GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 14. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 15. WEST VIRGINIA ALCOHOL & DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE ACT: If this Contract constitutes a public improvement construction contract as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code ("The West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act"), then the following language shall hereby become part of this Contract: "The contractor and its subcontractors shall implement and maintain a written drug-free workplace policy in compliance with the West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act, as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code. The contractor and its subcontractors shall provide a sworn statement in writing, under the penalties of perjury, that they maintain a valid drug-free work place policy in compliance with the West Virginia and Drug-Free Workplace Act. It is understood and agreed that this Contract shall be cancelled by the awarding authority if the Contractor: 1) Fails to implement its drug-free workplace policy; 2) Fails to provide information regarding implementation of the contractor's drug-free workplace policy at the request of the public authority; or 3) Provides to the public authority false information regarding the contractor's drug-free workplace policy."

Scope:

The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is requesting bids on geo-textile fabric, engineered wood fiber, pressure treated wood border and edging for use on playground zones in parks, forests and wildlife management areas throughout the state of West Virginia. Items will be purchased on "as needed" basis.

To ensure fairness in the bidding process, the inclusive facilities in this contact have been divided into four geographic regions: Region 1 – North Central West Virginia; Region 2 – South Western West Virginia; Region 3 – South Eastern West Virginia; and Region 4 – Eastern Panhandle Region.

This contract may have multiple awards. Bidders may bid on any one or combination of geographic regions. Awards will be made to the lowest-cost, qualified vendor(s) on a regional basis.

Product Specifications:

Geo-textile fabric or equal. Fabric must provide a water permeable separation between the earth and the wood fiber and at least 150 gallons per square foot per minute.

Engineered wood fiber or equal. Materials must be made of 100% hardwood; uniform in size; harvested and debarked; free of chemical treatments and additives; and free of soil, twigs, leaves and other contaminates.

4 inch x 8 inch pressure treated wood border or equal. Top exposed edges must be chamfered or rounded.

6 inch by 6 inch 16 foot long pressure treated wood border or equal. Top exposed edges must be chamfered or rounded.

Edging anchors for playground border or equal. Anchors must be #4 rebar and a minimum of 36" in length.

Requirements:

All engineered wood fiber must meet the following requirements:

- Compliance with U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, Handbook for Public Playground Safety.
- Compliance with ASTM Standard F 2075
- Compliance with Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Accessibility Guidelines for Buildings and Facilities; Play Areas.

Vendors must submit the following attachments:

- Complete manufacturer's specifications and warranties.
- ASTM and CPSC Statement of Compliance.

Warranties:

All engineered wood fiber must be guaranteed to be free of defects in workmanship and material for a minimum of one year from date of acceptance. However, if manufacturer warranty periods are longer than the required minimum one year warranty, those warranties shall apply.

All items ordered from this contract shall be delivered within a reasonable time not exceed thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of a BRO, unless otherwise agreed to, in writing, between the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources and the vendor. Deliveries will be made to various locations. The vendor must contact each facility forty0eight (48) hours prior to delivery.




