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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.

3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division

and have paid the required \$125 fee.

- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.html and is hereby made part of the agreement provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 14. CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures, and rules. Vendor further agrees to comply with the Confidentiality Policies and Information Security Accountability Requirements, set forth in http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy/noticeConfidentiality.pdf.
- 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

I certify that this bid is made without prior understanding, agreement, or connection with any corporation, firm, limited liability company, partnership, or person or entity submitting a bid for the same material, supplies, equipment or services and is in all respects fair and without collusion or Fraud. I further certify that I am authorized to sign the certification on behalf of the bidder or this bid.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1. Use the quotation forms provided by the Purchasing Division. Complete all sections of the quotation form.
- 2. Items offered must be in compliance with the specifications. Any deviation from the specifications must be clearly indicated by the bidder. Alternates offered by the bidder as EQUAL to the specifications must be clearly defined. A bidder offering an alternate should attach complete specifications and literature to the bid. The Purchasing Division may waive minor deviations to specifications.

3. Unit prices shall prevail in case of discrepancy. All quotations are considered F.O.B. destination unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the quotation.

- 4. All quotations must be delivered by the bidder to the office listed below prior to the date and time of the bid opening. Failure of the bidder to deliver the quotations on time will result in bid disqualifications: Department of Administration, Purchasing Division, 2019 Washington Street East, P.O. Box 50130, Charleston, WV 25305-0130
- 5. Communication during the solicitation, bid, evaluation or award periods, except through the Purchasing Division, is strictly prohibited (W.Va. C.S.R. §148-1-6.6).

- Q1: Is it adviseable to quote different discount percentages for parts on the list, or is one firm fixed percentage discount preferable?
- A1: A firm fixed discount for all parts.
- Q2: Will the bid be awarded based on the lowest total dollar amount or the highest discount percentage quoted?
- A2: The award will be based on low bid total per bid form, based on the vendor's current catalogue price less the discount. Please see Attachment A, Page 13 of the RFQ, Evaluation & Award.
- Q3: I wanted to know if there are any differences in DPS1236 and the prior RFQ DPS1208. I was expecting something different since the prior RFQ was canceled, but I am not seeing anything thats different.
- A3: The difference in DPS1236 and the previous RFQ, DPS1208, is located on Attachment A Page 13 of the RFQ Evaluation & Award.

I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE:

The West Virginia State Police is soliciting bids to establish a contract for automobile collision parts. The Contract awarded from this RFQ shall cover Eligible Items from Vendor's Catalogue, computer print-out, or computer disc. The Contract may be utilized by West Virginia State agencies and all political subdivisions of the State in all 55 counties.

II. DEFINITIONS:

The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them as follows:

- 1. "Agency" or "Agencies" means West Virginia State Police (WVSP) or any public entity seeking to procure Eligible Items under this Contract.
- 2. "Catalogue" means the price list or sales catalogue that includes all items that Vendor can and will sell under this Contract.
- 3. "Contract" means the binding agreement that is entered into between the State and the Vendor to provide the Eligible Items as specified herein.
- 4. "Discounted Unit Price" means the price of an Eligible Item purchased under this Contract. The Discounted Unit Price is calculated by reducing the lowest Catalogue price for an Eligible Item by the discount percentage quoted by Vendor on the Pricing Page.
- 5. "Eligible Item" means automobile collision parts for all brands of vehicles, or equal.
- 6. "Pricing Pages" means the schedule of prices, discount percentage, estimated usage, and totals attached hereto as Exhibit B and used to evaluate the RFQ.
- 7. "Purchasing Division" means the West Virginia Department of Administration, Purchasing Division.
- 8. "RFQ" means the official RFQ published by the Purchasing Division and identified as DPS1208.
- 9. "State" means the State of West Virginia and/or any of its agencies, commissions, boards, etc.
- 10. "Vendor" or "Vendors" means the successful bidder(s).

III. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Mandatory Eligible Item Requirements: Eligible Items must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.
 - a. Eligible Items must be automobile brand, or equal, in which multiple contracts may be awarded; in addition to one "after-market" contract.
 - b. Eligible Items must be compatible with the brand specific automobile.
 - c. Eligible Items must meet warranty requirements for the brand specific automobile, if within the warranty period.

IV. CONTRACT AWARD, PERCENTAGE DISCOUNT, CATALOGUE

- 1. Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a discounted price on all Eligible Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the lowest overall total cost for the items listed on the Pricing Page based on the Catalogue (includes computer print-out & computer disc) price of those items and the single percentage discount applied.
- 2. Percentage Discount: Vendor shall quote a single percentage discount that will reduce the lowest price shown in the Catalogue for every Eligible Item. The resulting Discounted Unit Price shall be the price Agencies pay for purchases of Eligible Items under this Contract.
 - The percentage discount and subsequent Discounted Unit Price derived from that discount must take into account any and all fees, charges, or other miscellaneous costs that Vendor may require, including delivery charges as indicated below, because those fees, charges, or other miscellaneous costs will not be paid separately. The Agency shall only pay the appropriate Discounted Unit Price for items purchased under this Contract.
- 3. Pricing Pages: Vendor shall complete the Pricing Pages by inserting Catalogue prices, the discount percentage, Discounted Unit Prices, totals, and all other information requested thereon. Vendor shall complete all columns as failure to complete the Pricing Pages in their entirety will result in Vendor's bid(s) being disqualified. The Discounted Unit Price Vendor lists in the Pricing Pages must be the final price that will be charged to an Agency.

The Pricing Pages contain a list of frequently purchased items and estimated purchase volume. The estimated purchase volume for each item represents the

approximate volume of anticipated purchases only. No future use of the Contract or any individual item is guaranteed or implied.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Purchasing Division may correct errors as described herein. Vendor should type or electronically enter the information into the Pricing Pages to prevent errors in the evaluation. The Pricing Pages were created as a Microsoft Excel document and Vendor can request an electronic copy for bid purposes by sending an email request to the following address: Tara.L.Lyle@wv.gov

4. Catalogue: Vendor must submit its Catalogue prior to award of this Contract for evaluation purposes. Vendor shall also mail the Catalogue free of charge to any Agency desiring to use this contract. Copies of the Catalogue may be requested in an electronic format and should be provided in that format if possible. Vendor's Catalogue will be used by Agencies to order Eligible Items under this Contract.

Vendor should identify all items listed on the Pricing Pages by circling or highlighting those items in its Catalogue and earmarking or tabbing the pages for those items, to assist in the evaluation and verification of the bids and pricing. If any discrepancies exist between the Pricing Pages and the actual price listed in the Catalogue, the actual price shall prevail and the Pricing Pages may be corrected by the buyer for evaluation purposes.

The Catalogue may be updated quarterly, but any price increase and renewal must be approved by the Purchasing Division at its sole discretion. Unless an updated catalogue is approved, the Eligible Items available under this Contract and prices for those items shall remain unchanged during the term of this Contract.

Catalogue must be held firm for a period of six (6) months both after award and after each change in catalogue; and the discount percentage may not be decreased during the life of the contract.

V. ORDERING AND PAYMENT

1. Ordering: Vendor shall accept orders by regular mail, facsimile, e-mail, or any other written forms of communication. Vendor may, but is not required to, accept on-line orders through a secure internet ordering portal/website. If Vendor has the ability to accept on-line orders, it should include in its response a brief description of how Agencies may utilize the on-line ordering system. Any on-line ordering system must have the capability to restrict prices and available items to conform to the Catalogue

originally submitted with this RFQ. Vendor shall ensure that its on-line ordering system is properly secured prior to processing Agency orders on-line.

2. Payment: Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia. Methods of acceptable payment must include the West Virginia Purchasing Card. Payment in advance is not permitted under this Contract.

VI. DELIVERY AND RETURN

- 1. **Delivery Time:** Vendor shall deliver standard orders within five (5) working days after orders are received. Vendor shall deliver emergency orders within one (1) working day after orders are received. Vendor shall ship all orders in accordance with the above schedule and shall not hold orders until a minimum delivery quantity is met.
- 2. Late Delivery: The Agency placing the order under this Contract must be notified in writing if orders will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to an Agency will be grounds for:
 - (a) cancellation of the delayed order, and
 - (b) obtaining the items ordered from a third party.

Any Agency seeking to obtain items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval of the Purchasing Division.

- 3. Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss: Standard order delivery shall be F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location. Vendor shall include the cost of standard order delivery charges in its bid pricing/discount and is not permitted to charge the Agency separately for such delivery. The Agency will pay delivery charges on all emergency orders provided that Vendor invoices those delivery costs as a separate charge with the original freight bill attached to the invoice.
- 4. Return of Unacceptable Items: Items that Agency deems unacceptable shall be returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense and with no restocking charge. Vendor shall either make arrangements for the return within five (5) days of being notified that items are unacceptable, or permit the Agency to arrange for the return and reimburse Agency for delivery expenses. If the original packaging cannot be utilized for the return, Vendor will supply the Agency with appropriate return packaging upon request. All returns of unacceptable items shall be F.O.B. the Agency's location. The returned product shall either be replaced, or the Agency shall receive a full credit or refund for the purchase price, at the Agency's discretion.

5. Return Due to Agency Error: Items ordered in error by the Agency will be returned for credit within 10 days of receipt, F.O.B. Vendor's location. Vendor shall not charge a restocking fee if returned products are in a resalable condition. Items shall be deemed to be in a resalable condition if they are unused and in the original packaging. Any restocking fee for items not in a resalable condition shall be the lower of the Vendor's customary restocking fee or 5% of the total invoiced value of the returned items.

VII. MISCELLANIOUS

- 1. No Substitutions: Vendor shall supply only Eligible Items contained in its Catalogue submitted in response to the RFQ or an updated Catalogue approved by the Purchasing Division as described above. Vendor shall not supply substitute items.
- 2. Vendor Supply: Vendor must carry sufficient common in-stock inventory of the Eligible Items being offered to fulfill its obligations under this Contract. By signing its bid, Vendor certifies that it can supply the Eligible Items contained in its bid response.
- 3. Reports: Vendor shall provide, upon Agencies' request, quarterly reports and annual summaries to the Agency showing the Agency's items purchased, quantities of items purchased, and total dollar value of the items purchased. Vendor shall also provide reports, upon request, showing the items purchased during the term of this Contract, the quantity purchased for each of those items, and the total value of purchases for each of those items. Failure to supply such reports may be grounds for cancellation of this Contract.
- 4. Contract Manager: During its performance of this Contract, Vendor must designate and maintain a primary contract manager responsible for overseeing Vendor's responsibilities under this Contract. The Contract manager must be available during normal business hours to address any customer service or other issues related to this Contract.
- 5. Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must," "will," "shall," "minimum," "maximum," or "is/are required" identify a mandatory contract requirement. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the Purchasing Division. Failure on the part of the Vendor to meet any of the mandatory specifications shall result in disqualification of the bid.

6. Waiver: The failure of either party to insist upon a strict performance of any of the terms or provision of this Contract, or to exercise any option, right, or remedy herein contained, shall not be construed as a waiver or a relinquishment for the future of such term, provision, option, right, or remedy, but the same shall continue in remain in full force and effect. Any waiver must be expressly stated in writing and signed by the waiving party.

The West Virginia State Police (hereinafter referred to as "Agency") is soliciting competitive bids to purchase certain automotive body parts for its police vehicle fleet. Vendors do not need to be a registered vendor to submit a bid on this contract, however if they are determined to be the lowest bidder meeting the minimum specifications, then they will be required to pay a \$125.00 vendor registration fee to the State of WV, Purchasing Division prior to contract award.

BACKGROUND:

The agency operates its own body shop located at 711 Jefferson Road, South Charleston WV 25309. The agency maintains approximately 900 vehicles. The agency primarily operates Ford, Dodge, & GM vehicles.

GENERAL:

This attached list of parts on the bid form is not all inclusive, but is for evaluation purposes only. Any part that can be purchased from the vendor will be made available to the agency at the percentage discount from catalogue list, as described in the specifications.

Items may be ordered from this contract as long as they are not covered by a mandatory Statewide Contract.

EVALUATION & AWARD:

The State may issue up to three (3) contracts for original brand specific, or equally compatible, contracts for the specific brand of vehicle; and one (1) contract to a vendor who can provide after-market body parts.

Vendors shall complete the attached bid form for the specific brand, or compatible, being bid; failure to utilize the bid form, and complete each box, may be considered non-responsive. Due to the nature of a catalogue open-end contract and bid request, the percentage discount represents the actual bid, therefore, for evaluation purposes, the catalogue unit price and the percentage discount must be completed. It is preferred the extended total being calculated to arrive at the total.

Pricing will apply to future vehicle models within the contract period.

AUDIT:

The agency, state auditor's office, and any government agency that may purchase from this contract, may at any time, audit the winning vendor's invoices from the suppliers, to verify cost, compared to cost on invoices charged to the agency. The vendor must make all documents available within 2 hours of a notice of intent to audit.
