1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.

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The West Virginia State Police are soliciting bids for a major renovation of the forensic Firearm/Toolmark Section indoor firing range, located in South Charleston. The following specifications must be met in full by the successful vendor. The design of the new range is centered on Savage Range Systems or equivalent products.

The range size is approximately one hundred and ten (110) feet long, twenty (20) feet wide, and eleven (11) feet high.

### **SPECIFICATIONS**

- Decontaminate for lead of the entire range system including all walls, ceiling, floors and area behind the trap. This will include removal of the existing armor escalator trap, and removal and decontamination of sprayed on acoustic materials and Tectum panels from the entire range. This work will be done by 40-hour certified technicians in accordance with all applicable EPA requirements. Vendor must include any and all EPA documentation regarding disposition and disposal of hazardous waste material.
- Supply new range equipment:
  - Savage Range Systems Model 800R Granulated Rubber Bullet Trap (or authorized equivalent) consisting of the principle steel backstop, rubber media hopper, and retention baffle for twenty (20) foot wide range. Bullet containment system shall be rated to firearms up to and including .50cal BMG and capable of safely containing metal and frangible bullets. Rubber Ballistic Media shall be 3/4" +/- black metal & fiber free rubber material. Media shall be coated with calcium carbonate (fire retardant) at time of installation and may not contain any water absorbent or retentive material.
  - Two Savage Range Systems/Porta Target OHTS-25 non-turning overhead retrievable target systems (or authorized equivalent). For twenty-five (25 foot) of travel. Current target superstructure steel at rear of range can be utilized if moved forward or superstructure is to be removed

- Portable (less than 65 lbs.) forensic bullet trap capable of handling firearms up to .454 Casull, and delivering a forensic-grade specimen suitable for analysis and comparison (Savage Range Systems Forensic Buddy model FB or authorized equivalent). Additional: used for bullet recovery for ballistic comparison with, clear Lexan shell catcher. 1300 FPE @ muzzle (no steel core) for handguns only. 34"x10"x14".
  
- Range repairs and upgrades, including:
  - Supply and install twenty-four (24) four 4 foot two-tube strip light fixtures in place of existing fixtures. New light fixtures will utilize existing circuits and wiring unless necessary replacement to meet codes put forth by the National Electric Code or State/local authority.
  - Apply plywood cladding over existing ceiling baffles
  - Paint range (walls, ceiling, baffles) including one primer coat and two paint coats satin white in color
  - All labor, electrical connections, engineering design services including shop drawings, commissioning of range, training of personnel in operation and maintenance of the equipment shall be included
  - All freight charges of new equipment brought into range and freight charges for removal of items from range are to be included in this bid
