- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.

Successful bidder will be given twenty-four (24) calendar days from the issuance of the Purchase Order to provide and deliver ALL commodities listed on the attached Bid Form. Bidders must include in their bid all costs for freight and delivery, including any additional costs they might incur to insure that ALL fixtures are delivered within this timeframe.

All fixtures must be delivered undamaged. Upon inspection by the Agency, should any items found to have any flaws or damage, the Successful Bidder shall be responsible for picking up and replacing these items at no additional cost.

General Conditions

- B. Freight will be FOB-Destination; all charges for delivery of fixtures must be incorporated into the bid. All deliveries must be coordinated with Agency. The Successful Bidder must provide a minimum of 4-hours notice to the Agency prior

to delivery. Within two (2) business days of the award of the Contract, Successful Bidder must contact Agency Representative to propose delivery schedule. All fixtures shall be delivered to the campus of the WV Rehabilitation Center on Barron Drive in Institute, WV (exact location on campus to be determined at time of delivery). The Agency strongly prefers that deliveries be made in whole, with a minimum number of overall delivery trips.

- C. Successful Bidder must provide legible delivery tickets and insure that they are signed by an Agency Representative at the time of delivery. A list of eligible Agency Representatives, including contact information, will be provided to the Successful Bidder by the Agency.
- D. Award will be made to the lowest **Total Bid**. The Agency intends to award ONE contract for ALL fixtures listed.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
