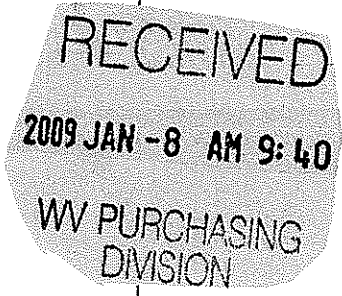

THE CELEBRATION PRINCESS IS AN AUTHENTIC PADDLEWHEEL, 149 PASSENGER COAST GUARD CERTIFIED VESSEL BUILT IN 1994. THE VESSEL IS POWERED BY A 115 H.P. JOHN DEERE DIESEL ENGINE THAT POWERS A 25 K.W. GENERATER AND A HYDRAULIC PUMP THAT POWER THE TWO HYDRAULIC MOTORS ON THE PADDLEWHEEL. THE VESSEL WILL CRUISE A MINIMUM OF 6 M.P.H. AT NORMAL OPERATING CONDITIONS AND AT FULL CAPACITY.

THE HULL IS ¼" STEEL (NEW IN 2007) WITH A STEEL SUPERSTRUCTURE. THE HULL CONTAINS A 419 GALLON SEWAGE TANK, 337 GALLON FUEL TANK AND A 207 GALLON POTABLE WATER TANK.

The minimum number of child-size life preservers required is sixteen (16). When more than sixteen (16) children are carried or persons weighing over ninety (90) pounds, additional child-size life preservers shall be carried so that the vessel has an approved life preserver suitable for each person on board.

No more than eighty (80) persons, including crew, shall be allowed on the upper deck at any one time. The maximum number of persons, including crew, allowed on the upper deck may be further reduced based on number of seats in place.

Operators must man the vessel's wheelhouse with a qualified member of the vessel's crew at all times passengers are embarked. The bridge watch must continuously monitor Channel 16 and other appropriate marine radio frequencies. Operators must maintain an effective lookout for other maritime traffic and have the ability to alert and direct passengers and crew in the event of emergency.

Subj: STABILITY LETTER FOR M/V JEWEL CITY, O.N. D1021567

It is the Master's responsibility to maintain the vessel in a satisfactory stability condition at all times in accordance with 46 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 185.20-5.

A simplified stability test witnessed by the U.S. Coast Guard and conducted in accordance with 46 CFR 171.035(d) was performed on the M/V JEWEL CITY (ex. R&D Hull RD 110) at Catlettsburg, Kentucky on 26 July 1994. On the basis of this test, the JEWEL CITY was found to have satisfactory stability for the carriage of 152 persons in **protected** service as presently outfitted and equipped. The following restrictions apply:

1. A maximum of 149 passengers may be carried. A maximum of 80 passengers may be carried on the upper deck. **In no case shall the number of persons exceed that allowed on the Certificate of Inspection.**
2. No weights, ballast or structure may be added, removed or relocated without the prior authorization of the Officer in Charge, Marine Inspection. The steel ballast (5000 lbs.) in the forward most void must be in place at all times.
3. All voids shall be maintained in a clean and dry condition. The transverse bulkheads located 12, 24, 36, 48, and 54 feet aft of the headlog must remain watertight. No bulkhead penetrations or modifications shall be made without prior approval of the cognizant OCMI.
4. All weather deck openings shall be kept closed and watertight while the vessel is in operation.

This stability letter shall be posted under suitable transparent material in the pilothouse.


