked closely with every department in the company to ensure quality and understanding of processes. Ben is committed to continued education of employees. Ben operates Eskola's operations daily and is involved in all key roles and is dedicated to fostering a company culture that enables its employees to grow with the company.





Relative Advantages:

The following are several points Eskola sees as advantages that will be beneficial to the owner.

- 1. Eskola has a full-time certified safety manager with multiple OSHA qualifications. His responsibilities include initial training of all new hires, training OSHA 10, OSHA 30, Fall Protection, Operator Certifications for equipment such as forklifts, man baskets etc, and other topics. He also maintains employee files with up-to-date certifications of each employee and scheduling trainings as they are needed to maintain the employee certifications. This will be essential to performing work for our customer and maintaining a rigid safety program so the level of safety is held high.
- In addition to a certified safety manager, Eskola employs several full-time safety field
 inspectors. Their responsibilities cover random site inspections to all projects, equipment
 inspections, fall protection equipment checks, housekeeping inspections, and initial safety plans
 for site specific issues.
- Eskola has a strong project management team that can and has handled many diverse and challenging projects for clients including TVA, ORNL, Redstone Arsenal and other agencies. This experience will be an asset for future projects allowing for key problem-solving skills, critical path management and scheduling.



- 4. Eskola employs full-time field superintendents who are responsible for crew management, meeting schedules, supporting the foremen on training for installations, communicating with the project managers, being the client's POC, and problem-solving daily challenges. Eskola's superintendents are non-laboring but instead are free to work and train on job specific details. Not working as a general crew member also allows him to focus on the overall goals, quality assurance, production schedule and material management.
- 5. Eskola employs over 100 craft trained people. The training and certifications are varied and broad. We have professionals trained by the manufacturer's for installing singleply systems, modified bitumen systems, shingles, metal roofing systems, sheet metal details, waterproofing and others. This allows Eskola to assemble a crew that will best fit the scope of work to be performed and maintain quality assurance.
- 6. Eskola has three branches with full time 24 hr emergency service departments. This affords us a geographical footprint that few competitors can offer and as a result it offers our client a shorter response time to emergencies as well as less travel time for crews, superintendents, and project managers. Less time on the road translates to more time on the site ensuring quality, safety and customer service is maintained at a high level.
- 7. Eskola also has a full-time waterproofing division. This allows Eskola to provide total building envelop services to clients offering more streamlined communications since the client would only be dealing with a single contractor for multiple scopes. This would translate to cost savings as well since the same management team would be covering the work instead of two companies and two management teams being involved which increases overhead.
- 8. Eskola has a highly skilled sheet metal division to provide ancillary services to support our roofing and waterproofing services. There is a specialized metal crew which install sheet metal flashings and details full time. This allows the production crew to focus on their specialty and increase production quantities and also maintains quality with the metal details.
- 9. Over the last three years, Eskola has continued to invest in project management software. Because Eskola has moved to secure cloud based information sharing, communications between field operations and office management personnel is in real time This has also allowed Eskola to decrease the amount of paper used and move towards going green.

Performance and Quality Tracking:

One of the first steps to ensuring a quality installation is for Eskola to carefully assemble a crew with the correct certifications and trainings that will be required for the project. Employee certifications and trainings are taken into consideration as well as the field experience and job performance history of the employee. If there are any lapses in training, those are addressed before the project start. If any manufacturer training is required for refreshments, those are scheduled and taken care of prior to the project start. All of these steps are to ensure that the correct team is ready to provide a top notch roof installation for the client.



Eskola uses several techniques for measuring performance and tracking quality assurance. For quality assurance, a third-party inspection by the manufacturer is scheduled part way through the project and a final inspection at the completion of the project. The final job walkthrough will consist of the entire Eskola team, a manufacturer rep, and owner rep to review any issues that might be uncovered. Any items found for a punch list are immediately addressed. Eskola takes pride in achieving short punch lists which is a sign of a quality installation from the start.

Throughout the project, in-house inspections are performed by the project managers, superintendents, and owners. The jobsite manual with the drawings and details are reviewed to ensure correct install practices are being followed per the manufacturer's requirements and the architect's drawings and specifications. Any deviations are addressed and corrected.

Eskola's project management team have a post project analysis checklist to review any project challenges that occurred, what caused them, how could they have been avoided, what solutions were implemented, how effective those were and could there have been better decisions made. In addition to this analysis, the PMs will hold a debriefing with the client's POC for feedback to further develop improvements regarding any future work.

Eskola's Safety Program:

Eskola LLC is firmly committed to providing all employees with a safe work environment and do everything possible to prevent workplace accidents. Eskola LLC provides proper training to all employees at any level to ensure all employees are up to date with new and existing regulations and standards. Eskola LLC management and supervision are in charge of monitoring, incorporating, and promoting safety during any given crew's daily tasks by. Eskola has an in-house score card which crews, foremen, superintendents, project managers and branch managers are all scored on a list of safety points and practices. This is evaluated annually with incentives to promote best safety practices. To ensure compliance and to promote safety throughout the company, Eskola's Safety Department also conducts random unannounced visits to all sites on a weekly basis.

Employee Training Assurance:

Eskola's certified safety manager maintains employee specific files with all certifications and trainings. Quarterly and annual audits are performed to check these files for expirations or additional trainings required. In addition to the files, an up-to-date roster with training expiration dates is kept



digitally. Our certified safety manager performs in house training including OSHA 10, OSHA 30, Fall Protection, First Aid/CPR and Forklift and Manlift training to name the major classes.

For onsite checks, Eskola also has a hardhat sticker indicator that is displayed on each employee's hat showing which trainings have been performed. This easily allows the foremen and superintendents to manage crew members based on their training and eliminates having an underqualified crew member perform tasks they should not do.

Employee Assignment:

When hiring an employee, Eskola performs an extensive interview process to learn about current training, certifications, experience, and craft knowledge. With the needs of the company clearly defined, an initial screening process based on the candidate's application and resume begins. After the initial screening is completed, the narrowed down candidates enter a two-phase interview process. Once a candidate is selected for the position to be filled, they go through a drug screening and all safety trainings prior to beginning the job onboarding training period. This training period includes shadowing a current employee and learning Eskola's systems, procedures, and standard practices.

For project specific assignments, Eskola carefully identifies the scope of work to be performed, the client and client's campus or building, the particular project challenges and the logistics surrounding performing the work. After analysis, Eskola then assigns the foreman and crew with the correct skillset and experience to handle the project. Project Managers are also assigned based on their experience and skill set.

Customer Costs and Management Control:

Prior to project award, Eskola will assist the owner, architect or other involved parties in discovering the design requirements and goals of the owner. Through this process Eskola will provide suggestions based on previous experience to offer ideas regarding roofs systems which will best serve the owner and meet warranty expectations. As an example, Eskola has been working with a food production industry leader to provide roofs that will be able to withstand the oils that are expelled onto the roof, meet FM requirements, FDA requirements and provide the owner with a roof that will last decades. The do this Eskola recommended a PVC hybrid roof system for durability and long-lasting life.



During the bidding phase and if permitted, Eskola has also provided voluntary alternates to owners. After examining the specifications and documents, occasionally Eskola is able to recommend alternate systems which will provide the performance needed but offer a cost savings to the owner creating a win-win situation. Post bid, if an owner is open to suggestions, Eskola has provided additional alternates once in depth evaluations have occurred of the site and of the owner's goals. As an example, at ORNL 8610, the original design was for a liquid applied PPMA roof system. This system had several advantages because it offered the ability to be applied in situations where roof top units were crowed creating difficult applications for other systems. The challenge was the odors and fumes created by the system. Eskola was able to provide an alternate which reduced fumes, still allowed for simple application and also gave the owner a cost savings.

Once a project is awarded, Eskola will have a management team consisting of Estimating, Safety and Project Management (Service, Waterproofing onsite superintendent) complete a site evaluation and handoff. During this handoff, Eskola will address the following points:

- 1. Site and roof access
- 2. Roof system being installed v.s. possible equivalent roof system if available (cost savings)
- 3. Site safety assessment for initial project safety plan and evaluate for permanent roof safety systems for customers in need
- 4. Schedule development
- 5. Identify other areas that are not roof related that could be cause of potential leak areas(windows, wall joints etc..)
- 6. Evaluate areas for service items to extend the life of existing roofs and new roof being installed

In regards to any project change orders, Eskola will look to have a cost-effective solution identified with manufacture spec prior to submittal. This reduces engineering cost to the customer based on need of verification of specification only required. Example of cost saving for customers; during new roof project closeout, Eskola service manager was onsite for warranty handoff. Discussion of other potential roof work was addressed. Eskola was able to offer a PM service plan for existing roofs, this extended the life of the roofs by 3 to 5 years, allowing the customer to budget future roof project into their capital budgets. This eliminated the use of emergency funds or O&M cost and allows for future scheduling, eliminating high peak season demand for roof work (short time frame completions with overtime rates = high cost).

Quality Assurance is very important at Eskola. We believe that quality, safety and service are three cornerstones to providing a job well done to the owner. Our quality assurance program is simple and built into our management style and is fundamental in the process.

Every week the Project Manager (PM) assigned to the job performs a site visit. His walks include checking safety, reviewing the scope with the foreman, troubleshooting any issues that are projected to come up, doublechecking manpower and man hours to gauge the schedule, checking the current work against the design details for compliance, and in general making sure that the project is up to industry standards of quality and practice.

The assigned General Superintendent (GS) also walks weekly and more often several times a week. He follows the same protocol as the PM by addressing safety, installation practices, and making sure details are in compliance with manufacturer's requirements.

At 50%, 80% and 100% completion, an Eskola LLC Inspector performs a thorough project status inspection. He goes over with a fine tooth comb checking seams with a probe, checking details, reviewing data sheets and drawings. Any issues found are recorded and communicated directly to the PM and GS for immediate corrective action.

When substantial completion is reached, Eskola schedules the manufacturer's representative to come out and perform an inspection. Eskola's goal through the whole process is to minimize the punch list at the end of the project so close out is streamlined. After the manufacturer's inspection, the punch list is generated and Eskola schedules the work to address any issues that manufacturer found.

Once the punch list has been completed, a final walk through with the manufacturer's representative, Eskola's inspector and project manager and any owner or contractor representatives is scheduled and performed. This walk through is intended as a formality as Eskola expects all issues that were discovered to have been addressed at this point.

Post final walk through, the warranties are provided and close outs are finalized.
