- Item 2: Under spec item 4.0, Site Preparation, the reference to "Section 12" is to be omitted.
- Item 3: Q) How far does the trench extend?
 - A) It will extend as designated on the plan sheets and as pointed out in the pre-bid field meeting.
- Item 4: Q) Will one, open, complete trench run continuously from site to site?
 - A) No only where designated on the plans or as shown in the field during the pre-bid meeting.
- Item 5: Q) Will we chase the cracks?
 - A) No excavation will be as per plan sheets and as shown at the pre-bid field meeting.
- Item 6: Q) Can spray foam be used?
