The West Virginia State Police are requesting competitive bids for an Open End contract for Trijicon brand Self Luminous Night Sights Or Equal for 870 Remington Shotguns.

Vendors wishing to furnish a brand other than Trijicon may do so, however, this brand must be equal to or better than the proposed Trijicon. A vendor quoting on another brand other than Trijicon brand must provide written documentation with their bid package. If no documentation is provided, their proposal will not be considered.

Part I – Construction

Sights will be equipped with green self-illuminating aiming dots on the front and rear sights. Sights will be tested per American National Standard Institute (ANSI) guidelines. Each glass capsule will be coated with a phosphor on the inside, and filled with tritium gas. Each capsule will be laser sealed. The glass lamp will be contained within an aluminum tube. The tube will be shock mounted in silicone rubber inside of the aluminum. The viewing end of the aluminum tube will be sealed with polished single crystal synthetic sapphire.

Part II – Warranty

These night sights will carry a twelve (12) year warranty from the date of purchase to cover any defects in the manufacture or material of said sights.

Part III – Delivery

Sights will be delivered to the West Virginia State Police Procurement Division located at 4124 Kanawha Turnpike, South Charleston, 25309. Shipping costs will be the responsibility of the vendor awarded the contract.

Part IV – Award

The contract will be awarded to the vendor with the most complete bid with the lowest grand total amount.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code §61-5-3*), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.

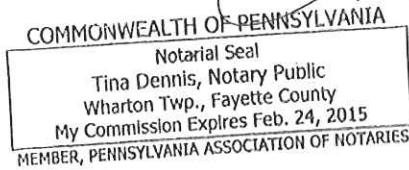

Certification and application* is hereby made for Preference in accordance with *West Virginia Code*, §5A-3-37. (Does not apply to construction contracts). *West Virginia Code*, §5A-3-37, provides an opportunity for qualifying vendors to request (at the time of bid) preference for their residency status. Bidder understands if the Secretary of Revenue determines that a Bidder receiving preference has failed to continue to meet the requirements for such preference, the Secretary may order the Director of Purchasing to: (a) reject the bid; or (b) assess a penalty against such Bidder in an amount not to exceed 5% of the bid amount and that such penalty will be paid to the contracting agency or deducted from any unpaid balance on the contract or purchase order.
