REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
 12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

Specifications

Purpose: The WV Division of Highways, District Four is contracting for an Open-End Contract for the purchase and delivery of Liquid Propane Gas (LPG) for consumption at the facilities listed below:

Preston County Headquarters: 4 tanks @ 1,000 gallons each
Preston County Fellowsville Substation: 1 tank @ 1,000 gallons
Monongalia Headquarters: 3 tanks @ 1,000 gallons
Coopers Rock Substation: 2 tanks @ 1,000 gallons 1 tank @ 500 gallons
I-68 Welcome enter: 4 tanks @ 1,000 gallons

1.0 DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the West Virginia Division of Highways
- B. The "Vendor" shall be defined as the successful bidder.
- C. The "Contract" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must", "will", "shall", "minimum", "maximum", or "is/are required" identify a mandatory item or factor. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The successful Vendor shall provide labor and materials necessary to supply LP Gas to the locations specified in this contract. Bid prices must remain constant throughout the life of this contract.

2.1 Pricing

2.2.2 Vendors must bid a firm fixed mark-up price per gallon on fuel delivery with product price tied to the OIL PRICE INFORMATION SERVICE (OPIS) publication. Prices should reflect the OPIS price for the terminal used to service District Four. The OPIS price used in bid evaluation shall be the OPIS average of the

bid opening week, for the terminal listed by the bidder for District Four. All prices quoted shall be delivered price to each location within district four.

FIRM FIXED MARK-UP PER GALLON: *The vendor is to bid only a firm fixed mark-up for business profit and expenses in supplying to a State Agency. Product cost shall be the average rack price of the products as published (for the preceding week) for the vendor supply terminal location in the OIL PRICE INFORMATION SERVICE. 2.2 Freight

2.2.1 Bidders shall incorporate all delivery costs into their unit price. No additional freight will be paid by the WVDOH.

2.3 Delivery

2.3.1 Deliveries shall be made within ten (10) working days after the vendor receives the WV-39 Blanket release Order stating items and quantities to be purchased. If for some reason the vendor is unable to meet the ten (10) day delivery time on any specific item, the vendor must contact the requesting Agency to provide a reason for the delay and expected date the item(s) will be delivered.

3.0 ORDERING AND INVOICING

3.1 Release Orders

3.1.1 For all orders, the Agency will issue to the Vendor a WV-39 Release Order. Issuance of the Release Order shall contain the type of merchandise to be purchased and shall serve as the authorization to begin work. No work other than that specified in the release Order shall be undertaken by the vendor.

3.1.2 Release Orders may be placed by any or all of the WVDOH locations listed in the cost sheet.
