The Acquisition and Contract Administration Section of the Purchasing Division "State" for the West Virginia General Services Division is soliciting quotations to remove and replace three (3) manholes serving the high pressure steam distribution system, including all accourtement and accessories, to be located at the three distinct locations on the Capitol Complex, located at 1900 Kanawha Blvd, East in Charleston, West Virginia. This document is intended to supplement information provided in the standard "Request for Quotation" and "General Terms and Conditions" issued by the Purchasing Division for this project. Contractors should carefully review all documents.

### Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting:

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on Thursday, July 21, 2011, at 10:00 am. Contractors attending the meeting shall assemble at the Engineering Section Conference Room at 103 Michigan Avenue (south of Washington Street). No parking is provided for attendees by the Agency. ### Scope of Work:

The work includes, but is not limited to, removing and properly disposing of three concrete manholes and bases equipped with high pressure steam valves, piping and accessories and replacing them with two pre-fabricated steel manholes provided with steam and condensate shut-off valves, piping, trap assemblies, anchor bases and other accessories as designed, intended and described in the construction documents and other related work for the completion of this project.

Work shall be conducted as a single project. 72 hours after award of the Contract the Contractor shall submit a schedule showing the commencement and completion dates for each proposed area or subsystem.
