GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- **4.** All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

Water Line Backflow Prevention Device Testing Services Specifications

BACKGROUND

The agency has approximately 70 service water lines in West Virginia. Some locations have multiple water meters that service multiple buildings in one location.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The vendor will perform testing of backflow prevention devices, and complete any required test results form that is provided by the agency from utility. At a minimum, the vendor will test the device per the requirements of the State of West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources Bureau for Public Health, under Title 64 Legislative Rule, Series 15, Cross Connection Control & Backflow Prevention.

QUALIFICATIONS

Vendor shall be a licensed plumber, have a valid contractor's license, and certified to perform backflow prevention testing. Vendor shall have a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 general liability insurance and current worker's compensation and unemployment certificates.

NOTE: All licenses, insurance, and certifications must be submitted prior to the award of this contract.

WAGE RATES

Vendor shall pay, at a minimum, the prevailing wage rate for certified plumbers, and any assistant(s), for the county in which the job is located.

REGIONS

For bidding purposes the State is separated into six (Troop) regions, per the attached map.

PIGGYBACKING

All other government agencies may purchase from this contract.

EVALUATION AND AWARD

Vendor will provide hourly rates on the bid form. Billable hours begin upon arrival at the jobsite, and end upon completion, or leaving the jobsite. Vendor may not bill for travel time to and from the jobsite. Estimated quantities are for bidding purposes only, more or less may be required. The estimated quantities are not a guarantee for this contract. The hourly rates example will be calculated on the attached bid form to establish low bid.

An award will be made to the lowest responsible bidder per region. Should a bidder win more than one region, those regions will be included and issued under one contract.

*NOTE – If the rate is different per region, a separate bid per region shall be submitted identifying the region. If the rate per region is the same for all regions, then please mark the regions you wish to bid on below.



PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
