**ADDENDUM #1
DEP14699
Sandy Run Highwall and Portals Project**

The contractor shall incorporate a mechanism in the open limestone or grouted channels to facilitate taking flow measurements. The best way to enable flow measurements is construction of a sharp-edged drop of about 18 inches (or more) in the channel.

QUESTIONS

- 1.) **Q.** Why is a survey plat of the re-established property corners required?
A. Because it may not be possible to physically locate the re-established corners, so the plat will allow the property owner to verify the location of the property corners.
- 2.) **Q.** Can on-site rock be used for riprap?
A. No, it must be commercially purchased limestone.
- 3.) **Q.** Can the left over material from clearing and grubbing be wind rowed?
A. No, it must be burned.
- 4.) **Q.** What is the maximum size of rock that will be allowed to be buried in the backfill?
A. Two feet in any dimension. Larger rock shall be broken up or removed from the backfill.
- 5.) **Q.** Are there soil borrow areas identified on the plans for cover material for the refuse?
A. No, the quantity of unclassified excavation on the bid schedule is sufficient to include the amount of soil material needed to cover the refuse. So, the unclassified excavation pay item includes both refuse and soil material as well as any rock less than two feet to be backfilled.
- 6.) **Q.** Was the site core drilled?
A. Yes, bore logs are provided in the specifications.
- 7.) **Q.** Can on-site rock be used for road stabilization?
A. No.
- 8.) **Q.** Is the contractor required to use the access roads identified on the plans?
A. No, but he is required to stay within the construction limits?
- 9.) **Q.** If stabilization of the proposed access roads is necessary to provide all weather access, will the contractor be compensated?
A. No, the cost for providing all weather access during construction is the contractor's responsibility. He will be paid for reclaiming the access upon completion of the work.

The Contractor shall have 120 calendar days from the Notice to Proceed to complete construction activities on the project. The \$250 per day liquidated damage clause will be in effect after the 120 days. However, the total performance period will be 365 days from the date of the Notice to Proceed for invoicing purposes.
