1.0 **Scope:**

1.1 The specifications are intended to cover all requirements for the purchase of a Scrubber-Sweeper system to be used at the West Virginia Alcohol Beverage Control Administration, Warehouse located in Nitro, WV.

2.0 **Specifications:**

- 2.1 Successful bidder, hereafter "Supplier" shall furnish a scrubber-sweeper, all necessary attachments and delivery of said unit to the WVABCA Warehouse. The "Supplier" shall provide the following specifications on the aforementioned unit:
- 2.1.1 Must have a minimum cleaning path of 32 inches (including side and sweeping brush).
 - 2.1.2 Is to have no more than four cylindrical brushes and no less than two.
 - 2.1.3 Shall possess the ability to place down pressure on the brushes to allow more pressure to be applied on desired spots.
 - 2.1.4 Shall be equipped with a side sweeping brush.
 - 2.1.5 Shall be equipped with a squeegee that is equipped with a breakaway feature.
 - 2.1.6 Shall be equipped with a system that raises the squeegee when the unit is placed in reverse.
 - 2.1.7 Shall allow the operator to control the amount of water used to scrub or squeegee.
 - 2.1.8 Shall be capable of picking up small debris such as wood chips, glass fragments, paper and plastic fragments.
 - 2.1.9 Shall be capable of scrubbing and dry sweeping.
 - 2.1.10 Must have a minimum of 36 volt battery system and must come equipped with a battery charger.
 - 2.1.11 Must be equipped with an hour meter and battery discharge meter.
 - 2.1.12 Shall have fuse protection on its circuitry.
 - 2.1.13 Shall have an adjustable seat and a seatbelt.
 - 2.1.14 The driver's seat shall be mounted at the front portion of the scrubber-sweeper to allow for maximum line of sight by the driver.
 - 2.1.15 Shall have a solution tank with a minimum capacity of 40 gallons.
 - 2.1.16 Shall have a recovery tank with a minimum capacity of 50 gallons.

- 2.1.17 Shall have drain valves that allow for hose connections on the solution and recovery tanks. The connections will allow the operator to fill and empty the aforementioned tanks.
- 2.1.18 Shall be equipped with a dust filter that may be changed with minimal tools.
- 2.1.19 Shall have a debris hopper that is equipped with a minimum of 70 pounds of capacity.
- 2.1.20 Shall be equipped with hazard lights that may be engaged while the unit is in motion.
- 2.1.21 Shall be accompanied by a parts manual and an operations manual.
- 2.1.22 The "Supplier" must deliver the scrubber-sweeper to the WVABCA Warehouse located at 500 River Road, Hub Industrial Park, Nitro, WV 25143. Delivery costs must be included in the price of the equipment.
- 2.1.23 Equipment cost must be inclusive of manufacturer's warranty.

3.0 **Submitting:**

- 3.1 The Vendor should submit the following with bid proposals but must submit prior to award:
 - 3.1.1 Manufacturer's warranty, specifications on all items, operation and maintenance manuals.

4.0 Acceptance and Testing Requirements:

- 4.1.1 Upon delivery of the scrubber-sweeper the "Supplier" shall demonstrate the units functions and demonstrate that the equipment is in working order prior to acceptance by the agency. Warranty period will become effective upon agency acceptance via change order.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code* §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.

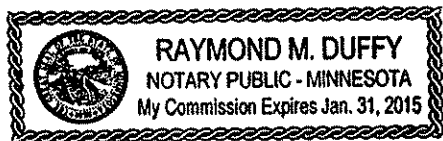



 Bidder is a resident vendor who certifies that, during the life of the contract, on average at least 75% of the employees working on the project being bid are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two years immediately preceding submission of this bid; **or**,
3. **Application is made for 2.5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked:**

Bidder understands if the Secretary of Revenue determines that a Bidder receiving preference has failed to continue to meet the requirements for such preference, the Secretary may order the Director of Purchasing to: (a) reject the bid; or (b) assess a penalty against such Bidder in an amount not to exceed 5% of the bid amount and that such penalty will be paid to the contracting agency or deducted from any unpaid balance on the contract or purchase order.

By submission of this certificate, Bidder agrees to disclose any reasonably requested information to the Purchasing Division and authorizes the Department of Revenue to disclose to the Director of Purchasing appropriate information verifying that Bidder has paid the required business taxes, provided that such information does not contain the amounts of taxes paid nor any other information deemed by the Tax Commissioner to be confidential.
