- Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.

ABOVE GROUND FUEL TANK INSTALLATION

West Virginia Department of Highways is seeking contractors to bid on plumbing and electrical work to complete the installation of 10,000 gallon, dual compartment fuel tanks. The attached diagram indicates the bunghole outside diameters on top of tank. The tanks are configured to accept dispensers on opposite sides or both dispensers on one side of the tank. Depending on the site specific location of the tank, the quantity of pipe and conduit will vary slightly. All work must meet the standards of NFPA 30A (Code for Motor Fuel Dispensing Facilities and Repair Garages). The West Virginia State Fire Marshall will provide a post construction inspection.

The following items will be performed by WVDOH and are excluded from the contract: Submit site plan to WV Fire Marshall
Concrete pad installation
Electrical conduit to pad and to the emergency shutoff device
Install pipe bollards around perimeter of concrete pad
Set 10000 gallon tank on pad
Ground tank to ground rods
Install steps on both ends of tank

Electrical and plumbing contract items: (note: The components supplied by WVDOH are incomplete and the contractor will be responsible for purchasing the additional components. All labor and equipment are to be included in the contractors' bid)

1) Beginning at the existing electrical conduit stubbed out of the concrete pad – purchase and install (2) hazardous location round outlet box with 3 sides T with ¾ inch hubs with hazardous location seal fitting.

2) Purchase and install ¾ inch hazardous location conduit from round outlet box to diesel dispenser, gas dispenser, and Warrick control unit with hazardous location seal fittings (3) at each location. Purchase and install ¾ inch conduit beam clamps place on 4 ft centers.

3) Install hazardous location seal fitting (2) at diesel and gas dispensers and connect to ¾ inch conduit. From seal fitting to dispensers connect ¾ inch x 4 inch nipple to bottom of dispensers.

4) From each dispenser install 4 inch x ¾ inch nipple to hazardous location seal fitting to ¾ inch conduit to each pump (furnished) located on top of tank.

5) Mount the furnished Warrick control unit at the end of tank where the electrical conduit is stubbed in concrete pad. Contractor supplies the mounting bracket.

6) From already installed round outlet box – install ¾ inch conduit to Warrick control unit. From control unit mount hazardous location ½ inch seal fitting to ½ inch conduit to top of tank to ½ inch T (1/2 inch round outlet box with 3 sides with ½ inch hubs). From ½ inch T hub install ½ inch conduit to leak detection sensors at the diesel and gas tank compartments. Connect 18 gauge shielded wire from each sensor to Warrick control alarm unit.

7) At each pump (located on top of tank) install ½ inch nipple to ½ inch hazardous location seal fitting to ½ inch conduit to solenoid valve (purchase 2 each 1½ inch hubs, 120 volts, 30 watts, min. pressure = 0 psi, max pressure = 101 psi, explosion proof for hazardous location) for feul line. From solenoid valve install 1½ inch black iron pipe to each pump and install 1½ inch black iron pipe from solenoid valve to product line bung on top of tank. Use 12 gauge wire from each solenoid valve to 20 amp breaker at panel box. Purchase and install emergency shut off switch.

8) From product line bung install furnish product line to within 4 inches of tank bottom.

9) From each pump on top of tank purchase and install 1 inch black pipe to 1 inch ball valve located next to each dispenser. From each ball valve connect to fuel filter lid and from the fuel filter lid connect to dispenser hose and then to dispenser nozzle. (lids and hoses furnished)


10) At top of tank – purchase and install 3 inch black iron pipe from 7 inch fill bung (reducer furnished) to 4 inch fill pipe inside diesel and gas compartments. Note: all black pipe must be painted yellow for diesel and white for all other pipe. 2 coats each.

11) At top center of tank on diesel compartment – purchase and install 3 inch T to the 5 inch bung using 3 inch close nipple. From T leg to 90 degree 3 inch elbow to vent line (3inch x 22 inch vent line, vent cap furnished). From 3rd leg of T attach the furnished fuel gauge. Repeat procedure beginning at gas compartment bung.

12) Upon completion of installation and inspection by the WV State Fire Marshall, the tanks will be filled and the contractor shall purge both pumps and calibrate both dispenser meters. The contractor shall present the State Fire Marshall inspector a letter indicating that a WV licensed electrician has completed the electrical work and that it meets the National Electrical Code.

13) Contractor shall provide following decals/signs indicating "DIESEL, GAS, NO SMOKING, and EMERGENCY SHUT OFF".

The location of the tank installations for this bid are: WVDOH maintenance facility in Goshen Road Sub-Headquarters, I79 Exit 146; Coopers Rock Sub-Headquarters, I68 Exit 15; Fellowsville Maintenance Facility, Route 50 (Preston Co.); Taylor County Headquarters, Route 250 Pruntytown.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agencies or political subdivision. Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules. Vendors should visit **www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy** for the Notice of Agency Confidentiality Policies.
