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1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1.1 Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, equipment and anything incidental to the installation of the following equipment at Lakin Hospital.
 - 1 Hobart "or equal" Model CRS66A commercial dishwashing unit with a 30 KW pressure less booster heater, stainless steel vent hoods with vent stack and locking damper, and electric blower-dryer or equal
 - 2. Hobart "or equal" DDU38 direct drive unloader to be constructed of 14-gauge steel with covered corners and attached to the clean side of the dishwasher by stainless steel bolts. The unit shall be 208/240 volt, 3 phase.
 - 3. Hobart "or equal" SL-30 Side Loader. Stainless steel, reciprocating, 14 gauge with covered corners attached to the dishwasher chamber with stainless steel bolts. Sump has 1 ½ drain connection and perforated stainless steel strainer cover over drain opening.
 - 4. Stainless steel clean dish table attached to unloader.
 - 5. Stainless steel soiled dish table, with disposer with pre-rinse sink and prerinse spray attached to side loader.
- 1.2 This shall be a 100% turnkey installation. All work will be in compliance with the Fire Marshall regulations and all other building codes and industry standards. Final payment will be withheld if installed components are not in compliance, or any portion of this overall project is not 100% complete. The award will be made to the overall low bid that complies with the specifications.
- 1.3 The words "will", "must", and "shall" identify a mandatory requirement.

2. BIDDER REQUIREMENTS:

- 2.1 All vendors shall attend the mandatory vendor prebid conference to discuss any questions; measurements of job site; or concerns of the bid and to examine the job site.
- 2.2 It is the vendor's responsibility to verify all field conditions and limitations prior to bidding. It is also the vendor's responsibility to notify the West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources in writing, of conditions detrimental to proper and timely completion of the repair/upgrade. Do not proceed until nonconforming conditions have been corrected.

3. SCOPE OF WORK:

3.1 Minor deviations from the stated specification not listed as mandatory (must, shall, or will) are acceptable to facilitate a competitive bidding atmosphere provided the intent of the Request for Quotation or the effectiveness of the

system is not compromised.

- The objective of this RFQ to obtain a contract for the delivery, purchase, set up installation of a Hobart Model CRS66A Dishwasher "or equal". The dishwasher is a fully automatic, right to left operation, 202 racks per hour, top mounted controls, stainless steel frame (chamber 6" higher than standard), stainless steel anticlogging fixed wash arms, automatic fill, fixed pump intake screen, with a 3 phase, 10 28 amp, 208/240 volt motor.
 - 3.2.1 Contractor shall furnish and install tray rack constructed of plastic and stainless steel with chrome-plated wire for Hobart "or equal" C-Line Models 6" higher than standard.
 - 3.2.2 Contractor shall furnish and install a stainless steel vent hood (4 X 16) with vent stack and locking-type damper designed to fit either end of the dishwasher.
 - 3.2.3 Contractor shall furnish and install a Hobart "or equal" Model number DDU38-R/L Direct Drive unloader with a ¾" brass pressure regulator.
 - 3.2.4 Contractor shall provide and install an electric blower-dryer (3-phase only).
 - 3.2.5 Contractor shall provide and install a stainless steel booster heater, 30 KW minimum.
- Contractor shall furnish and install a Hobart "or equal" Dishwasher Disposer Model Number FD3/300-1, with 3 HP motor, aluminum housing, adjustable feet, 208/240 volts, 3 phase
- 3.4 Contractor shall furnish and install a clean dish table sized and shaped per the space dedicated for this component. Unit shall be constructed with 300 series 14-gauge stainless steel top. Top has 10" backsplash at rear with 45-degree turn back at top. Unit shall be sloped toward dishwasher. Table shall be built to match up with Unloader.
- 3.5 Contractor shall furnish and install a sink mixing faucet with 12" swing nozzle, wall mounted, 8" centers on sink faucet with ½" IPS male inlets.
- Contractor shall furnish and install soiled dish table sized and shaped per the space dedicated for this component. Unit shall be constructed with 300 series 14-gauge stainless steel top. Top has 10" backsplash at rear with 45 degrees turn back at top. Unit shall be sloped toward dishwasher. Table shall be built to match up with Side Loader and include a Pre-rinse sink welded in ring, scrap trough 6" wide X 54" long flowing into sink.
- 3.7 Contractor shall furnish and install an easy install pre rinse unit, wall mounted,

- base faucet with spring check cartridges and level handles, 1" long NPT male inlets, 15" overhang, 18" riser, and a flexible hose.
- The completed equipment and installation must meet the requirements of the National Sanitary Foundation (NSF) and American Society of Sanitary Engineering Standard No. 1004.
- Contractor shall identify necessary materials and electrical equipment to be installed and prepare shop drawings for approval on all fire and/or smoke-rated wall and floor penetrations. Contractor shall install equipment to facilitate servicing, maintenance, and repair or replacement of equipment components. As much as practical, connect equipment for ease of disconnecting, with minimum of interference with other installations.
- 3.10 Any wire ways the Contractor installs shall be of types, sizes, and number of channels as necessary to complete scope of work. Fittings and accessories including but not limited to couplings, offsets, elbows, expansion joints, adapters, and end caps shall match and mate with wire way as required for a complete system.
- 3.11 Contractor shall cut existing construction to provide for installation of electrical components and the subsequent fitting and patching shall be required to restore surfaces to their original or better condition.
- 3.12 Contractor shall determine load requirements. Contractor shall be responsible for installation of the dishwasher line that is in compliance with all Federal, State, and local building and sanitation codes.
- 3.13 Hospital maintenance staff will remove the existing dishwasher and prepare the room for installation of new equipment. In accordance with Section 2.2, Contractor shall notify owner of any condition detrimental to the installation of the new equipment.

4. INSPECTION:

- 4.1 Contractor shall inspect existing conditions governing this work during pre-bid site inspection to determine conditions and extent of work required. No allowance will be made subsequently on behalf of the contractor for any error or negligence on his part in connection with this requirement.
- The Contractor shall inspect all elements subject to movement or damage prior to commencing work.

5. SHOP DRAWINGS:

5.1 Contractor shall provide shop drawings to owner for approval specifying products and installation methods for the scope of work as defined in Section 3. A notice to proceed will be issued indicating approval of the shop drawings.

6. TEMPORARY FACILITIES:

- The Owner will provide normal electrical supply from the currently installed electrical system in the building for the use of the contractor. However, the Owner provides no guarantee or warranty as to the systems condition or capabilities. The Contractor shall assure himself that the electrical system is adequate for his requirements or supply additional temporary electrical power at his own expense.
- Any damage to the electrical system resulting from misuse or abuse to the existing electrical system shall be repaired or replaced by the contractor at no expense to the owner.

7. COORDINATION OF WORK:

- 7.1 The Contractor shall coordinate with the maintenance supervisor for the proper relation of the work to the building structure and to the employees therein. In the event of conflict the building employees shall prevail.
- 7 2 The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to protect the interior of the building from debris, dust or any residue occurring from the scope of work.
- 7.3 The Contractor shall provide the Owner with a schedule of work seven calendar days prior to the start of the work. The Owner shall be notified of any variances to the work schedule two (2) working days prior to the change.

8. WARRANTY: (GUARANTEE)

- The Contractor shall warrant to the Owner all materials and equipment will be new, and that all work will be of good quality, free from faults and defects in conformance with the contract documents. All work not conforming to these requirements may be considered defective. If the product warranty requires the contractor to have a factory representative to inspect and approve the installation, that will be completed prior to Owner acceptance.
- All materials and equipment shall be of current year production of manufacturer and manufactured for commercial usage. Used, reconditioned or remanufactured equipment is <u>not</u> acceptable.

9. PERMITS:

9.1 The Contractor shall secure and pay for the building permit and for all other permits, governmental fees and licenses which are necessary for the proper execution and completion of the work as specified.

10. CLEAN UP:

10.1 The Contractor shall keep the work area as clean as possible during the entire progress of work, and shall be responsible to remove from the site, the packaging materials from his products and other debris as it accumulates. All items of equipment that are removed, to allow the installation of new items, will become the property of the contractor to dispose of at a landfill or location authorized to accept the items as waste or recycled parts.

11. WAGE RATES:

11.1 The Contractor and any sub-contractors shall pay the higher of the U.S.

Department of Labor Minimum wage rates or of the West Virginia Department of

Labor wage rates as established for MASON County pursuant to West Virginia

Code 21-5-1, et seq. West Virginia Department of Labor Wage Rates are

available at website: http://www.wvsos.com/adlaw/wagerates/building06.htm

12. PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- 12.1 The Contractor shall submit to the Owner, one original invoice, (when the contracted work is completed in its entirety) and upon inspection and approval by the Owner.
- The Owner reserves the right to refuse payment in the event the completed work is not in accordance with industry standards or sub-standard in any way, or, if the amount requested is not within the agreed upon terms of the contract.

13. TERM OF WORK:

13.1 All work shall be complete within 90 calendar days from the approval of the shop drawings.

14. DELAYS AND EXTENSION OF TIME:

14.1 If the Contractor is delayed at any time in the progress of the work by any act or neglect of the Owner or by any employee of the Owner, or by any separate contractor employed by the Owner, or by changes in the work, or by labor disputes, fire, unusual delay in transportation, adverse weather conditions not reasonably anticipated, unavoidable casualties, or any other cause which the Owner determines may justify the delay, then the contract time may be extended by written approval of the Owner.

15. TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT STORAGE:

15.1 Contractor may set a trailer or temporary storage building on the site for all equipment and tools. The Contractor is responsible for his tools, equipment and materials.

16. SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

16.1 The Contractor shall provide safety barriers around work areas where heavy equipment may be in operation when placing materials in the building or as required by OSHA.

17. DAMAGES:

- 17 1 Any damages occurring to the building or property resulting from the contractor's performance of this work shall be the responsibility of the contractor to repair at his expense, either by using his own forces or that of an approved subcontractor. The repair method and finished product will be subject to the approval of the owner.
- 17.2 Insurance Requirements: Insurance certificates are required prior to award but are not required at the time of bid. Vendor shall present evidence of insurance at the time of award in the types and amounts required by the Agency and acceptable to the State. Included in the required insurance coverage shall be the following:
 - 1. For bodily injury (including death): minimum of \$500,000 per person & \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
 - 2. For property damage and liability: minimum of \$250,000 per occurrence.

18. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW AND REGULATIONS

The vendor shall pay any sales, use, and personal property taxes arising out of this contract and the transactions contemplated thereby. Any other taxes levied upon this contract, the transaction, or the equipment, or services delivered pursuant hereto shall be borne by the vendor. The vendor shall comply with all related federal and state laws and regulations. The vendor shall comply with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations including, but not limited to those relating to hospital licensor, State and Federal labor laws and laws, rules, and policies related to the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources.

19. BID RESPONSE:

- 19.1 Bidder shall submit one lump sum bid for all the work under all the terms and conditions as described herein.
- 19.2 Successful bidder should submit full commercial warranty information with the bid. The warranty information shall minimally contain the product warranty and labor warranty product.
- 19.3 Vendor is requested to attach descriptive literature of the equipment being bid.

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AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states:

No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION:

The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

LICENSING:

Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agencies or political subdivision. Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules. Vendors should visit www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy for the Notice of Agency Confidentiality Policies.
