PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

MANDATE: Under W. Va. Code \$5A-3-10a; no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political aubdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a cabor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the appregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTEDIS: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a ventor has contested any tax administrated pursuant to chapter elevan of the W. Vz. Code, workers comparisation premium, permit top or environmental fee or essessment and the matter has not become first or where the ventor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the ventor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DÉFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any essessment, premium, penalty, line, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a hidgment, line, penult visitation, license assessment, defaulted workers' companisation premium, penulty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or excitional penulties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outsitending balance or fability to the old fund or to the unbaured employers' fund or boling in policy default, as defined in W. Vs. Code § 25/20-2, failure to maintein mandatory workers' companisation coverage, or failure to fully most its obligations as a workers' companisation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the insurance Commissioner and femalins in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, mentage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five perpent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vender's authorized signer affirms and authorizedges under penalty of law for false awaring (W. Vs. (Gode 861-5-3) that neither vender nor any related party one a dain as defined above and that neither vender nor any related early are in employer default as defined shove, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.
