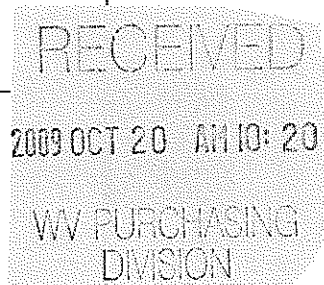

REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

School bus manufacturers will construct a pilot unit and provide expenses for approval by the West Virginia Executive Director, Office of School Transportation and/or his designee, prior to assembly line production of West Virginia school buses.

Specifications

Line setting tickets shall be furnished by the manufacturer for all vehicles.

Successful bidder will issue application for title at least 20 working days prior to the anticipated delivery date of completed units. 5-day advance notification to the ordering agency must be given prior to the actual delivery date.

Any component supplied by a bidder as an equivalent (where equivalent is permitted in the Minimum Requirements) must have prior approval, in writing, from the Executive Director, Office of School Transportation.

Delivery

Successful vendor shall be required to deliver buses within 120 days after receipt of order.

2010 SCHOOL BUS SPECIFICATION ADDENDUM

All school buses shall be set for a maximum speed of 65mph and in the economy mode prior to delivery. County Transportation Directors may apply for a waiver to the West Virginia Department of Education's Executive Director of School Transportation.

Gear ratios shall be determined for the most economical mode and verified with the West Virginia Department of Education's Executive Director of School Transportation.

A maximum idle time shall be set at 10 minutes.

BRAKES

- B. ABS automatic traction control system shall be standard on units with air brakes
 - B. 1. d. Be protected by a desiccant typed air dryer, with an ADIP or equal spin-on replaceable filter.
- B.2.g. A Schrader valve to charge the school bus air system in the event of a compressor failure shall be provided
 - h. Park brake release shall not be affected by any electrical failure.
 - i. Have at least 7" X 16 ½" brake blocks.
 - j. Be equipped with MGM long stroke welded clevis air chambers or equivalent.

 - l. Rear axle shall be equipped with oil deflector (that will direct oil from the brake surface).

SBUS10 Pre-Bid Questions and Answers

1. Would it be possible to extend the bid opening date from October 15th to October 22nd?

The Bid date has been changed to Oct. 10, 2009.

2. Maximum idle time shall be set for 10 minutes. Should exemption for special needs buses be added to this requirement?

All special needs buses are exempted from the idle time provision.

3. Maximum speed shall be set for 65MPH while differential section states that bus maximum speed shall not exceed 70 MPH.

Maximum speed shall be 65 MPH.

4. Gear ratios shall be determined for the most economical mode and verified with the West Virginia Department of Education's Executive Director of School Transportation while differential section states that purchaser shall specify differential ratio.

Specification is correct as stated.

5. ABS automatic traction control system shall be standard on all units with air brakes. Our request is that this requirement state that ABS with a differential traction control device may be used in lieu of ABS traction control.

A one year exemption for transit buses will be allowed requiring an ABS automatic traction control system. The locking differential will be allowed as a substitute.

6. A Schrader valve to charge the school bus air system in the event of a compressor failure shall be provided. Our request is that the words "Schrader Valve" be replaced with the words (external charging port.)

An external charging port is an approved equal to the Schrader Valve.

7. Park brake release shall not be affected by an electrical failure. The use of a park brake interlocking valve which is a State requirement listed under brakes requires the use of an electrical solenoid. For this reason the parking brake can not be released without electricity if the bus is equipped with a parking brake interlock system.

The specification should read the park brake release shall be on an individual circuit.

8. Rear axle oil deflectors. IC bus removed oil deflectors from all product lines in 2001 and they are not available on any IC products. Our request is that this requirement be removed from the specifications.

The rear axle oil deflectors specification is waived for this year.

9. BWAB and IC Bus, LLC request the following action be considered in reference to West Virginia specification Section Lamps And Signals G. School Bus Alternately Flashing Signal Lamps 5. Signal lamp system shall operate as follows: item f. This section to be changed to read as follows "The signal lamp system shall have an emergency override switch or other method to activate the red warning lamps with the vehicle ignition switch in either the on or off position." The rationale is that if a unit is in a stationary position (ignition in off position) the only warning lights that should operate would be the red warning lights keeping with the same procedure as a normal route stop; if a warning method is needed on a school yard for the purpose of slowing

traffic flow the use of the hazard lamps would be a more appropriate operational mode to use. Example of an emergency override (fail-safe) switch for the red warning lamps can be found in the Ohio specifications. It is listed as an emergency override system for the red warning lamps and labeled accordingly and functions with ignition in any position. This is currently the system that IC Bus is using on our product.

IC's emergency override system is approved as an equal to the specified School Bus Alternately Flashing Signal Lamps system for this year.
