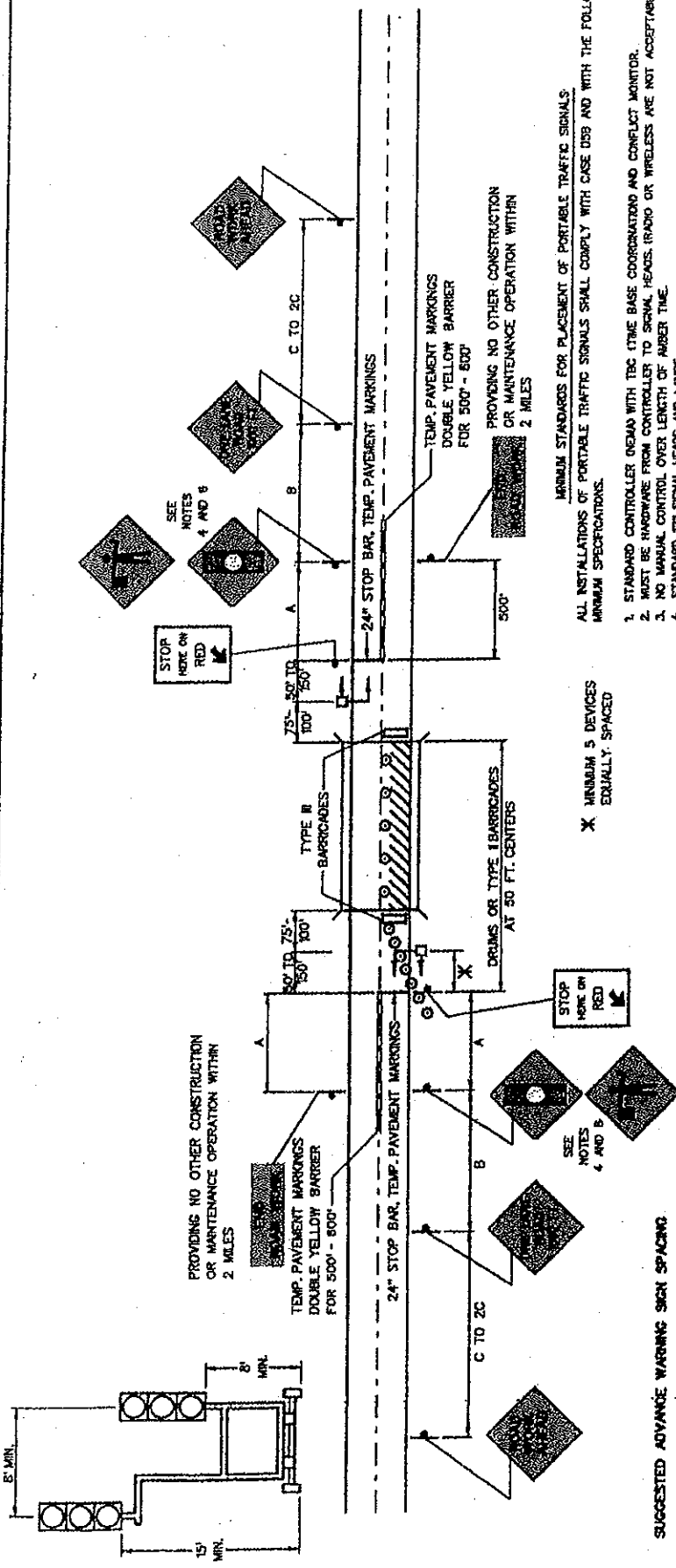
COST INCLUDES:

1. Installation and maintenance of temporary portable traffic light system to restrict traffic to one lane on the subject structure in accordance with Case D5B of the 2006 edition of the Department's Manual on Temporary Traffic Control for Streets and Highways. Traffic control signs and pavement markings will be done by others. Also no generators for power supply will be allowed.
2. The contractor has the option to install an overhead system in accordance with Case D5A of the same traffic manual.
3. Installation of electrical service pole and arranging for electrical service with the utility. Cost of electrical service will also be included. Electrical power wires will be carried by approved conduit which can be attached to the bridge.
4. Work is to begin within 10 calendar days of award.
5. This project is initially expected to last for 15 months until bridge replacement project is let. Bridge contractor will then assume cost of continuing service. Bridge project expected to last at least an additional 18 months.

ALL INSTALLATIONS OF PORTABLE TRAFFIC SIGNALS SHALL COMPLY WITH CASE D5B AND WITH THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS.

1. STANDARD CONTROLLER ONEMAN WITH TBC (TIME BASE COORDINATION AND CONFLICT MONITOR).

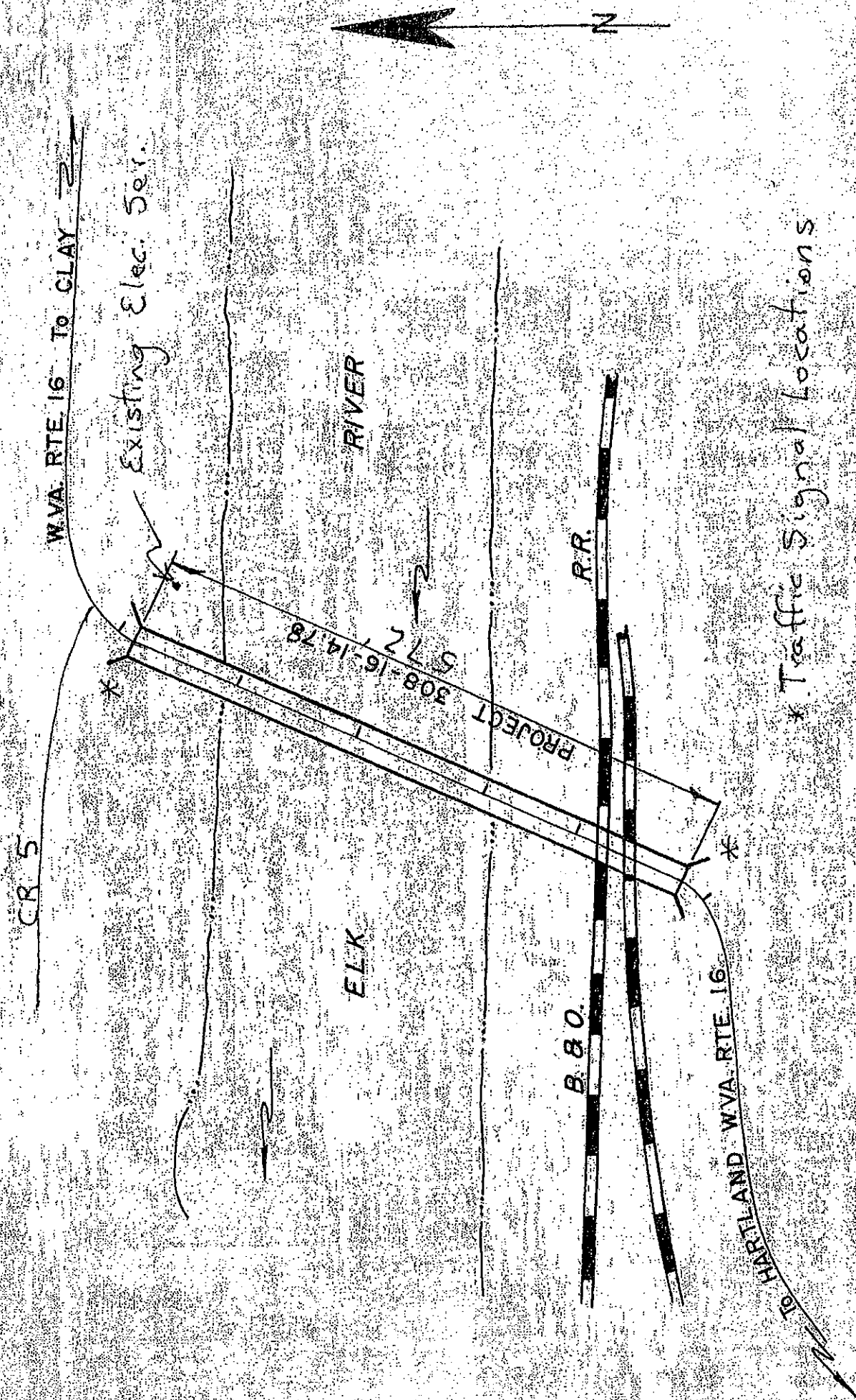

THIS MAY REQUIRE THE TRAILER WITH SIGNALS TO BE PLACED BEHIND GUARDRAIL OR SOME METHOD TO PLACE THE TRAILER OFF THE ROADWAY. WHEN USED AS A THREE PHASE SIGNAL FOR AN ADDITIONAL SIGNALIZED APPROACH, A THIRD TRAILER OR TEMPORARY SUPPORT SHOULD BE USED TO PROVIDE HIGHLOW INDICATIONS SEPARATED HORIZONTALLY BY 8 FEET.

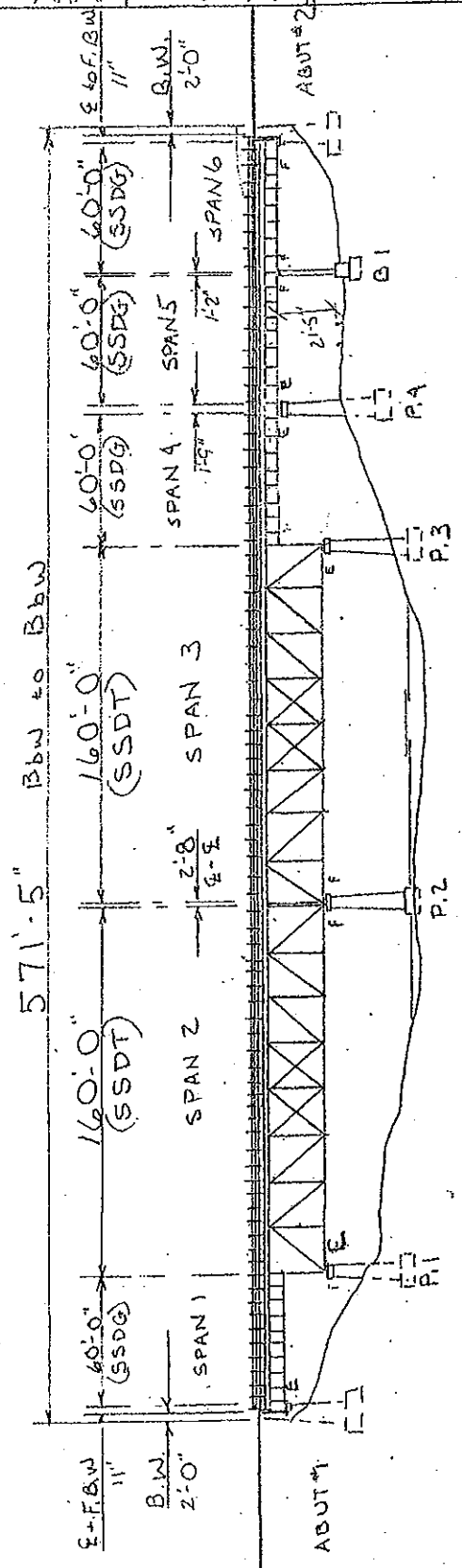


* Traffic Signal Locations

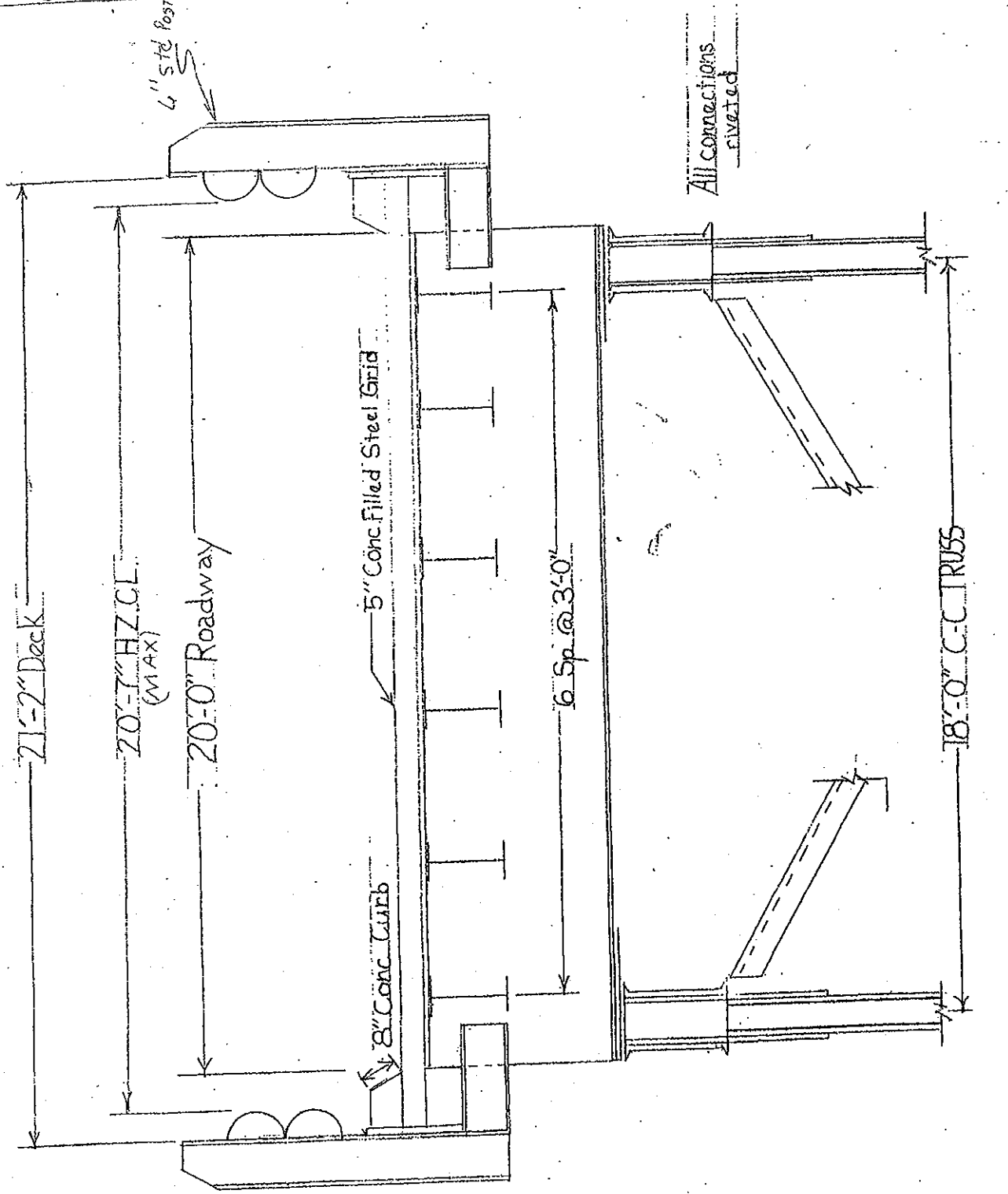

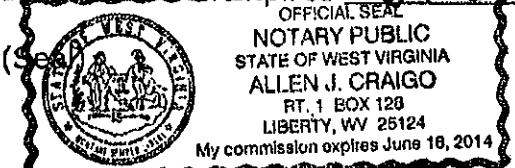

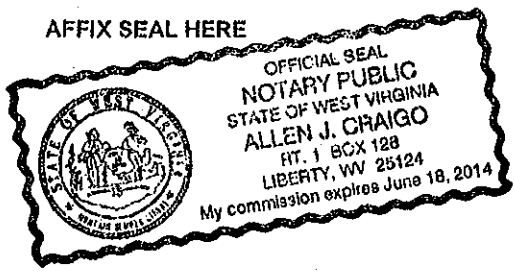
