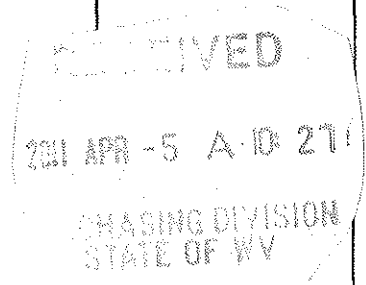

The West Virginia Purchasing Division for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is requesting bids for the purchase of a Four Wheel Drive, Diesel Utility Tractor with Front End Loader and Backhoe Attachment. All items are to be F.O.B. Destination. Freight or delivery charges must be included in the price of the goods. Delivery must be made within thirty (30) days of purchase order award.

General Specifications:

The Four Wheel Drive, Diesel Utility Tractor with Front End Loader and Backhoe Attachment must be new (2011 model).

Information for Bidders:

Bidders must submit a unit price bid for each item to furnish all items specified.

Damaged Items:

Damaged or defective items must be replaced at no additional expense to The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources.

Warranty:

The equipment must be guaranteed to be free of defects in workmanship and material for a minimum of one (1) year from date of acceptance. However, if manufacturer warranty periods are longer than the required minimum one year warranty, those warranties shall apply.

Item #1 Four Wheel Drive, Diesel Utility Tractor with Front End Loader

John Deere Model 5075M Utility Tractor with John Deere Model 553 Front Loader, or equal.

Tractor must meet the following specifications:

- Must be four-wheel drive;
- Must have a minimum 75 horsepower diesel engine;
- Must have a minimum PTO horsepower of 60;
- Must have a synchronized hydraulic shuttle transmission (power reverser);
- Must have telescopic lower link ends and telescopic stabilizers on lift arms;
- Must have a front grill guard and brush guard;
- Must have operational lights;
- Must have a roll over protection system;
- Must have dual rear standard remote valves with lever controls;
- Must have a cold weather package;
- Must have an open operator station;

- Must have a drawbar and clevis attached;
- Must have general farming rated tires (R-1 grade);
- Must have all tires filled with Polyfil;
- Must have a power beyond coupler kit to accommodate backhoe attachment;
- Must include an operators manual and a demonstration of equipment must be provided upon delivery.

Front Loader must meet the following specifications:

- Must have a free standing quick attachment system for loader frame and bucket;
- Must have a minimum lift capacity of 2,000 pounds;
- Must have a minimum front end lift height of 10 feet;
- Must have a six-foot general purpose bucket;
- Must include two open center, mid-mounted loader valves with a four-way joystick.

Item #2 Backhoe Attachment

Bush Hog Model CBH 80 Backhoe or equal.

Backhoe attachment must meet the following specifications:

- Must attach to 3-point hitch system of tractor;
- Must attach to Power Beyond hydraulic couplings on tractor;
- Must have a digging depth of at least 8 feet;
- Must have a bucket cylinder digging force of at least 3800 pounds;

- Must have cast flip over stabilizer pads;
- Must have an 18 inch commercial duty bucket with bolt on teeth with replaceable tips;
- Must have a fully adjustable operator's seat;

By submission of this certificate, Bidder agrees to disclose any reasonably requested information to the Purchasing Division and authorizes the Department of Revenue to disclose to the Director of Purchasing appropriate information verifying that Bidder has paid the required business taxes, provided that such information does not contain the amounts of taxes paid nor any other information deemed by the Tax Commissioner to be confidential.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
