- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.

QUESTIONS & CLARIFICATIONS

Q1: Spec section 07531-6, 3.6A calls for walk pads to be installed on the roof. Is it possible to get a layout of these walking pads?

A: Please include four (4) 18" x 18" walk pads to be field located around roof top units per owner's recommendation.

Q2: Spec section 05120-1, 1.3B-1 calls for the fabricator to participate in the AISC Quality Certification Program and to be designated an AISC Certified Plant or a minimum of ten years experience, with a quality control program in place and submit a copy of their quality control manual with the bid. Do to the size of this project will this be required for this project?

B. Fabricator Qualifications: Engage a qualified fabricator experienced in fabricating structural steel similar to that indicated for this Project and with a record of successful in service performance, as well as sufficient production capacity to fabricate structural steel with out delaying the Work.

Q3: Please confirm type of glazing to be used for skylights; Bronze over clear or polycarbonate clear over white?

A: Bronze over Clear.

Q4: Please provide a spec for the security metal ceiling to be included in Alternate #1. A: Refer to attached spec section 09500.

Q5: Please provide a detail of how to bear the new steel in the areas that have existing brick and block wall construction. Currently there is no detail depicting this condition.

A: Add the following note to Detail 5/S2

Note: Where new beam bears on existing wall, beam is to penetrate any existing veneer and bear on CMU back up. Grout fill CMU below beam bearing a minimum of three cells in depth and embed bearing plate as shown.

Once beams are installed patch / repair surrounding masonry to match existing construction.

SECTION 09500 - METAL CEILING PANELS

PART I - GENERAL

1.1 SCOPE

- A. Furnish and install the Metaline Security Ceiling System as manufactured and supplied by Interfinish, a division of the Chicago Metallic Corp. or equal.
- B. All metal components of system must be manufactured by the same manufacture.

1.2 RELATED WORK

- A. Division 15 Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning.
- B. Division 16 Lighting.

1.3 REFERENCES

- A. American Society for Testing Materials
 - 1. A-361- Specification for steel sheet, galvanized by hot dip process.
 - C-423- Test method for sound absorption and sound absorbtion coefficients by reverberation room method.

 - 4. C 636 Standard recommended practice for installation of metal suspension systems for acoustical tile and lay-in panels.

1.4 SUBMITTALS

 - Installation shall occur only when temperature and humidity conditions closely
 approximate interior conditions that will exist when area is complete and occupied.

Heating and cooling system shall be in operation in order to establish a suitable climate.

- All wet trades work to be dry and complete before installation.
- 3. Note: Ceiling system contractors to insure that there is NO overlap between different metal ceiling systems.

1.5 MAINTENANCE

A. Replacement Material

1. Furnish additional material equal to 2% of the ceiling system area.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.1 MANUFACTURER

A. Metaline Security Ceiling System as manufactured by Interfinish Metal Ceilings, a division of Chicago Metallic Corp. or equal

2.2 MATERIALS

A. Metaline Security Ceiling System Panels

1. Panels shall measure a nominal 1ft. by 1ft. or 2ft. by 2ft. and be formed from a G-90 hot-dipped galvanized steel as per A.S.T.M. A-361.

2. The metal from which the panels are formed shall receive a factory-applied baked enamel finish, per A.S.T.M. D-523, that is applied to the metal prior to forming. The color shall be Interfinish -001 White, with the metal receiving a 0.8 mil finish coat over a 0.2 prime

3. The panel shall be formed with upturned legs on all four sides of the panel that angle outward from the face of the panel 97.1 degree angle from the face of the panel. The resulting profile will permit the upturned legs of the panel to snap-in and lock under the bulb of the grid.

4. The panels shall be provided with an additional security feature, a half slot, located on each panel leg, 4-1/4 in. from each corner, which will serve to prevent objects, that have been forced through and around the panels at the corners, from being slid along the side of the panel in an effort to disengage the panel leg from the bulb of the grid component.

5. The panel shall be perforated. The perforation pattern shall be non-directional and shall consist of .078in. diameter perforations on .216in. diagonal centers.

B. Suspension System Components and Perimeter Treatment

1. Main Runner Component

2. The main runner shall measure 1 1/2in. high by 12ft. long and shall have a 15/16in. wide face.

3. The face of the main runner shall coated with an Interfinish -01 white finish. The finish shall be a baked polyester enamel and shall be an identical match to that on the security panels.

The bulb of the main runner shall be rectangular in shape and oversized so as to provide a larger surface under which the panels are to lock.

The main runners shall posses non-directional bayonet style couplings. Hook style ends will not be accepted.

C. Cross Tee Component

5.

- 1. The cross tee shall measure 1-1/2in, high by 2ft, and 4ft, in length and have a 15/16in, wide face.
- 2. The finish shall be identical to that of the main runner.
- 3. The bulb of the cross tee shall be identical to that found on the main runner.
- 4. The cross tee components shall possess stab-in end tabs for lateral pull out protection.
- 5. The ends of the cross tees shall butt to the face of the main runner.

D. Perimeter Treatment

- Wall Channel
- 2. Wall channel moldings shall measure 15/16in. by 1-9/16in. I.D. by 3/4in. and be manufactured from a minimum thickness of 25ga. Steel.
- 3. Wall angle shall measure 15/16in. by 15/16in. and be manufactured from a minimum thickness 25ga. Steel.

E. Accessories

- 1. Acoustical Insulation
- Blanket Insulation
- 3. The insulation shall be black fiberglass in a 1in. by 1lb. thickness. The system shall achieve an N.R.C. rating of no less than .80.
- 4. Security fasteners shall be used to attach panels to wall angle and to attach access panels to suspension system components. The fasteners shall be #10 by 1/2in. torx head security screws with center reject pin with white finish heads that match finish of panels.

F. Compression Member Struts

1. Compression member struts shall be made available for down bracing purposes. The struts shall be of a design as shown in Interfinish literature and shall be manufactured to a length as shown in architect's drawings.

G. Access Panels

- Access panels measuring 2ft. by 2ft. shall be made available. The access panels shall be
 offered with the same metal type and thickness, perforation pattern, and paint finish as
 the security panels. The access panels shall be formed with all sides at a 90-degree angle
 to the face of the panel so as to provide ease of removal and re-installation. The access
 panel shall be held in place by security screws (described above) that are screw-attached
 through the suspension system into the panel.
- Provide access panels at each VAV box, Fire and Volume Dampers in Ductwork and Plumbing Valve indicated on the drawings.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 INSPECTION AND PREPARATION

A. Inspect area in which ceiling is to be installed in order to identify any conditions that might dversely affect the installation of the ceiling system. Do not start work until these conditions are orrected. Verify that all work performed by other trades above the ceiling has been completed rior to installation.

B. Field measure the area in which the ceiling system is to be installed and establish the layout in order to create appropriate borders and minimize out of square conditions.

3.2 INSTALLATION

A. Suspension System Components and Perimeter Treatment.

1. Install perimeter wall channel or angle to walls with anchors every 12in, along the length of the chosen perimeter treatment.

2. Main runner components shall be installed on 48-inch centers, and shall be suspended directly from the existing structure by not less than 12-gauge steel hanger wire spaced on 48-inch centers along the length of the component. All hanger wires shall be wrapped tightly at least 3 full turns.

3. Attach compression posts at a center spacing as recommended by the factory along the length of each main runner and to the existing structure by means of an industry approved standard every 4 ft. In areas where there is an obstruction, such as ductwork or wiring, strut shall be placed at nearest point but on a cross tee rather than a main runner. A compression post shall then be tied to the hanger wire at the uppermost and lowermost point of the post. This shall be done by using a plastic tie. Details of the strut and the installation of the strut are detailed in the "Metaline Compression Member Detail" of the Interfinish manual.

4. Main runners shall be interconnected by 4ft. cross tees installed on 24in. centers to form 24in. by 48in. modules. Wherever shown on the design plans, these modules shall be divided by 24in. cross tees and installed perpendicular to the 4ft. module forming cross tee components to form 24in. by 24in. modules.

 As noted on the design plans affix additional hanger wires to grid components for enhanced support as warranted.

B. Metaline Panels and Related Items.

- 1. Insert the Metaline panel through the grid module from below. The panel then should be inserted downward, and snapped into the grid module. Once installed the face of the panels shall rest on the inside surfaces of the horizontal flanges of the main runners and cross tees, with the legs of the panel snapping and locking underneath the rectangular bulb of the grid.
- 2. Mount panels to the perimeter treatment, either channel or angle. Attach panels to perimeter treatment with #10 security screws. The placement should begin 3in. in from each edge of the panel, and occur every 6in. in between.
- 3. Mount access panels to the grid components using #10 security screws attached through the ceiling grid and into the access panels. The screws should located at each corner of the access panel and 6in. on center along each side, in between.
- 4. Lay poly-wrapped acoustical pads into grid modules so that the pads rest upon the backside of the Metaline panel. If an acoustical blanket is required lay the blanket over the top of the grid system..


3.3 REPAIR AND CLEAN

- A. Repair any damaged or dented areas by removing and replacing the affected components.
- B. Clean all ceiling components with a non-solvent based, non-abrasive commercial cleaning solution.

3.4 MAINTENANCE MATERIAL

A. Furnish additional material equal to 2% of the ceiling system area.


