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



- 7.6. Our Sakai SW320 wheelbase is 77" instead of 68". However, our inside and outside turning radiuses are shorter than the IR DD24 you last purchased, and our inside turning radius is shorter than the Terex TV1200 you purchased prior to the Terex. The reason for the shorter turning radius is due to our 35 degree articulation, which is greater than most other machines. Also, the longer wheelbase can result in better stability.

When the oil filter starts to become restricted, a warning light indicates the situation, giving the operator at least a day to have the filter changed, This system does not allow dirty oil to bypass into the engine. Most of the vibratory rollers in this size range use the same Kubota diesel engine with this system.
