REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1.1 The West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources is requesting a quotation to provide all labor, equipment and anything incidental to the demolition, and legal disposal of all associated building material, asbestos and debris associated with the demolition of two (2) Buildings known as the Old Recreation Hall and the Substance Abuse Unit, on the grounds of the Mildred Mitchell Bateman Hospital located at 1530 Norway Avenue, Huntington, WV 25709
- 1.2 All work will be in compliance with the Fire Marshall regulations and all other building codes and industry standards. Final payment will be withheld if any portion of this overall project is not 100% complete. The award will be made to the overall low bid that complies with the specifications.
- 1.3 The words "will", "must", and "shall" identify a mandatory requirement.

2. BIDDER REQUIREMENTS:

- 2.1 It is the vendor's responsibility to verify all field conditions and limitations prior to bidding. It is also the vendor's responsibility to notify the West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources in writing, of conditions detrimental to proper and timely completion of the demolition. Do not proceed until nonconforming conditions have been corrected.
- 2.2 Due to the size and complexity of this project, a mandatory prebid conference will be held in the Conference Room in the Administration Building at 10:00 am on1/22/08Failure to attend the prebid conference will result in automatic bid rejection.

3. SCOPE OF WORK:

- 3.1 Contractor shall totally demolish and remove Building 11 (Recreation Hall) and Building 10 (Substance Abuse Unit) following the abatement of all asbestos materials per the included asbestos survey.
- 3.2 The basement walls and footers shall be shattered and then backfilled with building debris legal for use as backfill.
 - 3.2.1 Any additional building debris legal for use as backfill will be dumped over the hill directly behind the Substance Abuse Unit and and Old Recreation Hall and then spread to match the existing landscape, covered with 10 inches (minimum) of top soil, seeded

and strawed.

- 3.2.2 Compaction of backfill will be performed to obtain a minimum density equal to that of the surrounding ground.
- 3.3 Contractor shall remove and legally dispose of the windows, roofing material, building fixtures, interior partitions, contents and any other building debris and rubbish not permitted for use as backfill associated with the demolition project at an approved West Virginia Department of Natural Resources approved landfill.
- 3.4 Contractor shall take the building's footer and concrete slab (or any other type of flooring) down 10 inches (minimum) below grade.
- 3.5 Contractor shall spread 10 inches (minimum) of top soil over the work area blended to match surrounding topography and then seed and straw the area.
- 3.6 The Contractor shall remove and legally dispose of the asphalt driveway leading to the Substance Abuse Building and then seed and straw the area.
- 3.7 The Contractor shall remove and legally dispose of three pole mounted electrical transformers in front of the Substance Abuse Building.
- 3.7 Fill dirt is available on site.
- 3.8 All utilities are disconnected.
- 3.9 The Owner assumes no responsibility for the condition of the buildings to be demolished.
- 3.10 The use of explosives will be considered if legally permitted by all governing agencies.
- 3.11 In addition to Building 10 & 11, please provide a separate bid for each of the following buildings as an add alternate to remove hazardous materials and demolish each building as shown in priority order:
- 3.11.1 Building 6, Ground Garage 540 s.f.
- 3.11.2 Building 6, Ground Building and Apartment 5184 s.f.
- 3.11.3 Building 6. Environmental Office Building 1650 s.f.
- 3.11.4 Building 6, Breezeway Area 832 s.f.
- 3.11.5 Building 6, Carpenter Shop Bldg. (Basement, Shop, & 2nd Floor)-11088 s.f.
- 3.11.6 Building 8, Garage and Basement 2880 s.f.
- 3,11.7 Building 7, Powerhouse/Boiler Bldg. 3600 s.f.

4. INSPECTION:

- 4.1 Contractor shall inspect existing conditions governing this work before bidding to determine conditions and extent of work required. No allowance will be made subsequently on behalf of the contractor for any error or negligence on his part in connection with this requirement.
- 4.2 The Contractor shall inspect all elements subject to movement or damage prior to commencing work.

5. SHOP DRAWINGS:

5.1 No shop drawings are required for this project.

6. TEMPORARY FACILITIES:

- The Owner will provide normal electrical and water supply from the currently installed respective system in the main facility for the use of the contractor. However, the Owner provides no guarantee or warranty as to the systems condition or capabilities. The Contractor shall assure himself that the system is adequate for his requirements or supply additional temporary utility service at his own expense.
- 6.2 Any damage to the electrical or water system of the main facility resulting from misuse or abuse to the existing system shall be repaired or replaced by the contractor at no expense to the owner.

7. COORDINATION OF WORK:

7.1 The Contractor shall coordinate with the Project Manager for the proper relation of the work to the building structure.

8. WARRANTY: (GUARANTEE)

- 8.1 The Contractor shall warrant to the Owner all work will be of good quality, free from faults and defects in conformance with the contract documents. All work not conforming to these requirements may be considered defective.
- 8.2 Insurance Requirements: The vendor, as an independent contractor, is solely liable for the acts and omissions of its employees and agents. The vendor shall provide proof of insurance at the time the contract is awarded. The vendor shall maintain and furnish proof of coverage of liability insurance for loss, damage, or injury (including death) of third

parties arising from acts and omissions on the part of the vendor, its agents and employees in the following amounts:

- 1. for bodily injury (including death): a minimum of \$500,000.00 per person, a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence.
- 2. For property damage: a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence.

9. PERMITS:

9.1 The Contractor shall secure and pay for the building permit and for all other permits, governmental fees and licenses which are necessary for the proper execution and completion of the work as specified.

10. CLEAN UP:

10.1 The Contractor shall keep the work area as clean as possible during the entire progress of work, and shall be responsible to remove all debris and rubbish from the work site.

11. WAGE RATES:

11.1 The Contractor and any sub-contractors shall pay the higher of the U.S. Department of Labor Minimum wage rates or of the West Virginia Department of Labor wage rates as established for **Cabell County** pursuant to West Virginia Code 21-5-1, et seq. West Virginia Department of Labor Wage Rates are available at website: http://www.wvsos.com/adlaw/wagerates/building06.htm

12. PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- 12.1 The Contractor shall submit to the Owner one original invoice when the contracted work is completed in its entirety upon inspection and approval by the owner.
- 12.2 The Owner reserves the right to refuse payment in the event the completed work is not in accordance with industry standards or substandard in any way, or, if the amount requested is not within the agreed upon terms of the contract.

13. TERM OF WORK:

13.1 All work shall be complete within 120 calendar days upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

14. DELAYS AND EXTENSION OF TIME:

14.1 If the Contractor is delayed at any time in the progress of the work by any act or neglect of the Owner or by any employee of the Owner, or by any separate contractor employed by the Owner, or by changes in the work, or by labor disputes, fire, unusual delay in transportation, adverse weather conditions not reasonably anticipated, unavoidable casualties, or any other cause which the Owner determines may justify the delay, then the contract time may be extended by written approval of the Owner.

15. TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT STORAGE:

15.1 Contractor may set a trailer or temporary storage building on the site for all equipment and tools. The Contractor is responsible for his tools, equipment and materials.

16. SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

16.1 The Contractor shall provide safety barriers around work areas where heavy equipment may be in operation when placing materials in the building or as required by OSHA.

17. DAMAGES:


