Brief Timeline

We have been in business since the 1920s as International Harvester, Dresser, Komatsu-Dresser, Komatsu and Dressta.

- 2007 Bolingbrook, Illinois Parts Depot opened to better serve Dressta customers
- 2005 HSW purchased the Komatsu portion of the joint venture. Komatsu and Dressta parts were serviced from the Komatsu parts facility in Ripley Tennessee.
- 2001 Komatsu and HSW agreed to separate Dressta and Komatsu sales divisions but continued to service all parts from the Komatsu facility in Ripley Tennessee
- 1998 Due to the acquisition of Dressta by Halliburton Corp. the Dresser brand changed to Dressta which was used in other parts of the world.
- 1985 Komatsu purchased the remaining Dresser interest in KDC. Machines were sold as Komatsu and Dresser branded products. Poland's HSW continued to build Dresser and some Komatsu machines
- 1983 Komatsu of Japan bought 40% of Dresser's Construction Equipment business. Machines were sold as Komatsu and Dresser brands
- 1980 International Harvester sold the construction equipment division to Dresser Industries of Dallas Texas. The machines were then branded as Dresser machines



In the mid 1960's International Harvester began to ship components to HSW in Poland for assembly of dozers and likewise shipped components to Komatsu in Japan for assembly of loaders. Manufacturing continued at Libertyville and Melrose Park Illinois as well as other facilities around the world.
