- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.

West Virginia Educational Broadcasting is seeking to purchase two (2) DVCPRO High Definition Master broadcast and studio VTRs that can produce and transmit over 2 hours of content for the Network Operations Center in Beckley, WV.

The Network Operations Center records studio, non-linear edited, satellite and microwave fed programming. There is an extensive library of pre-recorded DVCPRO 25 and DVCPRO 50 taped programming. These machines shall be capable of playing back any of this prerecorded content.

The specifications are listed below. The units shall be Panasonic AJ-HD 1800 or equivalent. If bidding an equivalent, vendor must provide manufacturer, model number and specifications with their bid.


