

1.0 INTRODUCTION

JFHQ is made-up of several buildings and facilities on both sides of Coonskin Drive. The WVARNG intends to reinforce the existing natural or man-made obstacles using a system of concrete and post and cable barriers to provide for a more secure environment

2.0 LOCATION

JFHQ is located on Coonskin Drive prior to entry to Coonskin Park. Coonskin Drive and the buildings are relatively level through the site though the facilities are generally located several feet above the elevation of the road.

3.0 SCOPE / OBJECTIVE

It is the desire of the WVARNG to install a functional barrier system that can be easily maintained, won't detract from the appearance of facilities, and may be modified or removed at a later date and will use the slope between our facilities and Coonskin Drive and incorporates previously installed barriers and gates.

4.0 REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

4.1 Project Specific:

- 4.1.1 Site: The attached schematic is an approximation provided for general information (See Attachment 3). The awarded contractor will be responsible for field measuring all distances and surveyor support as needed. These specifications include reference to Carr Concrete Protector Guard Wall CCC-PGW-100 or like item (See Attachment 1). If used as part of a bid, a submittal for like items must be included that lists materials, dimensions, weight, method of handling, finish, means of manufacture, and manufacture lead-time. Barriers are intended to be parallel or perpendicular to Coonskin Drive whenever possible and generally aligned to one-another. Installation may require modification to specified length of individual barriers.
- 4.1.2 Concrete Barrier System: The barrier system will be of modular concrete design consistent with Carr Concrete Protector Guard Wall CCC-PGW-100. Installation will be consistent with attached design and will generally be imbedded in slope. All sections will be placed on excavated and compacted soil with a 4" topping of compacted gravel. The excavation will be accomplished so that cut will equal the amount of material needed to fill the up-slope side of the section level to the top (No material is to be removed from the site without consent from the WVARNG) (See Attachment 2).

- 4.1.3 Runs: A 4' gap, outside edge to outside edge, will be left between stairwell and wall, gatepost and wall, and breaks in wall runs. Continuous lengths of wall run should be no greater than 70'. Barrier segments will begin and end in a post.
- 4.1.4 Seeding: The contractor will seed, fertilize, and mulch all disturbed areas and will submit fertilizer and seed content for approval prior to application.
- 4.1.5 Erosion: The contractor is responsible for developing and submitting runoff and erosion control measures or permits as necessary.
- 4.1.6 Funding: This project is based upon availability of funding; sum or all of the segments in Attachment 3 may represent the final scope of this project.
- 4.2 General
- 4.2.1. Construction will follow all national and state building codes.
- 4.2.2. The developed and approved design will be utilized for all construction.
- 4.2.3. All construction will result in a complete and functional system unless noted otherwise.
- 4.2.4. All construction activities will be in conjunction with OHSA, Safety and Health Requirements Manual (US Army Corps of Engineers) and FFA. As noted, the Army safety and health standards mirror OHSA. All construction activities on site will be a hardhat area and marked as such.
- 4.2.5. Access to the site will be restricted and controlled by the Contractor. A visitor's sign-in and hardhats are to be made available for personnel visiting site.
- 4.2.6. Fueling and open flame: Any operation will be maintained in accordance with OHSA and WV Fire Marshall Standards to included secondary containment, fire extinguishers, and spill control.
- 4.2.7. Cleanup is required daily. No open dumps of construction materials. Remove surplus soil material, unsuitable topsoil, obstructions, demolished materials, and waste materials including trash and debris, and legally dispose of them off Owner's property. Consideration will be given to relocating crushed pavement, gravel and clean soil on the property with the owner's permission.
- 4.2.8 Contractor is responsible for keeping driveways and entrances serving the premises clear and available for the Owner's use.
- 4.2.9 Repair to damaged structures, contents, and surrounding grounds will be the contractor's responsibility.

- 4.2.10 The contractor shall not use WVARNG facilities without prior approval; this includes dumpsters, restrooms, phones, or utilities.
- 4.2.11 Contractor shall coordinate storage of materials and equipment park locations with the WVARNG.
- 4.2.12 WVARNG sites are secure. Coordination must be made for all personnel, equipment, materials, deliveries, and sub-contractors. ID such as a driver's license is required. All personnel and vehicles are subject to search.
- 4.2.13 All work will be supervised. The WVARNG will be provided the name of the onsite person in charge with a means of immediate contact.
- 4.2.14 The contractor is responsible for paying current and applicable prevailing wage rates and providing certified payrolls as directed.
- 4.2.15 In accordance with FAR 11.504(b) and DFARS 211.504(b), liquidated damages will be assessed for each calendar day required to complete the construction work on this project past the scheduled completion date. The contractor has complete control of the pace of work. Liquidated damages shall be assessed at a rate of \$1,345.13 as follows:

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agencies or political subdivision. Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
