- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code

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### REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1.1 Request for Quotation to provide all labor, materials, equipment and anything incidental to the modernization of one elevator as listed herein for the Administration Building of Hopemont Hospital located at Route 3, Box 330, Terra Alta, WV 26764-9564.
- All work will be in compliance with safety standards set forth in ASME 17 1-2004,7 "Safety Codes for Elevators," Fire Marshall regulations, National Electric Code and the American's with Disabilities Act and all other applicable building codes and industry standards. The award will be made to the overall low bid that complies with the specifications.

### 2. BASE BIDS:

- 2.1 All qualified Bidders, being familiar with and understanding the bidding documents and also having examined the site and being familiar with all local conditions affecting the project hereby propose to furnish all labor, material, equipment, supplies and to perform all work in accordance with the bidding documents within the time set forth below.
- 2.2 It is the bidder's responsibility to verify all field conditions, building and elevator limitations prior to bidding. It is also the bidder's responsibility to notify the West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources in writing, of conditions detrimental to proper and timely completion of the repair/upgrade Do not proceed until nonconforming conditions have been corrected.
- 2.3 A mandatory vendor prebid conference is scheduled for 7/27/2009 at 10:30 AM the Hopemont Hospital conference room. Failure to attend the mandatory prebid conference will result in bid rejection.

### 3. SCOPE OF WORK:

3.1. To provide all labor, material, equipment and anything incidental to modernize one elevator in the Administration building of Hopemont Hospital so that the elevator is in full compliance with ASME 17.1-2004. The following specifications are required in the scope of work but the absence or presence of any requirement does not relieve the contractor from complying with the requirement to be in full compliance with ASME 17.1-2004. The contractor shall remedy any possible cites the elevator inspector determines are not in compliance with ASME 17.1-2004. Final payment will not be made until after the elevator inspector approves the modernization.

- 3 1.1 The existing elevator in need of modernization is an Otis traction elevator identified with the serial number of 103135. It services four landings and was installed in 1926.
- Controller The existing controller will be replaced with a new state of the art microprocessor. The new, advanced system shall operate from buttons located at each floor and in each car, and will utilize the latest in technology to optimize the elevator system, slow down and automatically stop cars at landings corresponding to registered calls.
- 3.3 System shall use easily reprogrammable intelligent software. Design basic algorithms will optimize service based on equalizing system's response to registered hall calls at shortest possible level and equalizing trip time at shortest possible time.
- Door operation shall automatically open door when car arrives at a floor to permit transfer of passenger and automatically close the door after a timed interval.
- 3.5 System shall stop car within 1/8" above or below the landing sill. Avoid over travel as well as under travel, and maintain stopping accuracy regardless of load in car, direction of travel rope slippage or stretch.
- The system shall include standard elevator features such as: Fire Service I & II, Independent Service, Attendant Service, Load Weighing and Emergency Power Service. The system shall use designs, components and assemblies that conform to or exceed the codes and standards applicable in the jurisdiction in which they are installed.
  - A new solid state, computerized AC vector drive will be installed and be suitable for operation specified and capable of providing smooth, comfortable acceleration, retardation and dynamic braking. Limit difference in speed between full load and no load to not more than +/-5 % of the contract speed.

<u>Automatic Load-Weighting Bypass</u> - Automatic bypass of hall calls shall be provided and be effective when the cars are operating on bank service. Load-weighing switches, which are actuated by the load in the car, establish bypass operation when the car becomes loaded. Once bypass operation is established, the car shall continue to bypass hall calls as long as it is loaded fully

<u>False Car Call Cancel</u> - The False Car Call Cancel Feature shall be applied on all cars to operate in conjunction with the door protection system to discourage the registering of false calls. All car calls shall be canceled if the car makes two consecutive stops for car calls and the beam of the door protection system is not interrupted or the Load Measurement Device detects no load in the cab

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Firefighters Emergency Recall - An emergency return system shall be provided in full compliance with the latest state, local and ASME Code requirements. Heat, smoke and products of combustion sensing device (sensors) and sensor wiring to the elevator controller are included in the scope of this contract.

Firefighters Service Phase I - In the event of an emergency, the Firefighters 3.11 Service Feature will enable those cars away from the recall floor to return to the recall floor immediately. The car arriving at the recall floor will remain parked with the doors open.

Firefighters Service Phase II - Contractor will provide Firefighters Service Phase Il operation for use by trained emergency service personnel

A key-operated switch as required by local regulations, will be provided in the car-operating panel of each car. The Firefighters Service Phase II operation will become effective when the Landing Fire Service switch is in the "ON" position or a smoke detector has been activated and the car has returned to the main or alternate Fire Service floor.

Independent Service - Independent Service shall be available to remove a car from the bank. When the switch is closed, the car is removed from the bank operations and all it's existing car calls are canceled. Registering a car call shall initiate door closing and travel to the chosen floor. On arrival, the doors shall open and remain open until another car call is registered. The car shall respond to only one call at a time, and all other car calls shall be cancelled after the car makes its first stop.

Electrical – Contractor shall: 3.14

Furnish and install shunt trip breakers.

Furnish and install 110 volt disc. Furnish and install 110 volt disconnect switches for car lighting.

Furnish and install GFCI receptacles.

Furnish and install fluorescent lighting in the machine room.

### 3.15 Hoistway — Contractor shall:

- 1. Provide 75-degree bevel guards on all projections, recesses or setbacks over two inches, except for the loading or unloading side.
  - 2. Provide pit light, light switch to be located adjacent to each pit entrance.
  - 3 Provide a legal hoistway inclusive of ventilation and shaftway bevel guards as required.
  - 4. Cutting and patching walls and floors.
  - 5. Where required, provide a pit access ladder for each elevator.

- 6. Where required, provide a lockable, self-closing, fire-rated pit door.
- 7 Hoistway venting or pressurization to prevent accumulation of smoke and gas as required by Local Building Code

# 3.16 <u>Machine Room</u> Contractor shall perform the following:

- 1. As required in the machine hoistway and/or pit enclosure, relocate all non-elevator oriented conduit, ducts and drains from elevator machine room. Enclosure requirements are to be two-hour rated.
- 2 Provide means to control room temperature and humidity to between 55 F and 90 F with relative humidity of not more than 85 % non-condensing. Peak equipment heat release is estimated at 26, 000 BTU/Hour/Unit for Traction or minimum of 6,000 BTU/Hour/Unit (maximum=9,000 BTU/Hour/Unit) for Hydraulic Elevator.
- 3. Provide machine room smoke/heat detector as required by regulation. In the event sprinklers are anticipated within the machine room area, means need to be provided to remove primary power prior to the application of water as required by code.
- 4 Provide connection at the first elevator controller for fire recall operation.

  Auto-recall is needed to respond to a life safety system/fire alarm system.
- 5 Provide proper lighting in the elevator machine rooms in the vicinity of each controller and mainline disconnect.
- 6 Provide feeder and branch wiring circuits to the controller of cooper wire, including a main line switch and convenience outlets.
- 7. Provide telephone outlet for each elevator connected to controller in machine room.
- 8. Provide a self-closing and locking access machine room door.
- 9 Provide an "ABC" fire extinguisher

# 4.INSPECTION:

- Contractor shall inspect existing conditions governing this work during pre-bid site inspection to determine conditions and extent of work required. No allowance will be made subsequently on behalf of the contractor for any error or negligence on his part in connection with this requirement.
- 4.2 The Contractor shall inspect all elements subject to movement or damage prior to commencing work.

# 5. SHOP DRAWINGS:

5.1 Contractor shall provide three (3) sets of shop drawings to owner specifying products and installation methods for the scope of work as defined in Section 3.

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### 6. TEMPORARY FACILITIES:

- The Owner will provide normal electrical supply from the currently installed electrical system in the building for the use of the contractor. However, the Owner provides no guarantee or warranty as to the systems condition or capabilities. The Contractor shall assure himself that the electrical system is adequate for his requirements or supply additional temporary electrical power at his own expense.
- Any damage to the electrical system resulting from misuse or abuse to the existing electrical system shall be repaired or replaced by the contractor at no expense to the owner.

## 7. COORDINATION OF WORK:

- 7.1 The Contractor shall coordinate with the maintenance supervisor for the proper relation of the work to the building structure and to the employees therein. In the event of conflict the building employees shall prevail.
- 7.2 The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to protect the interior of the building from debris, dust or any residues occurring from the scope of work.
- 7.3 The Contractor shall provide the Owner with a schedule of work seven calendar days prior to the start of the work. The Owner shall be notified of any variances to the work schedule two (2) working days prior to the change.

# 8. WARRANTY: (GUARANTEE)

The Contractor warrants to the Owner all materials and equipment will be new, and that all work will be of good quality, free from faults and defects in conformance with the contract documents. All work not conforming with these requirements may be considered defective.

# 9. PERMITS:

The Contractor shall secure and pay for the building permit and for all other permits, governmental fees and licenses which are necessary for the proper execution and completion of the work as specified.

### 10. CLEAN UP:

The Contractor shall keep the work area as clean as possible during the entire progress of work, and shall be responsible to remove from the site, the packaging materials from his products and other debris as it accumulates. All items of equipment that are removed to allow the installation of new items will become the property of the contractor to dispose of at a landfill or location authorized to accept the items as waste or recycled parts.

# 11. WAGE RATES:

11.1 The Contractor and any sub-contractors shall pay the higher of the U.S. Department of Labor Minimum wage rates or of the West Virginia Department of Labor wage rates as established for **PRESTON COUNTY** pursuant to West Virginia Code 21-5-1, et seq.

# 12. PROGRESS PAYMENTS:

- Due to the size and complexity of the project, two progress payments will be permitted, these may by submitted at 50% and 100% completion.
- 12.2 At each progress payment, the Contractor shall submit to the Owner one original invoice for payment, supported by such data substantiating the contractor's right to payment under the terms in this contract. After agreement by both parties, the Owner shall make payment.
- Application for payment shall be submitted to the Owner for work completed and approved by the Owner. The Owner reserves the right to refuse payment in the event the completed work is not commensurate with the amount shown on the Application for Payment or if the completed work is not in accordance with industry standards or sub-standard in any way.
- Payment for the completion of this project shall be made by the Owner to the Contractor when the contract work is completed in its entirety and inspected and approved by the Owner.

# 13. TERM OF WORK

13.1 All work shall be complete within a maximum of 60 calendar days from the issuance of the notice to proceed

# 14. DELAYS AND EXTENSION OF TIME:

14.1 If the Contractor is delayed at any time in the progress of the work by any act or neglect of the Owner or by any employee of the Owner, or by any separate contractor employed by the Owner, or by changes in the work, or by labor disputes, fire, unusual delay in transportation, adverse weather conditions not reasonably anticipated, unavoidable casualties, or any other cause which the Owner determines may justify the delay, then the contract time may be extended by written approval of the Owner.

# 15. TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT STORAGE:

Owner shall provide a location on the site for all equipment and tools. The Contractor is responsible to safeguard his tools, equipment and materials.

# **16. SAFETY EQUIPMENT:**

16.1 The Contractor shall provide safety barriers around work areas where heavy equipment may be in operation when placing materials in the building or as required by OSHA.

# 17. DAMAGES:

Any damages occurring to the building or property resulting from the performance of this work shall be the responsibility of the contractor to repair at his expense, either by using his own forces or that of a sub-contractor. The repair method and finished product will be subject to the approval of the owner.

# 18. SCHEDULE OF BID RESPONSES

- 18.1 Bidders shall submit one lump-sum bid for all the work under all the terms and conditions as described herein.
- 18.2 Bidders shall also submit full warranty information for each product as described in section 3. The warranty information shall minimally contain the product warranty and labor warranty product.
- The Bidders are requested to submit references, including the name, address, and telephone number of a contact person (someone specifically familiar with the Contractor's work) for at least three (3) previous users of service. Include descriptions of projects, locations, and records that were generated during the project


