- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes

Understanding a whirlpool:

A whirlpool uses the water in the bath to drive the jets to create the whirlpool action in the water. The whirlpool itself cannot be turned on until all jets are covered with water, if it is you can ruin the pump. Nor can a whirlpool system be completely drained. Again, by design, the internal plumbing system allows water to remain in the plumbing lines and pump between baths. This dark damp environment is a perfect environment for the growth of harmful bacteria. Even with their recommended cleaning procedures of back flushing the system between baths, the lines cannot be thoroughly cleaned; no disinfectant on the market today can clean without scrubbing.
