

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- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.

- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. 

TAKE US ROUTE 119 S (Corridor G) & TRAVEL APPROX. 55 MILES TO LOGAN EXIT (RT. 10). TURN RIGHT OFF 119, THEN LEFT AT THE LIGHT. TRAVEL 2.2 MILES TO THE INTERSECTION, TURN LEFT ONTO RT. 10 SOUTH. GO THROUGH LOGAN, TURN RIGHT AT THE TRAFFIC LIGHT. CONTINUE ON RT. 10 SOUTH FOR 14.8 MILES TO RT. 80 SOUTH TOWARD GILBERT. FROM THIS INTERSECTION, TRAVEL .2 (2 TENTHS OF A MILE), CROSS TRACKS, CONTINUE ACROSS BRIDGE TO ROCKHOUS ROAD. 

SCOPE OF WORK

The successful bidder shall provide appropriate equipment, materials, labor and any technical services needed for the successful reclamation of <u>Hunt Coal</u>, Permit <u>U-5071-86</u>, and any disturbance associated with such operation. The General Performance Standards (GPS) shall apply to all items in Scope of Work.

Work necessary on this site will include the following items, but is not limited to these:

- 1. Upon mobilization to the site, which will be directed in a written Notice to Proceed, the access roads shall be reconstructed in accordance with bid item #16.0. If fuel and lubricants are to be stored on site, bid item #2.0 shall be in place before fuel is delivered. Project sign shall be constructed and erected in accordance with attached specifications. The sign shall be maintained during the construction activities and through the life of the warranty period. Sign cost is No Bid Item and included with mobilization cost. No work shall be authorized or allowed at site until sign is constructed and erected on site and approved by DEP.
- 2. Storm water management in the form as described in bid item #7.0 shall be installed.
- 3. Concurrent and continuous reclamation shall be maintained throughout the life of the project. Backfill is required for <u>all areas</u>. Regrading and topsoiling is required for <u>all areas</u>. Revegetation and soil improvement is required for <u>all areas</u>. Reclamation is to be according to the attached specifications, plans, and clarifying discussions at the Pre-Bid Conference.
- 4. Construction stakeout as necessary to carry out work. (Bid Item # 6.0) *NOTE: This is a water treatment facility, with critical elevations. Survey and construction stakeout will be required, and the plan submitted prior to construction.
- 5. Check for and locate all utilities within the work area to provide and maintain a safe working area in addition to preventing damage to the utility.
- 6. EXCAVATE EXISTING THREE (3) MINE SEALS and the existing SEEP COLLECTION DRAIN, and REPLACE with new mine seals. Cost of the excavation and construction of new mine seals is inclusive to the cost of Deep Mine Wet Seals. (see attached specifications and/or plans)
- 7. Construct the MINE SEEP COLLECTION SYSTEM. This will consist of approximately TWO HUNDRED AND TEN LINEAR FEET (210') of POURED CONCRETE SEEP CUTOFF WALL, TEN (10') LINEAR FEET OF POURED CONCRETE UPSTREAM ENDWALL, TEN LINEAR FEET (10') OF POURED CONCRETE DOWNSTREAM ENDWALL, and TWO HUNDRED LINEAR FEET (200 LF) OF TWELVE INCH (12") HDPE DR17 COLLECTION DRAIN PIPE. Collection drain discharge pipe will pass through the downstream endwall, and convey discharge into V-Ditch Number One (#1). Opening where collection drain passes through the downstream endwall must be sealed around pipe to prevent seepage. Seep cutoff wall and the two endwalls are to be poured four feet (4') above pavement, with one foot (1') poured below pavement level. Rebar for headwall shall be grouted one foot (1') into pavement below bottom of wall. The system will be covered with SIX (6") TO EIGHT INCH (8") CLEAN SANDSTONE to the top of the seep cutoff wall and will be at least four feet (4') above the coal seam at the highwall. Cost of seep cutoff wall, upstream and downstream endwalls, pipe, and sandstone are inclusive to the cost of the mine seep collection system. (see attached specifications and/or plans)
- 8. Construct approximately ONE THOUSAND LINEAR FEET (1000 LF) of V-DITCH #1 to convey flow from mine seep collection system to the conveyance channel. Cost of excavation and limestone will be inclusive to the cost of v-ditch number one (#1) (see attached specifications and/or plans).
- CLEAN OUT, to unobstructed flow, approximately TWO HUNDRED FIFTY LINEAR FEET (250') of EXISTING LIMESTONE RIP-RAP CHANNEL NUMBER ONE (#1) to collect all surface runoff above limestone v-ditch #1 and direct to natural stream channel (see attached specifications and/or plans).

VENDOR:

- 10. Reconstruct approximately EIGHTEEN HUNDRED (1800') LINEAR FEET of EXISTING ACCESS ROAD NUMBER THREE (#3), starting just before DRIVE THROUGH #3 (low water crossing) and ending at the UPSTREAM ENDWALL of the MINE SEEP COLLECTION SYSTEM. Construct with a 1% grade toward v-ditches and channels. The road surface will be constructed with WOVEN FABRIC UNDERLAYMENT and STONE BASE. There will be THREE (3) LOW WATER CROSSINGS installed at designated locations along the Access Road. The cost of the three low water crossings, filter fabric, and stone will be inclusive to the cost of the Access Road (see attached specifications and/or plans).
- 11. Clean out approximately ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE FEET (175') of CONVEYANCE CHANNEL to convey flow from V-Ditch Number One (#1) to Stilling Basin. This channel exists but needs to be cleaned down to natural stone with a minimum width of four feet (4'). Cost of this conveyance will be inclusive to Conveyance Channel. (see attached specifications and/or plans).
- 12. Construct a STILLING BASIN below the conveyance channel in the designated location. Install a CONCRETE SPLASH PAD where the conveyance channel enters the stilling basin. The Stilling Basin will be LINED with a HDPE "POLY-FLEX" LINER, WITH A SIXTY (60) MIL THICKNESS OR EQUIVILANT. Install TWO (2) EIGHT INCH (8") PERFORATED SCHEDULE 40 PVC DECANT PIPES and ONE (1) FOUR INCH (4") SCHEDULE 40 PVC PERFORATED DECANT PIPE, all with TRASH RACKS, in the stilling basin. A FOUR INCH (4") to TWO INCH (2") REDUCER will be connected to the four inch (4") decant pipe, with a TWO INCH (2") PVC DRIVE LINE conveying flow to the Aqua-Fix Unit. TWO (2) EIGHT INCH (8") HDPE DR17 PIPES, one for the INTAKE LINE to the Aqua-Fix Unit and one for the DRAIN LINE to V-Ditch #2, will attach to the two 8" decant pipes. A STAINLESS STEEL KNIFE VALVE will be installed in the intake line and in the drain line. An ANCHOR PAD will be installed for the decant pipes, with the openings sealed so as not to leak. An EMERGENCY OVERFLOW CHANNEL will be constructed to carry overflow to the natural stream channel. The cost of the anchor pad, PVC liner, decant pipes, 2" and 4" PVC drive line and reducer, 8" HDPE DR17 drain line, 8" HDPE DR17 intake line, knife valves, and the emergency overflow channel, will be inclusive to the cost of the Stilling Basin (see attached specifications and/or plans).
- 13. Construct the AQUA-FIX UNIT. This will include the construction and installation of the TIP BUCKET, CONCRETE FOUNDATION, TEN (10) TON SILO, STEEL ENCLOSURE, and a CRANE for lifting the unit and silo (see attached specifications and/or plans). The cost of the tip bucket, concrete foundation, silo, steel enclosure and crane will be inclusive to the cost of the Aqua-Fix Unit. (see attached specifications and/or plans.
- 14. Construct approximately FIFTEEN HUNDRED LINEAR FEET (1500') of V-DITCH #2 from along lower section of access road number three (#3) above the stilling basin and continue to headwall number one (#1). V-Ditch number two (#2) will require some field adjustment to pass beneath an existing eight inch (8") gas line. The ditch will be lined with LIMESTONE. Cost of excavation and limestone rip-rap will be inclusive to the cost of V-Ditch Number Two (#2)(see attached specifications and/or plans).
- 15. Construct HEADWALL NUMBER ONE (#1) to capture flow from V-Ditch #2. Install approximately ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY LINEAR FEET (150') of EIGHT INCH (8") HDPE DR17 CONVEYANCE LINE to carry flow from the headwall to Pond #1 and Pond #2. TWO EIGHT INCH (8") STAINLESS STEEL KNIFE VALVES will be installed in the line to alternate flow from headwall to pond #1 or to pond #2. The openings in the headwall for the eight inch (8") pipe will be sealed so as not to leak. Pipe will be BURIED A MINIMUM OF TWO FEET (2'). The cost of the HDPE DR17 PIPE and knife valves will be inclusive to the cost of the Headwall number one (#1). (see attached specifications and/or plans).
- 16. CLEAN OUT approximately FOUR HUNDRED LINEAR FEET (400') of OPEN LIMESTONE CHANNEL #3 to direct surface runoff, from above treatment system, to the Existing Natural Drain. Open limestone channel #3 will be GROUTED. TWO (2) TWENTY FOOT (20') SECTIONS OF TWENTY FOUR INCH (24") HANCOR SURLOK CULVERTS will be installed near the base of the valley fill to cross Access Road Number One (#1). The culverts will be BEDDED with THREE INCH (3") to FIVE INCH (5") LIMESTONE. The cost of the CMP Culverts will be inclusive to the cost of cleaning and grouting of the Open Limestone Channel #3 (see attached specifications and/or plans).

Install TWO HUNDRED TWENTY LINEAR FEET (220') OF SIXTY INCH (60") ADS PIPE in the natural stream channel, and BED WITH THREE INCH (3") TO FIVE INCH (5") LIMESTONE to MIDWAY OF PIPE DIAMETER. TWO (2) HEADWALLS, one at the INLET and one at the OUTLET, will be installed. After pipe is bedded in stream, COVER WITH AT LEAST TWO FEET (2') OF SOIL. The cost of the two (2) headwalls, limestone, and sixty inch (60")ADS pipe will be inclusive to the cost of the placement of the pipe. (see attached specifications and/or plans).
- 18. Construct POND NUMBER ONE (#1). Install CONCRETE ANCHOR PAD, and approximately SEVENTY FIVE LINEAR FEET (75') of EIGHT INCH (8") HDPE DR17 DRAIN LINE from Pond Number One (#1) to Pond Number Three (#3).
