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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

The West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR), Bureau of Public Health (BPH), Office of Emergency Medical Services (OEMS), Division of Medical Communications, hereinafter referred to as the "Agency," desires to establish an open-end contract for the purchase of various microwave antennas, lines and accessories to serve remote radio sites. The Agency is responsible for operating the Statewide Medical Command System that includes RF communications carried on its current microwave infrastructure. Other entities of West Virginia state government as well as counties, municipalities and Public Safety Agencies within the state of West Virginia shall be able to piggy back on this contract with prior approval from the Agency.

1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1.1 Vendor quoted amounts shall include freight and shipping costs F.O.B. to destination to any West Virginia location. Specifically, no additional charges shall be quoted for shipping.
- 1.2 Vendor must complete the price list quote sheet and include the lowest catalog list price, the percent discount, and the quoted price on the sheet.
- 1.3 If percent discount differs for other categories of equipment, then the vendor must include the percent discount for each category of equipment.
- 1.4 The percent discount for the sample sheet of items must be the same percent discount for that category of equipment in the catalog percent discount quote.
- 1.5 Andrew part numbers are listed to assist in product identification but equivalent parts may be quoted from other manufacturers as long as the other manufacturer is specifically noted and certified as equivalent.
- 1.6 Vendor must attach a current catalog price list.
- 1.7 The percent discount from list shall remain the same during the entire contract period, including any renewals.
- 1.8 Accessories shall be priced in lots to indicate price breaks per volume ordered.
- 1.9 Items listed are not to be construed to be the only items needed. The list represents the most frequently utilized items. It is the intent of the State to utilize the entire catalog of like items.
- 1.10 Each quotation must contain, at a minimum, technical documentation including literature sufficient for an effective evaluation of the equipment being proposed.

- 1.11 If, for any reason, before final acceptance, the equipment is found to be defective or not as warranted and/or contracted for, WV DHHR BPH OEMS may refuse to accept it and the Bidder shall be so advised and shall be required to correct the defective equipment within a reasonable time as defined by WV DHHR BPH OEMS. All costs relating thereto, including freight, shall be at Bidder's own expense.
- 1.12 Award of this contract will go to a single vendor who meets all of the specifications as outlined in this RFQ at the lowest price.
- 1.13 The contents of the submission of the successful Bidder shall be considered as contractual obligations. Failure to meet these obligations may result in voidance of the contract.
- 1.14 The Agency will issue a State contract order form to the vendor for items covered by this contract with item quantities and location for delivery.
- 1.15 Payment to vendor will be made following delivery of equipment ordered once a final and complete invoice is received. Payment will be made within 60 days of invoice upon agency approval and acceptance.
- 1.16 WV BPH OEMS may place orders that will be paid for with ARRA funds. The successful vendor must agree to and sign the attached ARRA statement. Any order placed with ARRA funds will be noted on the purchase order.

SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT PROVISIONS ARRA FUNDING

The Contractor is hereby notified that this project will be financed with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (hereinafter, "ARRA") Funds.

Required Contract Provision to Implement ARRA Section 902

Section 902 of the ARRA requires that each contract awarded using ARRA funds must include a provision that provides the U.S. Comptroller General and his representatives with the authority to:

- (1) examine any records of the contractor or any of its subcontractors, or any State or local agency administering such contract, that directly pertain to, and involve transactions relating to, the contract or subcontract; and
- (2) Interview any officer or employee of the contractor or any of its subcontractors, or of any State or local government agency administering the contract, regarding such transactions.

Accordingly, the Comptroller General and his representatives shall have the authority and rights prescribed under Section 902 of the ARRA with respect to contracts funded with recovery funds made available under the ARRA. Section 902 further states that nothing in 902 shall be interpreted to limit or restrict in any way any existing authority of the Comptroller General.

Authority of the Inspector General provision

Section 1515(a) of the ARRA provides authority for any representatives of the United States Inspector General to examine any records or interview any employee or officers working on this contract. The contractor is advised that representatives of the inspector General have the authority to examine any record and interview any employee or officer of the contractor, its subcontractors or other firms working on this contract. Section 1515(b) further provides that nothing in this section shall be interpreted to limit or restrict in any way any existing authority of an inspector General.

Buy American Provision

Use of American Iron, Steel, and Manufactured Goods

Recipients may not use any funds obligated under this award for the construction, alteration, maintenance, or repair of a public building or public work unless all of the iron, steel, and manufactured goods used in the project are produced in the United States unless HHS waives the application of this provision. (ARRA Sec. 1605)

Wage Rate Provision

[This term and condition shall not apply to tribal contracts entered into by the Indian Health Service funded with this appropriation. (ARRA Title VII - Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies, Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Facilities)]

Subject to further clarification issued by the Office of Management and Budget, and notwithstanding any other provision of law and in a manner consistent with other provisions of ARRA, all laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors on projects funded directly by or assisted in whole or in part by and through the Federal Government pursuant to this award shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on projects of

a character similar in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with subchapter IV of chapter 31 of title 40, United States Code. With respect to the labor standards specified in this section, the Secretary of Labor shall have the authority and functions set forth in Reorganization Plan Numbered 14 of 1950 (64 Stat. 1267; 5 U.S.C. App.) and section 3145 of title 40, United States Code. (ARRA Sec. 1606)

Limit on Funds

None of the funds appropriated or otherwise made available in ARRA may be used by any State or local government, or any private entity, for any casino or other gambling establishment, aquarium, zoo, golf course, or swimming pool. (ARRA Sec. 1604)

Disclosure of Fraud or Misconduct

Each recipient of sub-recipient awarded funds made available under the ARRA shall promptly refer to the HHS Office of Inspector General any credible evidence that a principal, employee, agent, contractor, sub-recipient, subcontractor, or other person has submitted a false claim under the False Claims Act or has committed a criminal or civil violation of laws pertaining to fraud, conflict of interest, bribery, gratuity, or similar misconduct involving those funds. Contractor Data Reporting

The contractor must provide the WV Department of Health and Human Resources with their D-U-N-S number if available, or otherwise the name and zip code of the contractor's headquarters. Contractors are not required to obtain a D-U-N-S number.

Reporting Jobs Creation

Pursuant to Title XV, Section 1512 of the ARRA, the State shall require that the Contractor provide reports and other employment information as evidence to document the number of jobs created or jobs retained by this contract from the Contractor's own workforce. No direct payment will be made for providing said reports, as the cost for same shall be included in the various items in the contract. The WV Department of Health and Human Resources will not accept statistical sampling methods to estimate the number of jobs created and retained. All recipients must report a direct and comprehensive count of jobs, as specified by OMB guidance M-10-8. PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (West Virginia Code §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.


