REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
14. **HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM:** The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (<http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm>) is hereby made part of the agreement. 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1. DESCRIPTION

The box culvert shall have a 20'-0" span, 10'-0" rise, 48'-0" long and be designed for an HL-93 loading with less than two feet of fill. The box culvert shall be manufactured in twelve (12) 4'-0" long interlocking sections for a total length of 48'-0".

Two (2) exterior sections and ten (10) interior sections are required.

In addition to the box culvert the fabricator shall also supply in accordance with the attached plans all associated items included but not limited to the following:

Lifting/assembly hardware, rubber resin joint filler and self-adhesive exterior joint sealer.

2. ACCEPTANCE

Cracks developing in a box culvert section may be cause for rejection of the section. Cracks that are not detrimental to the structural integrity of the box culvert section, as determined by the Division of Highways, may be accepted under the following conditions:

- 1) Cracks of 0.004 inch or less shall be treated with a second coat of a Division of Highways approved concrete sealer.
- 2) Cracks of greater than 0.004 inch shall be treated by a Division of Highways approved epoxy injection methods. All concrete sealer and epoxy injection required for acceptance shall be performed at no additional cost to the Division of Highways.

3. DELIVERY

ALL BOX CULVERT SECTIONS AND ACCESSORIES SHALL BE DELIVERED TO THE PROJECT SITE DURING THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 26, 2009.

Upon receipt of a Purchase Order the Vendor shall submit shop drawings to the District Bridge Engineer within fifteen (15) calendar days. Shop drawings must be approved by the Division of Highways prior to the manufacture of any box culvert sections.

Should the Vendor fail to meet the above delivery schedule, liquidated damages will be assessed in accordance with Section 108.7 of the current Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges.

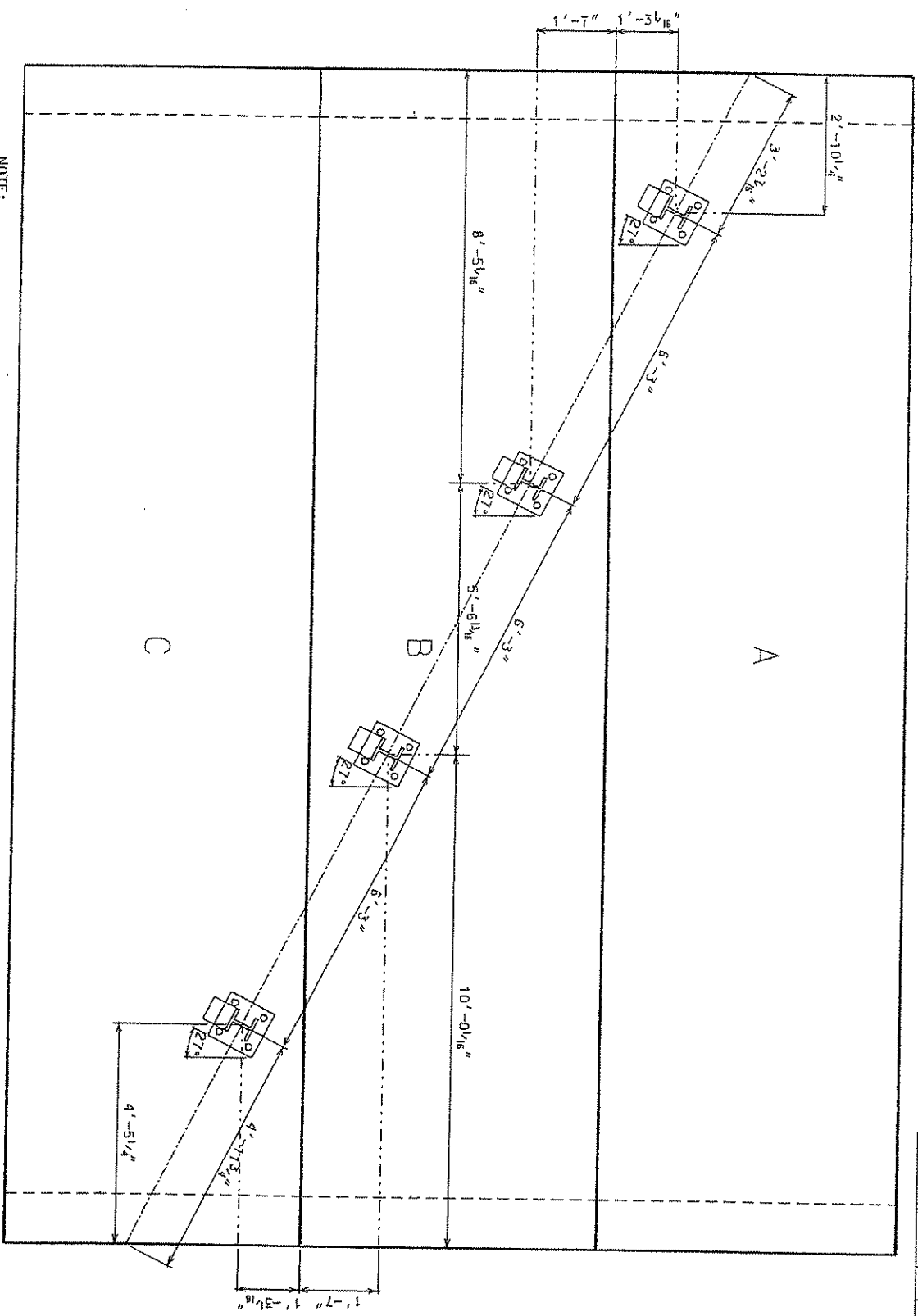
Sites for delivery of box culvert sections and accessories under this contract shall be accessible to equipment that is normally and customarily used for transportation of box culvert sections. Delivery will not be required where gross vehicle loaded weights will exceed the legal road or bridge load. Upon receipt of an approved Purchase Order, the Vendor must notify the District Bridge Engineer within ten (10) calendar days if delivery under the terms of this contract cannot be performed due to weight restrictions or roadway geometrics.

Prior to delivery, all box culvert sections, accessories and optional items shall be tested and accepted in accordance with Section 603 of the Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges adopted 2000, as modified by the January 1, 2009 Supplemental Specifications.

4. PARTIAL PAYMENT OF APPROVED BOX CULVERT

Upon completion of manufacture and approval by the Division of Highways of the box culvert specified on Purchase Order, the vendor may invoice and the Division will pay for the cost of manufacturing the box culvert, not to exceed 65% of the total cost of the delivered box culvert. Partial payment for the box culvert shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. The vendor must request partial payment and furnish an official invoice for the manufactured and approved box culvert.
- b. The partial payment invoice shall be accompanied by a surety bond equal to the invoiced amount guaranteeing delivery of all items specified on the Purchase Order.
- c. The vendor shall furnish a statement of approved box culvert condition and exact storage location.
- d. The vendor shall furnish a legal right-of-entry onto the storage site to Division of Highways' employees and/or agents for the purpose of inspecting, sampling, testing and removing any or all box culvert sections.
- e. The vendor shall certify that the stored box culvert sections are suitably marked and identified as property of the Division of Highways and will not be for any purpose not designated by the Division.

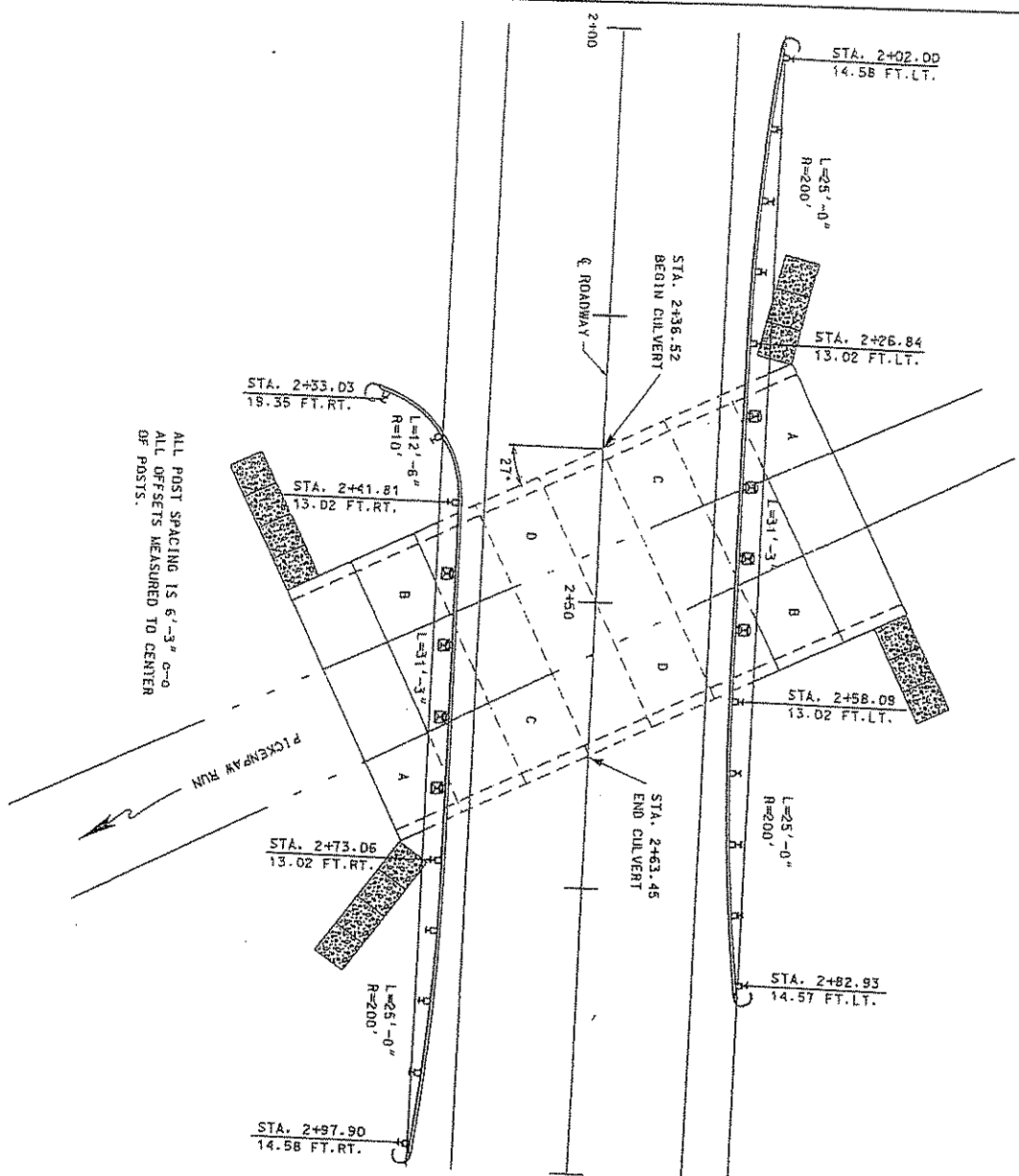

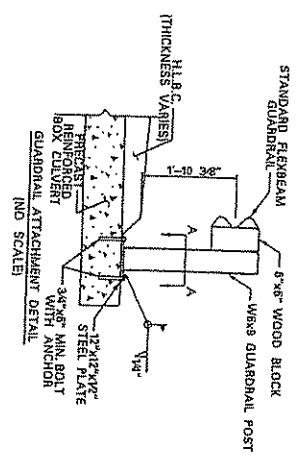
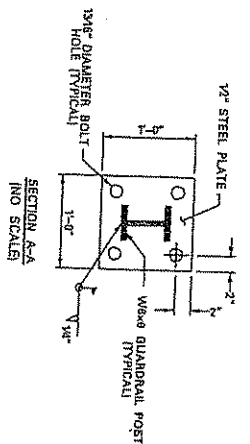

Certification and application* is hereby made for Preference in accordance with West Virginia Code, §5A-3-37. (Does not apply to construction contracts). West Virginia Code, §5A-3-37, provides an opportunity for qualifying vendors to request (at the time of bid) preference for their residency status.
