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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.

The Acquisition and Contract Administration Section of the Purchasing Division "State" for the West Virginia General Services Division is soliciting quotations for the purchase of three (3) John Deere 2008 Gator XUV 850D All-Terrain Vehicles, or equal. The lump sum bid requested will include three units with similar base requirements, with two of the three units having additional accessories, as listed herein.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- A. Vendor must supply 18-month (or greater) manufacturer's warranty for equipment.
- B Freight will be FOB-Destination; all charges for delivery of equipment to Location on Capitol Complex in Charleston must be incorporated into the bid.
- C. Award will be made to the lowest Total Bid for the base three units, including the additional accessories for the two units.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

The following are the minimum requirements for the three base bid units:

- 2. Fully independent front suspension; semi-independent or independent rear suspension;

Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.
