1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.

  4. Manufacturer's recommended installation procedures which, when approved by the project manager, will become the basis for accepting or rejecting actual installation procedures used on the work.

## QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Use adequate numbers of skilled workmen who are thoroughly trained and experienced in the necessary crafts and who are completely familiar with the specified requirements and the methods needed for proper performance of the work of this section.
- B. Installation shall follow manufacturer's recommendations.
- C. Contractor will be responsible to ensure their employees and visitors observe OSHA standards and Life safety codes to include work site cleanliness.

## PANEL INSTALLATION

- A. Masonry screws are the recommended direct attachment method for tectum panels to masonry walls. B. Screws heads will match the panel color.
- C. Screws should be installed so that the face of the screw is flush with the panel face.
- D. Fasteners will be placed in mortar joints to fasten panels to the masonry walls.
- E. Screw fasteners will be placed one to two inches from each panel edge and centered. A total of six screws will be used per panel unless situation requires otherwise.
- F. No washers shall be used unless recommended by manufacturer.
- G. Adhesive used in conjunction with screws high impact areas is recommended. Adhesive will not be visible.
- H. From the floor to six feet vertical height on the drill hall walls, no panels shall be placed.
- I. Panels must reduce reverberation time from 2.3 seconds to a minimum of 1.5 seconds. Once panels have been installed, the space shall have an AR rating of 9036 sabins or more.
