- Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.

- **Method of Collection:** Vendor will collect all urine samples in compliance with 49 CFR Part 40 protocols. The split sample method of urine collection will be followed as described in the aforementioned regulation.
- Equipment to be Used: Urine collections will be conducted using standard test kits and Control and Custody Forms like those required by the USDOT in 49 CFR part 40 (and Part 382 or 219 as applicable) for all regulated collections.
- Random Testing Pool Establishment and Selection Criteria: All random selections will be made in a manner consistent with regulations found in 49 CFR parts 40 and 382.
- **Scheduling of Testing:** Vendor will convey random testing selection information to the designated representative on a monthly basis.
- **Situations:** Special situations will be handled in a manner consistent with applicable regulations for such testing. Vendor will coordinate special collections with the WVSP designated representative. Emergency situations will be handled by providing the designated representative with a list of phone numbers for after hours and holiday use.





"Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agencies or political subdivision. Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

**CONFIDENTIALITY:** The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules. In regards to RFQ DPS0817, could you please answer the following questions to better help in answering the bid.

1. How many tests yearly are performed at collection facilities and how many tests yearly are performed on-site at the WV State Police Barracks?

2. Could you please provide a listing of each barrack location that on-site testing will occur? Or will all collections occur at one location?

3. What is the time of frame of scheduling on-site testing for each of the WV State Police at each barracks from when the random list is presented to the vendor and WV State Police? One day, one week, one month etc.

# Answers from the agency:

- 1. Approximately 80% of the tests are performed at State Police barracks, with the other 20% walking into collection facilities. Our current provider uses collection facilities in Kanawha, Cabell and Jefferson Counties. Employees randomly selected from those counties walked into a collection facility. A collector was sent to all other locations and collected at the detachments. Currently, based on manpower, we are doing 24 tests per month.
- 2. There are about 60 detachments located in the 55 counties. Collections could be scheduled at any of them. The complete list with addresses and phone numbers can be found at <a href="https://www.wystatepolice.com">www.wystatepolice.com</a>
- 3. The random drug list is provided by the vendor to the State Police at the first of each month. The State Police will provide the vendor with dates, times and locations for each drug test. We attempt to provide you with a few days notice to accommodate scheduling. We try to schedule as many in the first part of the month as possible to ensure all collections are made. We collect from all employees on the list by the last day of the month.
