The Acquisition and Contract Administration Section of the Purchasing Division "State" for the West Virginia General Services Division is soliciting quotations for all labor, materials and associated costs to provide new and replacement fire rated doors and associated hardware for a complete installation and upgrade in Building 88, located at 7 Players Club Drive in Charleston, West Virginia. This document is intended to supplement information provided in the standard "Request for Quotation" and "General Terms and Conditions" issued by the Purchasing Division for this project. Contractors should carefully review all documents.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting:

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on Tuesday, January 31, at 10:00 am. Contractors attending the meeting shall assemble in the lobby of Building 88. Parking is available for attendees by the Agency. See Purchasing Division Request for Quotation for additional information.

Scope of Work:

The work consists of upgrading the fire doors system in Building 88 by replacing 21 existing doors and framing and installing one (1) new door. The Contractor shall:

1. Furnish replacement doors per attachment A;

2. Frame and finish drywall (5/8 "X" type), where required (location #22);

3. Furnish all door, trim, casement, wall trim and baseboard or cove base (where applicable) to match existing interior finishes;

4. Paint all new surfaces to match existing paint scheme;

5. Install new locksets-brass finish (locations listed on Attachment A);

 Install new rated door closures (commercial grade), finishes to match hinge finish, as indicated on Attachment A (brass hinge = brass closure/steel(chromium plated) hinge = sprayed aluminum closure);

7. Install new hinges (commercial grade), with finishes as indicated in Attachment A (exit doors finished in steel, interior doors in brass);

8. Install panic bars (commercial grade), steel finish (locations listed on Attachment A).

Contractor will submit hardware specification sheets for approval prior to installation. All doors and associated hardware must meet NFPA guidelines and be 90 minute rated. The following hardware examples are provided, not to limit competition, but to establish the level of quality required:

Interior Door Locksets: must be Corbin Russwin CL3300 series, or equal, having:

-Bright Brass Finish;

- -Double cylinder lockset that allows for locking of the outside lever on either side of the door:
- -Outside lever that rotates in the locked position;

-Solid cast levers without plastic inserts;

-Single lock chassis that can accommodate 1-3/4" to 2-1/4" door thickness;

-No exposed mounting screws;

- -Compliance with ANSI A156.2 Series 4000, Grade 1;
- -Minimum manufacture warranty of seven (7) years; (The preferred model for office doors is CL3351)

Door Closures: must be Norton 8000 Series, or equal, having:

- -Bright Brass Plated Finish (interior) or Aluminum (exterior);
- -Fasteners which comply with NFPA 80 for fire door assemblies;
- -Compliance with ANSI/BHMA standard A117.1;
- -Compliance with ANSI/BHMA A156.4, Grade 1 certified;

Hinges: must be Hager Model#BB1279, or equal, having:

- -Five knuckle, ball bearing construction;
- -Size of 4-1/2" x 4-1/2";
- -Composition of metal gauge .0134 or greater;
- -Compliance with ANSI A8112;
- -Bright Brass Finish for interior doors, Satin Chromium Plated for exterior.

Panic Bars: Must be Von Duprin #22 Exit Devices, or equal, having:

Contract Period:

The Contract shall be completed within **60** calendar days from the issuance of the written Notice to Proceed. In accordance with the West Virginia State Code 5A-3-4(8), Contractor agrees that liquidated damages shall be imposed at the rate of \$250.00 per day for failure to complete the project within the contract period. This clause shall in no way be considered exclusive and shall not limit the State or Agency's right to pursue any other additional remedy to which the State or Agency may have legal cause for action including further damages against the Contractor.

Definitions:

- A. "Agency", as herein stated, shall mean The Department of Administration, General Services Division.
- B. "Contractor", as herein stated, shall mean the vendor or service organization contracted by these specifications.
- C. "The Contract", as herein stated, shall mean the agreement between the Owner and the Contractor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Agency Representative", as herein stated, shall be defined as that person so designated by the Director of the General Services Division.
- E. "Architect/Engineer", as herein stated in these Contract Documents shall refer to the General Services Division.

Payment:

Upon completion of the Contract, the Contractor shall submit one invoice. The invoice shall be signed in blue ink. Deliver invoice to:

General Services Division Attn: Business Manager 1900 Kanawha Blvd. East Building 1, Room MB-68 Charleston, West Virginia 25305

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All work shall be inspected and approved prior to payment. Contractor shall submit certified payrolls with the invoice.

General Conditions:

- 1. The Contractor shall procure all necessary permits and licenses to comply with all applicable laws, Federal, State, or municipal, along with all regulations, and ordinances of any regulating body.
- 2. The Contractor shall pay any applicable sales, use, or personal property taxes, arising out of this Contract and the transactions contemplated thereby. Any other taxes levied upon this Contract, the transaction, or the equipment, or services delivered pursuant hereto shall be borne by the Contractor. It is clearly understood that the State of West Virginia is exempt from any taxes regarding performance of the scope of work of this Contract.
- 3. Contractor shall be responsible for parts and materials as follows:
 - a) The Contractor shall supply all tools, tool accessories, personal safety equipment and supplies necessary to execute the responsibilities of this Contract.
 - b) Contractor shall furnish a warranty of a minimum twelve (12) months for labor and materials, or the manufacturer's warranty for materials, whichever is longer.

Bonds and Insurance:

Refer to Purchasing Division's 'Request for Quotation' for requirements on bonding; insurance; wage rates; "Foreign made aluminum, glass and steel in Public Works Projects", and other project requirements.

Final Inspection:

The final inspection will be conducted by a Project Manager from the General Services Division, Operations and Maintenance Section.

Work found to be in accordance with the Contract Documents will be accepted as complete for final acceptance. Unacceptable work, or work not in accordance with the Contract Documents shall be removed, replaced, changed or cleaned as required to meet requirements of Contract Documents prior to final acceptance. Final acceptance does not waive or release Contractor to conform to the Contract Documents.

Final payment shall not be made until all work is finally accepted.

Limits of Work

Work areas will be limited to those spaces required for access to the various doors in Building 88.

No interior space may be utilized for temporary (overnight) storage of equipment and tools. Coordinate storage needs with the GSD building manager.

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Agency facilities shall remain in use during this contract. Contractor shall work with the building manager to coordinate the temporary access to work areas and otherwise provide for the Contractor needs to complete work. Contractor shall minimize disruption to building work areas and loading dock access.

Use of Facilities

Contractor shall be permitted reasonable use of building utilities including power, water and sanitary sewage disposal as required for conducting the work. The Contractor shall coordinate the location of service connections or use of receptacle with the building manager to avoid overloading existing circuits.

Contractor Schedule:

The Contractor shall provide overall project schedule within 72 hours of receipt of the Notice to Proceed to the GSD project manager.

The Contractor shall provide a proposed construction schedule indicating areas to be worked. Where coordination or disruption of occupants may be required, provide advance notice prior to conducting work in those areas. Adhere to schedule provided and coordinate with building manager.

Waste Removal

Contractor shall make arrangements for the collection and disposal of Contractor's waste and construction related debris. Debris shall be removed on a daily basis.

Contractor Visitor Badges

Building 88 is a secure facility. The Contractor shall provide a list of all personnel working on this project within twenty-four (24) hours of receipt of the Notice to Proceed. This list shall include a copy of a valid driver's license or other legal identification and include date of birth. All proposed workers may be subjected to a criminal history / driver's license background check prior to being permitted to work in state buildings. Workers shall carry valid Contractor Photo ID Badges to be worn when working in the building. Under no circumstances shall a worker be assigned to this project without the validation first being submitted to the General Services Division and approval given.

Work Restrictions:

Work shall be generally performed inside the existing building during normal business working hours of 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, except state recognized holidays. However, Agency shall coordinate with Contractor to allow for additional hours to be worked, if necessary and requested by the Contractor, to accommodate the expedited project schedule.

This is a non-smoking building: Smoking is not permitted within the building or near entrances, operable windows or outdoor air intakes.

Parking

Building 88 Fire Door System Upgrade Project No. GSD126438

Limited parking is available on the project site. Parking in non-designated areas is not permitted. A limited number of spaces will be allocated for contractors vehicles near the project site. Provisions will be made for locating refuse dumpsters if required by the project. Use of loading dock areas for parking is strictly prohibited.

With prior approval, contractor's vehicles may be brought on-site for loading & unloading or to provide equipment necessary for conducting the work. Vehicles not necessary for conduct of work shall be removed from site within one-half hour.

Codes:

All work is to be performed in compliance with applicable Federal and State codes including but not limited to the International Building Code, International Mechanical Code, Life Safety Code, NEC, OSHA,UL, ANSI, ASME,NFPA and related standards.

Safety:

Perform all work in compliance with applicable safety regulations. Work shall be subject to verification and inspection by Agency Safety representatives. Such verification shall not relieve the Contractor from meeting all applicable safety regulations and inspection by other agencies.

The Contractor shall notify Agency if suspected hazardous materials are encountered. Any areas requiring abatement will be provided by the Agency under a separate contract.

Hot Work Permit:

The Contractor shall obtain Agency's permission prior to performing any work that requires an open flame, creates sparks, use's equipment that creates combustible temperatures, or performs any work that could result in a fire hazard. Agency will review work area and issue a 'Hot Work Permit' prior to Contractor commencing work. Note that the Contractor must take proper precautions and may be required to provide a Fire Watch as a condition of the permit.

Workmanship:

The Contractor shall complete all work in a neat and workmanlike manner. All work shall be done using new materials in a manner that meets commercial quality standards. Work shall be neat, true, plumb and square, as applicable. Contractor shall verify all dimensions.







"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.


