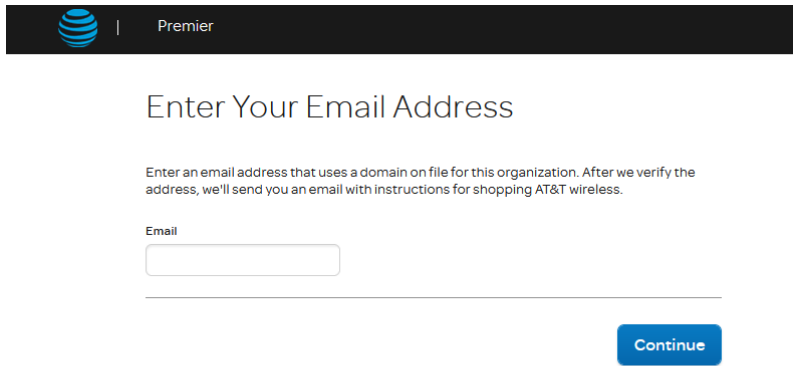
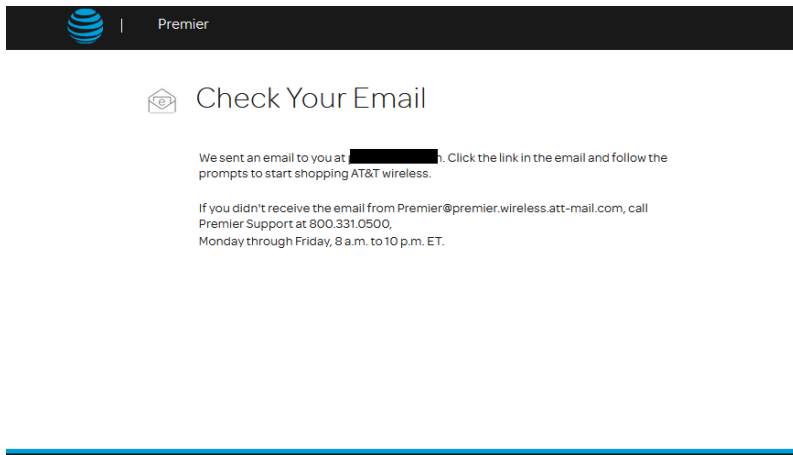


1. Go to: [AT&T Premier](#), enter your email address, and then click **Continue**.



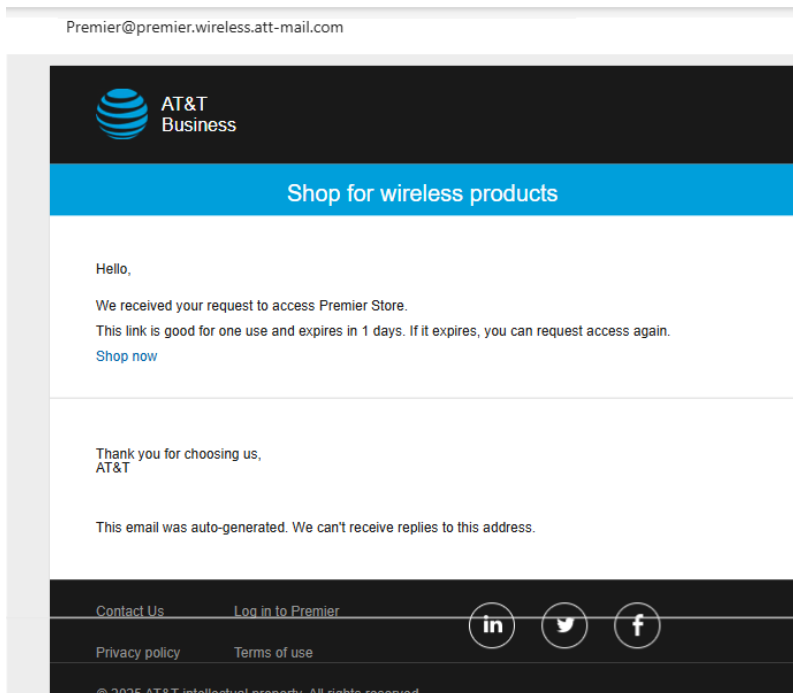

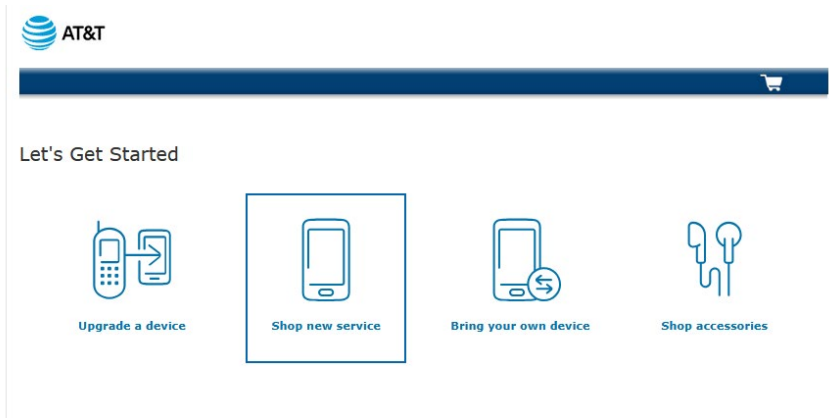
