Item 1: The DEP # shown on the project plan sheets should be DEP14642, rather than DEP14230.

Item 2: Under spec item 4.0, Site Preparation, the reference to "Section 12" is to be omitted.

Item 3: Q) How far does the trench extend?

A) It will extend as designated on the plan sheets and as pointed out in the pre-bid field meeting.

Item 4: Q) Will one, open, complete trench run continuously from site to site?

A) No – only where designated on the plans or as shown in the field during the pre-bid meeting.

Item 5: Q) Will we chase the cracks?

A) No – excavation will be as per plan sheets and as shown at the pre-bid field meeting.

Item 6: Q) Can spray foam be used?

A) No. Bidding will be as per bid items designated in the plan documents.

Item 7: Q) If there is water in the subsidence hole, will we still gravity inject the grout, rather than pump the grout?

A) Yes.

Item 8: Q) Are there any special plans concerning the ponds?

A) Ponds are to be left in "as good", or "better than" condition as they exist now.

Item 9: Q) What is the bottom width of the trench?

A) As designated in the plans and specifications.

Item 10: Q) Are there any special requirements concerning fencing/protection around the excavation?

- A) The contractor shall erect such temporary fences or guards as may be necessary for protection to persons, equipment, and animals; and to keep unauthorized persons away from the work. Payment for temporary fences/guards will be incidental to Item 8, Unclassified Excavation.

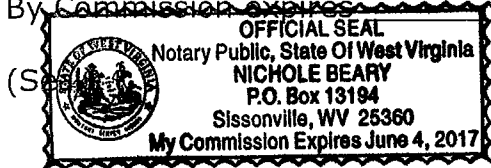

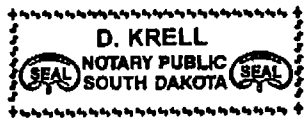
