GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. - 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. 1. SPECIFICATIONS

The following sections of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges, adopted 2010 as modified by the January 1, 2011 Supplemental Specifications shall apply to the administration of this contract: Sections 715.23.1, 715.23.2, 715.23.3, 715.23.4, 715.23.4.1, 715.23.4.2, 715.23.5, 715.23.5.1 and 715.23.5.2.

The terms "Contractor" and "Vendor" used in the above specifications of this contract are interchangeable. Contractor shall mean Vendor and Vendor shall mean Contractor.

2. <u>SCOPE OF WORK</u>

To provide various sizes of twisted wire mesh or welded wire mesh Gabion Baskets including tie wire to the WV Division of Highways to be delivered to District sites as specified in Section 8. Gabion Baskets shall be of uniform size and delivered flat. Tie wire is to be included in the price of the Gabion Baskets and is not to be priced separately or ordered separately.

3. <u>AWARD</u>

Vendors who submit a valid low bid will be awarded a contract for those items for which their bid is lowest per District. The State of WV reserves the right to make multiple awards on this contract when it is in the best interest of the State.

4. QUANTITIES

The quantities listed on the bid schedule, Section 9, are estimates only. An Agency Release will be issued to the awarded vendor for actual quantities as the need arises.

5. **DELIVERY**

Vendor will deliver orders F.O.B. to the Division of Highways District sites as specified in Section 8. Vendor shall complete delivery of Gabion Baskets to the Division of Highways District sites as specified in Section 8 within sixty (60) calendar days of receipt of the Agency Release.

- Vendor may add shipping charges for order of less than 50 Gabion Baskets per delivery site.

 Vendor shall provide a delivery document, freight bill, with each load indicating the number of items delivered and the actual or calculated gross vehicular weight of the delivery vehicle. The total number of delivery vehicle axles shall also be recorded on the delivery document.
- The vendor shall notify the Division of Highways District Storekeeper twenty-four (24) hours in advance of delivery to ensure personnel are available for unloading.

Contact is to be made to the named individuals or their representative at the telephone number given in Section 8 of this contract.

The Division of Highways reserves the right to pickup an order of less than 50 Gabion Baskets with no additional freight to be charged. This will be indicated on the Agency Release.

6. <u>VENDOR'S INVOICE</u>

Vendor's invoices must be submitted in original and one copy and contain the following:

- a. The Agency Release Number and this Contract Number.
- b. Item description, total quantity, unit price and the total cost of the material furnished.

Note: Under no circumstance will the Division of Highways accept, or pay for, quantities of material in excess of the quantity stated on the Agency Release.

7. PURCHASING CARD ACCEPTANCE

The State of West Virginia currently utilizes a VISA Purchasing Card Program which is issued through a bank. The successful vendor must accept the State of West Virginia VISA Purchasing Card for payment of orders placed by Division of Highways Agency Releases for orders as a condition of award.

Product Description

Gabions are baskets manufactured from 8x10 double twisted hexagonal woven steel wire mesh, as per ASTM A975-97 (Figs. 1, 2). Gabions are filled with stones at the project site to form flexible, permeable, monolithic structures such as retaining walls, channel linings, and weirs for erosion control projects.

The steel wire used in the manufacture of the gabion is heavily zinc coated soft temper steel. A PVC coating is then applied to provide additional protection for use in polluted, contaminated or aggressive environments: in salt, fresh water, acid soil or wherever the risk of corrosion is present. The PVC coating has a nominal thickness of 0.02 in. (0.50 mm). The standard specifications of the mesh-wire are shown in Table 2.

The gabion is divided into cells by diaphragms positioned at approximately 3 ft (0.9 m) centers (Fig. 1).

To reinforce the structure, all mesh panel edges are selvedged with a wire having a greater diameter (Table 3). Dimensions and sizes of PVC coated gabions are shown in Table 1.

Gabions shall be manufactured and shipped with all components mechanically connected at the production facility.

Wire

All tests on wire must be performed prior to manufacturing the mesh. All wire should comply with ASTM A975-97, style 3 coating, galvanized and PVC coated steel wire. Wire used for the manufacture of gabions and the lacing wire, shall have a maximum tensile strength of 75 000 psi (515 MPa) as per ASTM A641/A641M-03, soft temper steel.

Woven Wire Mesh Type 8x10


The mesh and wire characteristics shall be in accordance with ASTM A975-97 Table 1, Mesh type 8x10 and PVC coated. The nominal mesh opening, D = 3.25 in. (83 mm) as per Fig. 2. The minimum mesh properties for strength and flexibility should be in accordance with the following:

- Mesh Tensile Strength shall be a minimum of 2900 lb/ft (42.3 kN/m) when tested in accordance with ASTM A975-97 section 13.1.1.
- Punch Test resistance shall be a minimum of 5300 lb (23.6 kN) when tested in compliance with ASTM A975-97 section 13.1.4.
- Connection to Selvedges shall be 1200 lb/ft (17.5 kN/m) when tested in accordance with ASTM A975-97.

P.V.C. (Polyvinyl Chloride) Coating

The technical characteristics and the resistance of the PVC to aging should meet the relevant standards. The main values for the PVC material are as follows:

- The initial property of the PVC coating shall be in compliance with ASTM A975-97 section 8.2.
- Prior to UV and abrasion degradation, the PVC polymer coating shall have a projected minimum durability of 60 years when tested in accordance with UL 746B Polymeric Material—Long Term Property Evaluation for heat aging test.



The tolerance on the opening of mesh 'D' being the distance between the axis of two consecutive twists, is according to ASTM A975-97

Lacing, Assembly and Installation

Gabion units are assembled and connected to one another using lacing wire specified in Table 3 and described in Fig. 3. MacTie preformed stiffeners or lacing wire can be used as internal connecting wires when a structure requires more than one layer of gabions to be stacked on top of each other. Internal connecting wires with lacing wire shall connect the exposed face of a cell to the opposite side of the cell. Internal connecting preformed stiffeners shall connect the exposed face of a cell to the adjacent side of the cell. Preformed stiffeners are installed at 45° to the face/side of the unit, extending an equal distance along each side to be braced (approximately 1 ft. (300 mm)). An exposed face is any side of a gabion cell that will be exposed or unsupported after the structure is completed.

Stainless steel ring fasteners can be used instead of, or to complement, the lacing wire (Fig. 4).
