- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.

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The West Virginia Division of Highways is soliciting bids for the removal of three (3) underground storage tanks at the Wayne County Headquarters.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Contractor shall provide all material, equipment and labor to remove three UST's and all associated product lines, vent lines and the pump island.

SYSTEM DESCRIPTION

The tank field is composed of one 10,000 gallon diesel tank, one 10,000 gallon gas tank and one 1,000 gallon used oil tank. All three tanks are fiberglass.

The tanks are overlaid with a 37' x 40' concrete slab. The product lines and vent lines are covered by asphalt pavement.

The length of the gas line is about 57 feet. The Diesel line is about 36 feet. The vent lines are close to 48 feet.

The used oil tank is not in the same tank pit as the gas and diesel tanks. It is next to the main building covered with asphalt pavement.

There are two monitor wells within the tank field to be removed by the contractor.

The pumps will be removed and electrical service to the tanks will be terminated by state forces prior to contract work.

WORK TIME

Work shall be performed from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday thru Friday. Alternate work hours will be considered at the request of the Contractor. The Contractor will also notify the DOH five (5) days prior to the start of work.

CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION

The Contractor shall have a West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection class "B" certified employee on site throughout the duration of the project.

TANK CONTENTS

The Contractor will be responsible for the removal of all solid and liquid contents from the tank interiors. These contents should be placed in approved containment drums and removed from the site prior to demobilization. Disposal manifests of the drums should be included in the closure report

TANK DISPOSAL

All tanks, vent lines, product lines and observation well piping shall become the property of the Contractor and be removed prior to demobilization. PHOTOIONIZATION DETECTOR

The Contractor shall provide a photoionization detector and operator to determine field values of contamination.

CONTAMINATED EXCAVATION

Contaminated soil found within the tank pit, up to 10 cubic yards, shall be removed and stockpiled on site. The Contractor will provide the equipment needed to transport the soil and plastic with straw bales to contain the stockpile.

CONTAMINATED LIQUIDS

Contaminated liquids within the tank pit are to be removed and disposed of by the Contractor. Waste disposal manifests of this liquid should be included in the closure report.

ANALYTICAL TESTING

The Contractor shall be prepared for the sampling and testing of liquids and solids within the excavated area. The number of samples and kind of tests will be dictated by the WVDEP. Analytical results should be included in the closure report.

TANK PIT BACKFILL

The Contractor shall provide the equipment and labor needed to backfill the excavated area to the original contours. The DOH will provide the backfill material.

The excavated concrete slab shall not be placed in the backfill. It will be stockpiled on site.




The Contractor will comply with all federal, state and local regulations pertaining to safety and environmental laws throughout the course of this project.

The Contractor shall furnish five (5) copies of the closure report. Two (2) copies of the report will be given to the WVDOH and three (3) will be given to the WVDEP.



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

### PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

**LICENSING:** Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agencies or political subdivision. Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

**CONFIDENTIALITY:** The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules. Vendors should visit **www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy** for the Notice of Agency Confidentiality Policies.




