- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.

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Specifications

Purpose: To establish a contract to install, repair, and calibrate 15 Permanent Automatic Traffic Recorders (PATR) located Statewide.

1.0 DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the West Virginia Division of Highways
- B. The "Vendor" shall be defined as the successful bidder.
- C. The "Purchase Order" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must", "will", "shall", "minimum", "maximum", or "is/are required" identify a mandatory item or factor. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The successful Vendor shall provide loops and piezos in the pavement to continuously collect vehicle counts, vehicle classifications, weigh-in-motion, and speed data.

2.1 Technical Requirements:

- 2.1.1 Work to be completed during the execution of this contract will consist of re-installation of existing loops and piezos for 5 PATR sites, installation of 9 new PATR sites, calibration of 15 sites, service poll extension/AC conversion of 1 site, and purchase of select PATR field equipment.
- 2.1.2 The minimum installment per site, per lane will be two (2) twelve (12) foot piezo sensors on either side of one (1) six (6) foot x six (6) foot loop detectors and related wiring, saw cuts, conduit, etc. per attached materials list and

installation sketches. Associated wire runs will be made as necessary to connect sensors to in place controller cabinet. It should be noted, all new installation sites will have controller cabinets mounted on utility poles. Contractor shall provided and install utility pole, type "M" controller cabinet and install solar panel on utility pole per attached material list.

2.1.9 PATR additional instruction for 2, 4 and 6 lane installs:

- Piezo lead-in cables must be measured so they can be ordered attached to the sensor for direct pulls into cabinet. (No splices permitted)
- Loops (THHN 14 AWG) can be pulled direct. (No splices permitted.)
- For accuracy and optimum installation a ¾" single blade should be used. This would mean one accurate cut per piezo installation.
- The Contractor shall avoid placing sensors or loops through joints or cracked areas.
- All 6' x 6' (six foot by six foot) loops shall have four
 (4) turns of standard #14 AWG wire.
- DOH personnel will determine lead-in lengths & perform electrical readings of sensors during installation and will inspect pavement cuts which must utilize a ¾" cut blade.

- Acetone will be required to clean sensors and cuts
- All sites will require WIM calibration upon completion of installation. Contractor will be responsible for providing calibration truck with certified weight and size as set forth by the WVDOH.

2.1.10 WIM performance:

Wheel base or axle spacing measurements shall have a precision of +/- .5 feet. (.15m). Length measurements shall be accurate to within +/- 2 MPH (4.83Km) of actual speed. Weigh in motion measurements shall meet the accuracy performance standards set by ASTM E1318. Calibration vehicle will consist of the following characteristics: class 9 (5 axle) combination vehicle with operator, air ride equipped, and minimum 70K pound weight bill. Calibration process will consist of 4 to 6

passes per lane per site. Upon completion of field calibration, adjustment factors for each site will be provided to DOH office personnel.

2.2 Warranty, Service, Support:

- **2.2.1** WARRANTY: The equipment and installation be warranted against all defects in material and workmanship, and failures for a period of not less than 24 months, and shall cover 100% parts, labor, and shipping. If the manufacturer's standard warranty period exceeds 24 months, then the standard warranty shall apply. All accessory parts shall be covered by the same warranty. The warranty begins on the date the units are determined to meet specifications and are accepted by the WVDOT. If contractor replaces items due to defects or workmanship then the warranty shall being again.
 - a. WVDOT will verbally notify the vendor point-of-contact for the needed warranty repair. Warranty replacement shall not exceed seven (7) days.
 - b. The vendor shall issue shipping authorization instructions. All shipping charges shall be assumed by vendor.
 - c. All warranty repairs shall be accomplished and the equipment returned to WVDOT point of origin within 45 calendar days of receipt of the equipment by the vendor. Any equipment that is covered by warranty that cannot be repaired within 45 days shall be replaced with new equipment within the 45 calendar days at no cost to WVDOT.

- d. Exclusions: WVDOT will assume responsibility for the cost of repairs resulting from theft, vandalism, natural disaster and operator error and negligence.
- 2.2.2 SERVICE AND SUPPORT: The manufacturer of the equipment shall have an authorized dealer within the Continental United States. The authorized dealer shall have factory-trained personnel available for warranty repairs and the performance of service. The dealer shall also maintain an inventory of high-usage parts and quick source for low-usage parts. The authorized dealer shall provide the WVDOT with a point-of-contact and a toll free telephone number. This number shall be attended, at a minimum, during the hours of 10:00AM to 4:00PM Eastern Standard Time. This contact shall be responsible for responding to all inquiries relating to the purchase order and subsequent support.

2.3 Additional Information:

2.3.1 Special Instructions:

- Notice to Bidders: All contractors are required to attend pre-bid meeting prior to placing project bid.
- WVDOH to provide field map of PATR locations at mandatory pre-bid meeting.
- During bid process the contractor will submit in writing information regarding all sub-consultants to be used prior to construction. The WVDOH reserves

the right to approve or disapprove all subconsultants.

- Notice to proceed will be within 45 days of bid opening. Contract duration will be 1 year from notice to proceed.
- During construction the vendor must coordinate lengths of Class 1 BL sensors with WVDOH, Traffic Analysis Section field men before ordering to ensure Class 1BL sensors are of proper length for each of the Two Lane Site Installation. Four and six lane sites do not apply.
- During construction the vendor must supply "As Built" drawings per complete installation site, for all installs in order to be able to locate underground wiring and conduit pipes for future reference.
- During execution of contract all systems will be functional to WVDOH standards prior to payment.
 The systems shall be fully functional and equipped to collect traffic count, classification, weight data, and speed data in multiple lanes.

2.3.3 Wage Rate:

2.3.5 Maintenance of Traffic:

- 2.3.5.1 Maintenance of traffic shall be in accordance with section 636 of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways' Standard Specifications, Roads and Bridges, adopted July 1, 2010, Supplemental Specifications, January 1, 2011, and the manual "Traffic Control for Street and Highway Construction and Maintenance Operations," which is made a part of this contract and the traffic plan for individual segments, as described below.
- **2.3.5.2** The Contractor shall use portable construction signs only. These signs shall be installed only while actual work is being performed and must be removed at all other times.
- 2.3.5.3 No work shall be performed by the Contractor during peak hours (6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.) on critical roadways, as determined by the District Engineer.
- 2.3.5.4 It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to coordinate traffic control with any adjacent or overlapping project. This coordination shall be done through the District engineer to ensure that

any one closure shall not conflict with any other closure.

2.3.5.5 Maintenance of traffic at sites on the WV Turnpike shall be in accordance with the specification.

3.0 INVOICING

3.1 Payment

3.1.1 The Contractor will invoice the WVDOH upon completion of work as specified in the contract. The Contractor will invoice the WVDOH no more than one time per month. Detailed invoices will be submitted to the Traffic Analysis Unit within the WVDOH's Program Planning and Administration Division for review and approval. The Contractor will receive payment of invoices via check.

3.2 Special Payment Instructions

3.2.1 Contractor may request partial payment of materials purchased for bid items 1, 2, 3 and 4. Prior to partial payment, contractor must coordinate material inspection and approval by WVDOH field personnel.

Contractor may request partial payment upon completion of PATR site installation for bid items1, 2, 3 and 4. Prior to request for partial payment, contractor must supply WVDOH with a detailed breakdown of installation cost per PATR.


Contractor may not invoice partial payment for services rendered or materials purchased more than once per calendar month unless previously authorized by the WVDOH. Invoice


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interval limit does not apply at the request of contract payment upon completion.


