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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
- 14. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 15. WEST VIRGINIA ALCOHOL & DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE ACT: If this Contract constitutes a public improvement construction contract as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code ("The West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act"), then the following language shall hereby become part of this Contract: "The contractor and its subcontractors shall implement and maintain a written drug-free workplace policy in compliance with the West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act, as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code. The contractor and its subcontractors shall provide a sworn statement in writing, under the penalties of perjury, that they maintain a valid drug-free work place policy in compliance with the West Virginia and Drug-Free Workplace Act. It is understood and agreed that this Contract shall be cancelled by the awarding authority if the Contractor: 1) Fails to implement its drug-free workplace policy; 2) Fails to provide information regarding implementation of the contractor's drug-free workplace policy at the request of the public authority; or 3) Provides to the public authority false information regarding the contractor's drug-free workplace policy."

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1. Use the quotation forms provided by the Purchasing Division.
- 2. SPECIFICATIONS: Items offered must be in compliance with the specifications. Any deviation from the specifications must be clearly indicated by the bidder. Alternates offered by the bidder as EQUAL to the specifications must be clearly defined. A bidder offering an alternate should attach complete specifications and literature to the bid. The Purchasing Division may waive minor deviations to specifications.
- Complete all sections of the quotation form.
- 4. Unit prices shall prevail in case of discrepancy.
- 5. All quotations are considered F.O.B. destination unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the quotation.
- 6. BID SUBMISSION: All quotations must be delivered by the bidder to the office listed below prior to the date and time of the bid opening. 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

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EXTRUDED ALUMINUM SIGN PANELS

SCOPE OF CONTRACT

The purpose of this contract shall be for the furnishing of extruded aluminum sign panels.

MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS

The aluminum panels supplied on this contract shall meet the following material specifications, per Section 661 of the latest addition of the West Virginia Division of Highways, Standard Specifications, Roads and Bridges (Standard Specifications):

 Extruded aluminum sign panels shall be manufactured of Alloy 6063-T6, ASTM B221. Prior to delivery, all panels shall be given a chemical conversion treatment meeting the requirements of ASTM B449, Class I or II, per section 661 of the Standard Specifications.

SHAPE SIZE REQUIREMENTS AND TOLERANCES

Extruded aluminum sign panels shall be manufactured in 12 inch (305 mm) and 6 inch (152 mm) widths.

12 inch wide panels shall conform to the dimensional requirements of extrusion "C", per Standard Detail Sheet TE7-1 of the West Virginia Department of Transportation Division of Highways Standard Details Book Volume II; Signing, Signals, Lighting, and Marking; Eighth Printing, March 2008 (Standard Details). 6 inch wide panels shall conform to the dimensional requirements of extrusion "B", per Standard Detail Sheet TE7-1 of the Standard Details. All panels shall be cut to lengths specified in each Blanket Release Order. The Division of Highways reserves the right to order panels of any length within the range of panel lengths bid by the vendor. The vendor shall be capable of supplying panels as long as thirty (30) foot and panels as short as five (5) foot.

Per Section 661 of the Standard Specifications, each panel shall be flat and true within ¼ in. tolerance on an 8 ft. length, with proportionally greater allowance on longer lengths. Flatness across the face of each panel shall be limited to 0.004 in. per inch of width.

PACKAGING

Extruded aluminum sign panels shall be shipped back to back and face to face. Panel faces are to be protected by a thin interleaving of Styrofoam. Stacks of panels are to be securely banded with a minimum of one (1) band for each six (6) foot of length. Packaged stacks of panels are not to exceed 4,000 pounds in weight. Panels shall be shipped on an open bed truck for ease in unloading.

All materials shall be delivered within forty-five (45) days ARO. Late delivery charges against the vendor may be assessed at a rate of \$50.00 per calendar day after the forty-five (45) day deadline.

Deliveries to the Division of Highways must be made between the hours of 7:30 AM and 3:00 PM at the WVDOH Traffic Engineering Division Traffic Services Complex located at 180 Dry Branch Road, Charleston.

Vendor must notify Traffic Engineering personnel forty-eight (48) hours minimum prior to delivery. Contact Chuck Swigger at 304–558-6356 or Ted Whitmore or Bruce Miller at 304–558-3063.

MINIMUM ORDER SIZE

Each Blanket Release Order shall include a minimum of 1,600 feet of 12 inch Type "C" extruded aluminum sign panels.

PRICE ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

The State of West Virginia will consider bids that contain provisions for price adjustments prior to the original expiration date of the Contract, provided that such price adjustment covers both upward and downward movement of the commodity price, and that adjustment is based on the "pass through" increase or decrease of raw materials and/or labor, which make up all or a substantial part of a product. Adjustments are to be based upon an actual dollar figure, not a percentage. All price adjustment requests must be substantiated in a manner acceptable to the Director of the WV Purchasing Division (e.g. governmental bench marks, general market increases, and published price lists). All documentation of price increases incurred by the vendor shall be based on governmental bench marks, general market increases, published price lists, etc. in effect on the original effective date of the Contract, or the effective date of the currently approved price increase in effect, as applicable. Such requests for price increases shall be received in writing by the Director of the Traffic Engineering Division at least 30-days in advance of the proposed effective date of the increase. The price increase request will be evaluated by the Traffic Engineering Division and will be forwarded to the Purchasing Division for concurrence. The vendor may not submit a request for a price increase with a proposed effective date less than 90-days from the original effective date of the Contract. Subsequent requests for price increases may not have a proposed effective date less than 90-days from the effective date of the currently approved price increase in effect. Any time the vendor requests a price adjustment, the Purchasing Division may either accept the price adjustment and amend the Contract accordingly or reject the adjustment in its' entirety and cancel the Contract.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

VENDOR OWING A DEBT TO THE STATE:

PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTS & DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE ACT:

Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

I certify that this bid is made without prior understanding, agreement, or connection with any corporation, firm, limited liability company, partnership or person or entity submitting a bid for the same materials, supplies, equipment or services and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud. Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agencies or political subdivision. Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules.
