We continue to be interested in receiving request for proposals issued for the State of West Virginia in regards to accounting and consulting engagements in the health reimbursement area, including consulting services regarding state plan review and analysis, assistance in the preparation of required findings and assurances, litigation support including legal strategies and expert testimony, Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (OBRA) consulting, pharmacy cost surveys, and services regarding rebasing/recalibration of Diagnosis Related Groups (DRG)-based reimbursement systems for inpatient hospital services.

We have also developed personal computer applications to meet specific state agency needs. These include the collection, analysis, and transmission of resident assessment data submitted on the Minimum Data Set (MDS) and related instruments.
