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Specifications

Purpose: To provide the West Virginia Divisions of Highways with precast concrete box sections for a Marion County project located on County Route 27 at milepost 0.39 (Coons Run).

1.0 DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the West Virginia Division of Highways
- B. The "Vendor" shall be defined as the successful bidder.
- C. The "Purchase Order" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must", "will", "shall", "minimum", "maximum", or "is/are required" identify a mandatory item or factor. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the Agency.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The Vendor shall provide 40 LF of 18'x8' Precast Concrete Box Sections with joint sealer.

2.1 Technical Requirements

All box sections and accessories manufactured and delivered shall be in accordance with Section 604 of the West Virginia Division of Highways Standard Specifications Roads and Bridges (Standard Specs), adopted 2010 and the current Supplemental specifications. The sections shall have an 18 foot span and an 8 foot rise and be designed for a cover range of less than 2 feet and all welded wire reinforcement and reinforcing steel bars shall be epoxy coated in accordance with AASHTO M284. The manufactured length of each box section shall be 4 feet. The Vendor shall furnish a sufficient amount of joint sealer

3.0 INVOICING

3.1 Payment

3.1.2 The State of West Virginia currently utilizes a VISA Purchasing Card Program which is issued through a bank. The Vendor must accept the State of West Virginia VISA Purchasing Card for payment of all orders placed by the Agency for orders as a condition of award.

3.1.3 Upon completion of manufacture and approval by the Agency of all Box Sections specified on the Purchase Order, the Vendor may invoice and the Agency will pay for the cost of manufacturing the Box Sections, not to exceed 65% of the total cost of the delivered Box Sections. Partial payment for Box Sections shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. The Vendor must request partial payment and furnish an official invoice for the manufactured and approved Box Sections.
- b. The partial payment invoice shall be accompanied by a surety bond equal to the invoiced amount guaranteeing delivery of all items specified on the Purchase Order.
- c. The Vendor shall furnish a statement of approved Box Sections condition and exact storage location.
- d. The Vendor shall furnish a legal right-of-entry onto the storage site to Agency employees and/or agents for the purpose of inspecting, sampling, testing and removing any or all Box Sections.

4.0 AWARD

4.1 A Purchase Order will be awarded to the lowest acceptable bidder.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
13. **HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM:** The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.html and is hereby made part of the agreement provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
