The Acquisition and Contract Administration Section of the Purchasing Division "State" for the West Virginia General Services Division is soliciting quotations to provide all labor, materials, equipment and associated costs for installing bird deterrent netting to protect the House and Senate Balconies – the tops of all column capitals and the entire ceiling area -- from roosting and nesting birds. This document is intended to supplement information provided in the standard "Request for Quotation" and "General Terms and Conditions" issued by the Purchasing Division for this project. Vendors should carefully review all documents.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting:

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on Wednesday, August 31, 2011, at 10:00 am. Contractors attending the meeting shall assemble outside of Room MB60 in the basement of the Main Capitol Building. See Purchasing Division Request for Quotation for additional information.

Scope of Work:

The work consists of providing and installing bird deterrent netting, per the attached technical specifications and drawings, on all of the column capitals and under the entire ceiling areas of both the House (East Portico) and Senate (West Portico) balconies of the Main Capitol Building. Contractor shall remove any previously installed bird control apparatus and clean all bird droppings or nesting material from all areas to be contained by the new netting. Work shall be conducted from a lift (an articulating boom is likely required), with limitations on where the lift can be placed (the sidewalks at the immediate exits of both porticos are hollow and cannot bear the weight of a lift). Netting at the ceilings shall be installed to allow for access to the light fixtures in the ceilings of both porticos, to minimize the amount of netting that would have to be dismantled or removed to access the lights.

Work shall be conducted as a single project with work phased separately in each wing to avoid blocking both porticos simultaneously. Work in each area shall be substantially complete prior to beginning the next area. Successful contractor shall submit a schedule (within three calendar days of the issuance of the Notice to Proceed, to the Architect) showing the commencement and completion dates for each proposed area or subsystem. The schedule shall be reviewed and approved by the Owner prior to commencement of the work. Coordinate the schedule around Owner's work requirements.

Furnish all materials, labor, and equipment necessary to complete all work as indicated by these specifications. Intent is that the completed work consists of a fully completed bird deterrent netting system on each portico's column capitals and ceiling. Furnish any incidental work, materials, labor and equipment that are necessary to complete the work, even if such incidental work is not explicitly included in the contract documents.

Any equipment contracted for prior to receipt of the signed purchase order and issuance of the written Notice to Proceed letter shall be at the Bidder's risk.

Contract Period:

The Contract shall be substantially completed within **Sixty (60)** calendar days from the issuance of the written Notice to Proceed. In accordance with the West Virginia State Code 5A-3-4(8), vendor agrees that liquidated damages shall be imposed at the rate of \$500.00 per day for failure to complete the project within the contract period. This clause shall in no way be considered exclusive and shall not limit the State or Agency's right to pursue any other additional remedy to which the State or Agency may have legal cause for action including further damages against the vendor.

Definitions:

- A. The Department of Administration, General Services Division, Room MB-60, State Capitol, Charleston, West Virginia shall be hereinafter called the "Owner".
- B. The vendor contracted by these specifications shall hereinafter be called the "Contractor".
- C. "The Contract", as herein stated, shall mean the fully executed purchase order to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Owners Representative", as herein stated, shall be defined as that person so designated by the Director of the General Services Division.
- E. "Architect/Engineer", as stated in these Contract Documents shall refer to the General Services Division.

Payment:

The Contractor shall submit two copies (one original and one copy) of current invoices once each month on AIA forms G702 and G703. Invoices shall be signed in blue ink. Deliver invoices to:

General Services Division Attn: Business Manager 1900 Kanawha Blvd. East Building 1, Room MB-68 Charleston, West Virginia 25305

Payments shall be made monthly based on the percentage of work completed. A ten percent (10%) retainage will be deducted until substantial completion of the contract. Progress payments shall not be made when the total value of the work performed since the last estimate amounts to less than Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars.

Submit the proposed invoice to the General Services Division - Projects / Engineering Section for approval of format prior to submission of first invoice. All work shall be inspected and approved prior to payment.

Submit certified payrolls with each payment application.

Supplementary General Conditions:

- 1. The Contractor shall procure all necessary permits and licenses to comply with all applicable laws, Federal, State, or municipal, along with all regulations, and ordinances of any regulating body.
- 2. The Contractor shall pay any applicable sales, use, or personal property taxes, arising out of this Contract and the transactions contemplated thereby. Any other taxes levied upon this Contract, the transaction, or the equipment, or services delivered pursuant hereto shall be borne by the Contractor. It is clearly understood that the State of West Virginia is exempt from any taxes regarding performance of the scope of work of this Contract.
- 3. Contractor shall be responsible for parts and materials as follows:
 - A. The Contractor shall supply all tools, tool accessories, personal safety equipment, and supplies necessary to execute the responsibilities of this Contract.
 - B. Contractor shall furnish a warranty of twelve (12) months for labor and materials.

Bonds and Insurance:

Refer to Purchasing Division's 'Request for Quotation' for requirements on bonding; insurance; wage rates; "Foreign made aluminum, glass and steel in Public Works Projects", and other project requirements.

Submittals:

All submittals for this project shall be reviewed and approved by the General Services Division Architectural/Engineering Section.

Project Closeout:

- Closeout documents, including marked-up shop drawings shall be submitted in bound format prior to final application for payment.
- 2. Final cleanup shall be completed prior to final acceptance.
- 3. Submit As-Built Drawings and record documents.
- 4. Submit "Affidavit of Payment of Debts and Claims."

Final Inspection:

The Final Inspection will be conducted by a Project Manager from the General Services Division, Architectural / Engineering Section.

Work found to be in accordance with the Contract Documents will be accepted as complete for final acceptance. Unacceptable work, or work not in accordance with the Contract Documents shall be removed, replaced, changed or cleaned as required to meet requirements of Contract Documents prior to final acceptance. Final Acceptance does not waive or release Contractor to

conform with the Contract Documents.

The date of Substantial Completion shall be determined by the Architect/Engineer conducting the final inspection based on all work being complete for final acceptance or substantially complete to permit beneficial use by the Owner. Final payment shall not be made until all work is finally accepted.

Limits of Work

Work areas will be limited to those spaces required for access to the porticos.

Some interior space may be utilized for temporary (overnight) storage of equipment and tools. Coordinate storage needs with the GSD Building Manager.

Owner and Agency facilities shall remain in use during this contract. Contractor shall work with the Building Manager and Protective Services to coordinate the temporary access to work areas and otherwise provide for the Contractor needs to complete work. Contractor shall minimize disruption to Capitol work areas and loading dock access.

Use of grass-covered areas for the placement of equipment is allowable, but only with approval of the Owner, and with the stipulation that any re-grading or reseeding required (at the Owner's discretion) as a result of damages to the grounds by the placement or traffic of the Contractor's equipment, to restore the grounds to their condition at the start of the project, shall be the Contractor's responsibility. It is strongly preferred that the Contractor use grounds damage preventatives as much as possible (turf protection mats, etc)

Use of Facilities

Contractor shall be permitted reasonable use of building utilities including power, water and sanitary sewage disposal as required for conducting the work. Coordinate the location of service connections or use of receptacle with the building manager to avoid overloading existing circuits.

Contractor Schedule:

Provide overall project schedule within three (3) calendar days of issuance of Notice to Proceed.

Provide a proposed construction schedule indicating areas to be worked. Where coordination or disruption of office workspaces or pedestrian traffic to the building may be required, provide at least one week's advance notice prior to conducting work in those areas. Adhere to schedule provided and coordinate with through Project Manager.

Waste Removal

Contractor to make arrangements for the collection and disposal of Contractor's waste and construction related debris. Debris shall be removed on a daily basis.

Contractor Visitor Badges

The Capitol Building is a semi-secure facility. Contractor shall provide a list of all personnel working on this project within the Building prior to beginning any work. This list shall include a copy of a valid driver's license or other legal identification and include date of birth and social security number. All proposed workers may be subjected to a criminal history / driver's license background check prior to being permitted to work in state buildings. Workers shall carry valid Contractor Photo ID Badges to be worn when working in the building (provided by Owner). Under no circumstances shall a worker be assigned to this project without the validation first being submitted to the General Services Division and approval given. Other security measures, specific to the operations of the WV Legislature, may be required of the Contractor.

Work Restrictions:

Work shall be generally performed inside the existing building during normal business working hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday, except state recognized holidays. Work outside of these hours may be allowed, but only with prior approval of the Owner.

This is a non-smoking building: Smoking is not permitted within the building or near entrances, operable windows or outdoor air intakes.

These two porticos are high pedestrian traffic areas. Traffic through the doors cannot be blocked for unscheduled periods of time. At least a single lane of pedestrian access to the portico must be maintained during normal Capitol hours of 7:00am to 7:00pm.

The House and Senate conduct monthly Interim sessions (generally covering three days, a Sunday through a Tuesday). Also, special legislative sessions can be called at anytime during the project. No work can be done during any session without prior, written approval from the Owner (it is unlikely this approval would be given).

Parking

No parking is available on the project site. Parking in non-designated areas is not permitted. A limited number of spaces will be allocated for contractors vehicles near the project site. Parking for Contractor's personnel will be available in the designated contractor's parking area near Laidley Field. Provisions will be made for locating refuse dumpsters if required by the project.

Use of loading dock areas for parking is strictly prohibited.

With prior approval, contractor's vehicles may be brought on-site for loading & unloading or to provide equipment necessary for conducting the work. Vehicles not necessary for conduct of work shall be removed from site within one-half hour.

Building Access

The building is available from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. Extended work hours may be acceptable if approved by the Owner. This building is a semi-secure location. Access to the building shall be coordinated with the Owner. Contractor shall not leave open doors unattended and shall close

doors when not in use.

Codes:

All work is to be performed in compliance with applicable Federal and State codes including but not limited to the International Building Code, International Mechanical Code, Life Safety Code, NEC, OSHA,UL, ANSI, ASME and related standards.

Safety:

Perform all work in compliance with applicable safety regulations. Work shall be subject to verification and inspection by GSD Safety representatives. Such verification shall not relieve the Contractor from meeting all applicable safety regulations and inspection by other agencies.

Notify Owner if suspected hazardous materials are encountered. Any areas requiring abatement will be provided by the GSD under separate contract.

Hot Work Permit:

Contractor shall obtain Owner's permission prior to performing any work that requires an open flame, creates sparks, use's equipment that creates combustible temperatures, or performs any work that could result in a fire hazard. Owner will review work area and issue a 'Hot Work Permit' prior to Contractor commencing work. Note that the Contractor must take proper precautions and may be required to provide a Fire Watch as a condition of the permit.

Workmanship:

Contractor shall complete all work in a neat and workmanlike manner. All work shall be done using new materials in a manner that meets commercial quality standards. Work shall be neat, true, plumb and square, as applicable. Contractor shall verify all dimensions.

Warranty:

In addition to individual material warranties, Contractor shall warranty all work for a period of one year from the date of Substantial Completion.



"Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.





SECTION 10296 – BIRD DETERRENT NETTING SYSTEM TO PROTECT CARVINGS, SCULPTURE AND MOLDINGS

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 SUMMARY

- A. This Section includes the following:
 - Installation of bird deterrent netting at the underside and column capitals of east and west building balcony.
 - This procedure includes guidance on installing a netting bird deterrent system. This type of system is most commonly used to protect large areas of architectural detailing, especially carvings, sculptures and moldings. It is usually installed on the upper portions of a building, where its presence will not be as apparent.
- B. Intent: It is the specific intent of this Section to provide for bird deterrent installation in a manner that does not damage or detract from the building's historic character. All work required to achieve this intent shall be included. The netting system is designed to prevent birds from nesting in at the column capitals by making entry into those areas difficult.

1.2 SUBMITTALS

- A. Samples: Submit a 12' x 12" sample proposed bird netting to the Architect for color approval.
- B. Mock-ups: An areas (s) selected by the Architect will have a test installation of bird netting for approval prior to beginning work.

1.3 PROJECT/SITE CONDITIONS

A. Do not use adhesive on wet or damp surfaces or when temperatures are above 120 degrees F or below 45 degrees F.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.1 MANUFACTURERS

2.2 MATERIALS

A. Bird Netting: UV stable, ¾" knotted plastic netting in tan, such as "Birdwire System" (Proguard Commercial Pest Solutions), or approved equal. Characteristics or netting including color and grade must be approved by Architect.

- B. Anchors: Stainless steel mounting pins which will not rust or cause staining on masonry.
- C. Adhesive: <u>Epoxy putty</u>; high modulus, high strength, non-sag, two-component, epoxy resin adhesive, designed for vertical and overhead bonding, moisture, insensitive, and in color approved by Architect.

2.3 EQUIPMENT

- A. Masonry drill.
- B. Hammer.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 PREPARATION

A. Surface Preparation: Remove all bird excrement, from the application area. Use cleaning methods accepted by the Architect, which will not damage the stone surface or adjacent materials. Application must take place after masonry cleaning operations are completed, but may be scheduled for work while staging is in place.

- A. Follow manufacturer's printed instructions for netting installation. Area to be protected must be measured accurately.

- F. Stretch netting over area to be protected and attach to anchoring pins. Stretch netting so that the mesh runs vertically and horizontally, NOT diagonally. The netting will blend better with the background when stretched in a horizontal and vertical direction.
