GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order
- 14. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 15. The following sections of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges, adopted 2000 and supplemented January 1, 2003 shall apply to the administration of this contract: Sections 101, 102.4, 102.5, 105.1, 105.3, 105.4, 105.10, 105.11, 105.12, 106.3, 106.4, 106.5, 106.6, 106.7, 106.9, 107.1, 107.2, 107.3, 107.14, 107.19, 107.20, 108.8, 109.1, 109.2, and 109.20

The terms "Contractor" and "Vendor" used in the above specifications of this contract are interchangeable. Contractor shall mean Vendor and Vendor shall mean Contractor.

West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges, adopted 2000 and supplemented January 1, 2003 may be obtained from:

WV Department of Transportation Division of Highways Building 5, Room A-729 1900 Kanawha Blvd., East Charleston, West Virginia 25305

Material supplied under this contract shall meet the applicable requirements of Section 710 of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges, adopted 2000 and supplemented January 1, 2003.

Material supplied under this contract shall be pressure treated using Chromated Copper Arsenate (CCA) – Type B or Type C, 100% pure oxide formulation only as the preserving salt. Kiln drying after treatment will not be necessary.

All treated material must be supplied from an approved preserving plant or acceptance testing and approval shall be obtained by the vendor prior to delivery. A list of approved treatment plants is available from:

West Virginia Division of Highways Materials Control, Soils and Testing 190 Dry Branch Road Charleston, West Virginia 25306

Pine Bridge Lumber (S4S)

Pine bridge lumber shall be No. 1 Dense or better, surfaced four sides and CCA treated in accordance with AWPA Standards to .60 pounds per cubic foot salt retention.

Oak Bridge Lumber (Rough Sawed)

Oak bridge lumber shall meet the standards of the National Hardwood Lumber Association for Sound Square Edge. Oak lumber shall be un-surfaced, but shall be sized by being processed through a hit or miss surfacer. White Oak Only

BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS

Vendors shall not qualify bids. Any qualifications of the bids or any modification of the specifications or conditions governing the bids may be cause to reject the bid.

Vendors shall include a copy of treatment specification with their bid.

Low bidder will be determined based on total estimated purchase and will not be awarded on an item by item basis

DELIVERY

Vendor shall complete delivery of lumber to the West Virginia Division of Highways storage lot located on US Route 219, 1 mile North of Elkins, WV 26241. Maximum bundle weight of the lumber delivered shall be 6,000 pounds.

Vendor will deliver orders of 6,000 board feet or more FOB to specified delivery site. The vendor may add shipping charges for orders of less than 6,000 board feet.

Vendor shall complete delivery of lumber to the specified delivery site within sixty (60) calendar days of receipt of the State Contract Order (SCO).

A delivery document showing items delivered and the actual calculated gross vehicular weight of the delivery vehicle shall accompany each load. The total number of delivery vehicle axles shall be recorded on the delivery document.

A twenty-four (24) hour notification shall be required prior to each delivery. Failure to provide a proper notification may result in a delay in acceptance of the lumber. The telephone number for notification will be recorded on the State Contract Order (SCO) issued to the vendor.
