1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.

3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.

Specifications

Purpose: To establish an open end contract to provide the West Virginia Division of Highways with fuel pumps and fuel pump dispensers

1.0 DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the West Virginia Division of Highways
- B. The "Vendor" shall be defined as the successful bidder.
- C. The "Contract" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Release Order" shall be defined as order placed against the Contract by the Agency.
- E. Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must", "will", "shall", "minimum", "maximum", or "is/are required" identify a mandatory item or factor. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The successful Vendor shall provide fuel pumps dispensers and all related parts to upgrade the agency's existing pumps to compatibility with Fuel Master Fuel Management system.

2.1 Technical Requirements:

2.1.1: AST Fleet Fuel Suction Pump

Shall be GASBOY Model 9823 KF Astra, or equal, and shall be complete with all necessary plumbing, electrical hardware, including wiring switches, controls, and all necessary accessories required to connect unit to above ground storage tank according to all state and federal guidelines. Fuel pumps shall also have a capability of being converted to metric with the change of computer chip and board decal. Fuel pump shall be UL listed and FCC

approved. The Vendor shall furnish any technical engineering service which may be needed to ensure the proper installation at no extra cost to the WVDOT.

Additional Requirements: The AST Fleet Fuel Dispenser shall meet the following minimum requirements:

- a. Regulatory Approvals: UL and W/M Listed
- b. Motor: 1 HP Continuous Duty minimum 115 VAC/(60) HZ
- c. Meter: CFT flow through positive displacement, four pistons accurate to 0.25%
- d. Filter: Integrated internal spin on filter
- e. Housing & Cabinet: Painted G90 galvanized steel
- f. Finish: White hydraulic cabinet, black remote register, blue Tedlar Faceplate
- g. Flow Rate: 20 GPM minimum
- h. Remote Electronic Register: Volume only front display 1" back lighted LCD Maximum 999.000 gallons. Electronic totalizer is displayed on LCD by magnetic switch. Reads up to 999999 battery backed totalizer, activated without the removal of panels.
- i. Discharge: 1" NTP black iron
- j. Nozzle Boot: Front mount flips up to activate pump
- k. Mechanical Totalizers: For pump unit cabinet Mechanical non-resettable reads up to 9999999
- l. Must have single pulse output to work in conjunction with Fuel Master Fuel Management System.

2.1.2 Fuel Dispenser

Shall be GASBOY Model 9853 KDF Suction Pump, or equal, and shall be complete with all necessary plumbing, electrical hardware, including wiring switches, controls, and all necessary accessories required to connect unit to underground storage tank according to all state and federal guidelines. Fuel pumps shall also have a capability of being converted to metric with the change of computer chip and board decal. Fuel pump shall be UL listed and FCC approved. The Vendor shall furnish any technical

engineering service which may be needed to ensure the proper installation at no extra cost to the WVDOH.

Additional Requirements: The Fuel Dispenser shall meet the following minimum requirements:

- a. Regulatory Approvals: UL and US Weights and Measures for resale of fuel
- b. Motor: 3/4 HP minimum Continuous Duty 115 VAC/(60) HZ
- c. Pump Unit: Rotary Vane with integrated air separator and self priming built into pump casting
- d. Meter: Four piston, positive displacement flow through CFT meter bolster resistant to fuel contamination with self cleaning chambers.
- e. Filter: Integrated internal spin on filter
- f. Cabinet & Finish: 13 gauge galvanized steel frame for superior corrosion resistance to fuel contamination with self cleaning chambers.
- g. Flow Rate: 15 GPM minimum
- h. Electronic Display Register: Volume only front display 1" back lighted LCD Maximum 999.000 gallons both front and back of cabinet.
- i. Electronic Totalizer: Battery backed electronic with magnetic actuator and should not require panels to be removed to activate totalizer
- j. Discharge: 1" NTP black iron
- k. Nozzle: Automatic nozzle unleaded type
- l. Hose: 3/4" x 12' hose
- m. Mechanical Totalizers: Each unit shall have an 8 digit non-resettable electromechanical totalizer.
- n. Must have single pulse output to work in conjunction with Fuel Master Fuel Management System.

2.1.3 Vendors bidding "or equal" merchandise must provide complete manufacturer's literature demonstrating adherence to the mandatory requirements contained herein.

2.1.4 Related parts for upgrade of exist pumps to include but not limited to:

Part # C07057 Kit

Part# C06482 Kit

Part# M06382K004 Kit

2.2 Freight

2.2.1 All shipments are to be FOB Destination.

2.2.2 The Vendor shall be responsible for all freight charges incurred as a result of the purchases under this Contract. For orders where expedited delivery is requested and authorized by the Agency, the Vendor may invoice for these charges provided that it will be given as a "pass through" cost to the Agency. No mark up shall be permitted for expedited delivery. See Section 4.2.3 for more information.

2.3 Delivery

2.3.1 Deliveries shall be made to the WVDOT locations listed on Exhibit B.

2.3.2 Release Orders shall be delivered in a maximum of three (3) working days. If the vendor is unable to deliver within five (5) working days, the Agency may purchase the required merchandise on the open market upon the approval of the Director of the WVDOT Equipment Division or the District Equipment Supervisor (or their designee). All open market purchases shall be made in accordance with the Department of Administration, Division of Purchasing Regulations. **Any changes from the indicated delivery schedule without prior written approval of the WVDOT may be cause for cancellation.**

2.3.3 All deliveries of merchandise and/or shipping documents at each WVDOT location must be properly marked on the outside of the carton showing the WVDOT Release Order Number/Contract Number. Any material delivered without this information on the outside of the carton or on the documents will be returned to the Vendor at the Vendor's expense.

2.3.4 The Vendor shall maintain, in his warehouse, adequate stock to supply the needs of WVDOH at all times.

2.3.5 A restocking charge can only be attached by the vendor with prior mutual consent of the Agency and the Vendor.

2.3.6 Delivery is an integral part of this contract and failure to comply will be cause to initiate a WV-82, Vendor Performance Form. This form will officially notify the West Virginia Division of Purchasing and the Vendor of unsatisfactory performance in the execution of this contract and the requirements herein.

2.4 Warranty

2.4.1 The Vendor shall provide a minimum of 2 Year warranty on all merchandise.

2.4.2 All warranty claims that require field service shall be performed by the vendor at no cost to the Agency.

3.0 MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

3.1 The vendor shall meet all Federal and State Laws and Regulations concerning Hazardous Chemicals.

3.2 The Vendor shall provide a proper and current Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) and shall forward with shipment to the Equipment Division located in Buckhannon, West Virginia. The Vendor shall also furnish the State and/or its agencies additional MSDS as requested. By signing and dating this bid, the Vendor agrees to these conditions.

4.0 ORDERING AND INVOICING

4.1 Release Orders

4.1.1 For all orders, the Agency will issue to the Vendor a WV-39 Release Order. Issuance of the Release Order shall contain the type of merchandise to be purchased and shall serve as the

authorization to begin work. No work other than that specified in the Release Order shall be undertaken by the Vendor.

4.1.2 Release Orders may be placed by any or all of the WVDOH locations listed in Exhibit A.

4.1.3 Release Orders must not be held by the Vendor until a maximum order point is reached.

4.2 Payment

4.2.1 The State of West Virginia currently utilizes a VISA purchasing card program which is issued through a local bank. The Vendor must accept the State of West Virginia purchasing card for payment of all orders placed against this Contract.

4.2.2 The Vendor must supply a credit card receipt, sales receipt, or cash register receipt. Charges must not be applied until merchandise is received by the Agency.

5.0 AWARD

Contract will be awarded complete and not split.

6. **Application is made for 3.5% resident vendor preference who is a veteran for the reason checked:**
 Bidder is a resident vendor who is a veteran of the United States armed forces, the reserves or the National Guard, if, for purposes of producing or distributing the commodities or completing the project which is the subject of the vendor's bid and continuously over the entire term of the project, on average at least seventy-five percent of the vendor's employees are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two immediately preceding years.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
